Game Overview:

St. Norbert looks to wrap up play in the Midwest Conference North Division unbeaten as the Green Knights travel to the Gopher State to face defending league champion Macalester. St. Norbert has already clinched a berth in the MWC Championship game on Nov. 14.

The Series:

Macalester leads the all-time series with St. Norbert 1-0 in a series begun in 2014, the year the Scots joined the Midwest Conference as an affiliate member.

Last Meeting:

Macalester defeated St. Norbert 21-13 on Nov. 8, 2014 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere, a win that clinched the MWC North Division title for the Scots. The Green Knights trailed 14-7 at halftime and 14-13 early in the fourth quarter, but Samson Bialostok's 2-yard run with 5:16 remaining sealed the win for Macalester. The Scots outgained St. Norbert 366-218 in total offense with possession for 37:12. Bialostok completed 8 of 16 passes for 122 yards and also rushed for 100 yards, while Zandy Stowell rushed 36 times for 143 yards. James Tringali completed 15 of 28 passes for 147 yards, while Elijah Fort had 73 yards rushing on 13 carries for St. Norbert.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 8-0 in his first season in De Pere.

Macalester coach Tony Jennison (UW-La Crosse, 1997) is 39-38 in his eighth season in St. Paul.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 8-0 overall and 4-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division after clinching the division title with a 63-6 win over Lawrence this past Saturday in De Pere. The Green Knights enter the week ranked No. 18 in the AFCA Division III Top 25 Poll.

Senior running back Brad Boockmeier has the team rushing lead with 561 yards on 114 carries and five touchdowns. Sophomore running back Elijah Fort has 531 yards rushing on 96 carries with 13 touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Jack Becker has completed 107 of 159 passes for 1,276 yards and nine touchdowns with three interceptions while rushing for 342 yards on 59 carries and five touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Zach Reeves has caught 29 passes for 338 yards, while sophomore wide receiver Brett Olson has 20 catches for 341 yards and two touchdowns.

Senior linebacker R.J. Callow leads the Green Knights in tackles with 53. Senior linebacker Wyatt Veseth has 45 tackles. Senior linebacker Jacob Wells and junior defensive back Ryan Grandlic have 44 tackles apiece, while Grandlic has four interceptions. Senior defensive back Frank Laterza has a team-high five interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 36.6 points and 436.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 9.5 points and 268.1 yards per game. St. Norbert's scoring defense is currently seventh in Division III.

About the Scots:

Macalester enters the game with a 4-4 overall record and a 2-2 mark in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Scots dropped a 25-21 decision at Carroll this past

Saturday after winning four of their previous five games.

Senior running back Zandy Stowell leads the Macalester offense with 733 rushing yards on 111 carries and nine touchdowns. Freshman quarterback Alec Beatty is second on the team in rushing with 477 yards on 60 carries with six touchdowns. Senior quarterback Benny Goldman has completed 39 of 70 passes for 262 yards and three interceptions, while sophomore quarterback Christian Adams has completed 29 of 77 passes for 470 yards with five touchdowns and four interceptions. Sophomore wide receiver Sam Bordo has 15 receptions for 179 yards and two touchdowns.

Senior defensive lineman Zach Hauser leads the Scots in tackles with 57 with eight tackles-for-loss. Junior defensive back Forest Redlin has 47 tackles, while sophomore linebacker Elliot Tanin has 42 tackles.

Macalester is averaging 24.1 points and 319.2 yards per game. Defensively, the Scots are allowing 19.4 points and 321.0 yards per game.

Born to Run:

Several St. Norbert records took a tumble this past Saturday with the Green Knights' rushing performance in a 63-6 win over Lawrence.

St. Norbert set a new school record with 508 yards rushing on a scant 49 carries. The total broke the old record of 461 yards on 57 carries set in a 42-13 win over UW-River Falls on Sept. 28, 1968. The 10.4 yards per rush was also a school record.

Jack Becker averaged 26.0 yards per carry, gaining 130 yards on five rushes. That mark eclipsed the old school record of 24.6 yards per carry, set by Rob Berger with 123 yards on five carries in a 63-24 win over Knox on Oct. 4, 2008. Becker's total was eight yards short of matching the most rushing yards in a game by a St. Norbert quarterback, with Berger running for 138 yards on seven carries in a 55-7 win over Grinnell on Sept. 13, 2008.

Brandon Carter (136 yards), Becker (130) and Curtiss Arndt (108) all had 100-yard rushing games, marking the first time in school history the Green Knights had three difference players hit the century mark in the same game.

Gopher Games:

St. Norbert is making a rare regular-season trip to Minnesota this week, only its fourth regular-season game in the Gopher State since 1977.

The Green Knights last played a regular-season game in Minnesota on Sept. 3, 2011 when it lost 20-7 at St. Thomas. St. Norbert also played at St. Thomas in 2002 (35-31 win) and at Hamline in 2000 (26-22 win). Prior to the Hamline game, the Green Knights' last appearance in Minnesota was a game at St. Thomas on Sept. 17, 1977 (24-0 loss).

St. Norbert has played three NCAA Division III Playoff games in Minnesota since 2001, two games at St. John's (27-20 loss in 2001 and 38-13 loss in 2003) and at St. Thomas (48-17 loss in 2012).

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert clinched its 17th consecutive winning season with its win over Ripon on Oct. 17. The Green Knights also surpassed last season's mark of 6-4 with their seventh win of the season against Beloit on Oct. 24.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 434-281-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .604. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 185-38, a winning percentage of .830.

St. Norbert has won 130 of its last 144 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .903.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is 196-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 117-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

* - St. Norbert is first in Division III in fourth-down conversion percentage (94.1 percent, 16-for-17) and is sixth in third-down conversion defense (25.3 percent, 25-for-99).
