The Series:

St. Norbert and Macalester are tied 1-1 in an all-time series begun in 2014, the year the Scots joined the Midwest Conference as an affiliate member. The visiting team has won both games, Macalester winning 21-13 in De Pere in 2014 and St. Norbert winning 25-16 last season in St. Paul.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert rallied to post a 25-16 win over Macalester on Nov. 7, 2015 at Macalester Stadium in St. Paul, Minn. The Green Knights, who outgained the Scots 313-285 in total offense, trailed 16-7 at halftime before scoring 18 unanswered second-half points to close out the win. Elijah Fort's 15-yard run gave St. Norbert a 7-3 lead after the first quarter, but Alec Beatty's pair of 1-yard touchdown runs in the second quarter put the Scots up 16-7 at halftime. The Green Knights countered with a 4-yard touchdown run by

Fort and a 48-yard field goal by Spenser Thompson-Meyers in the third quarter and a 2-yard touch-down run by Fort with 9:12 remain-ing to seal the win. Fort finished with 105 yards rushing and three touchdowns on 18 carries while Brad Boockmeier had 103 yards rushing on 21 carries. Zandy Stowell led Macalester with 136 yards rushing on 26 carries.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 15-4 in his second season in De Pere.

Macalester coach Tony Jennison (UW-La Crosse, 1997) is 46-42 in his ninth season in St. Paul.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert fell to 6-3 overall and 6-1 in the Midwest Conference fol-lowing a 38-14 setback this past Saturday at Monmouth. The Green Knights fell behind 21-0 after the first quarter and couldn't recover.

Senior quarterback J.T. Crosby has completed 120 of 213 passes for 1,643 yards with 20 touchdowns and seven interceptions and has also rushed for 418 yards on 91 car-ries and 11 touchdowns. Junior run-ning back Elijah Fort has a team-high 594 yards rushing on 117 car-ries with eight touchdowns. Freshman wide receiver Samuel Staehling has a team-high 27 recep-tions for 670 yards and nine touch-downs. Senior wide receiver Zach Reeves has 23 receptions for 283 yards and two touchdowns, while junior wide receiver Brett Olson has 20 receptions for 225 yards and four touchdowns.

Senior defensive back Ryan Grandlic, the reigning MWC Defensive Player of the Week, has 90 tackles after posting 26 tackles against Monmouth. Grandlic also has two interceptions and four fumble recoveries. Sophomore line-backer Matt Barrett has 85 tackles, while senior linebacker R.J. Callow has 47 tackles with seven tackles for loss and 2 1/2 quarterback sacks.

St. Norbert is averaging 40.1 points and 387.4 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are

allowing 20.9 points and 331.6 yards per game.

About the Scots:

Macalester enters the game 7-2 overall and 6-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Scots, who were idle this past Saturday, are coming off a 48-36 win over Cornell on Oct. 29 in St. Paul.

The Scots are led by sophomore quarterback Cody Petrich, who has completed 100 of 191 passes for 1,354 yards with seven touchdowns and three interceptions. Junior run-ning back Jacob Jones has a team-high 428 rushing yards on 111 car-ries and five touchdowns. Sophomore wide receiver Alec Beatty is leading Macalester in receiving with 40 catches for 595 yards and seven touchdowns, while senior wide receiver Garrett Eichhorn has 39 receptions for 666 yards and three touchdowns.

Macalester is led defensively by junior linebacker Phil Wetterstein, who has 79 tackles. Freshman defensive back Kiante Miles has 72 tackles, while senior linebacker Glen Hartford has 54 tackles and 10 tackles for loss. Senior defensive lineman Nick Egersdorf had 13 quarterback sacks and 15 tackles-for-loss.

Macalester is averaging 25.8 points and 399.7 yards per game. Defensively, the Scots are allowing 19.9 points and 374.1 yards per game.

Milestone Musings:

St. Norbert senior quarterback J.T. Crosby has thrown for 20 touch-down passes this season, just the 11th time in St. Norbert history that plateau has been reached.

Crosby is the first Green Knight to throw for at least 20 touchdown passes since Rob Berger threw 25 in 2010.

A quarterback has thrown for at least 21 just six times in program history, with Cody Craig's 30 in 2007 the school record.

Crosby also needs 120 yards of total offense in the season finale to move into the top 10 for total offen-sive yardage in a season. Luke Ott's

2,191 yards in 2000 in ninth and Ryan Hartman's 2,185 yards in 2002 is tenth.

Freshman wide receiver Samuel Staehling has nine touchdown receptions, a mark that is tied for 10th-most in St. Norbert history. He would become the 10th player in school history to catch at least 10 in a season with one against Macalester. Staehling would also be only the fifth to catch at least 10 touchdown passes in one season since 1993.

Joe Green was the most recent player to do it with 11 touchdown receptions in 2011. Judd O'Connell (2007) and Greg Benesh (1975) share the school record with 13.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert clinched its 18th consecutive winning season with a 56-20 win over Illinois College on Oct 29 at Schneider Stadium.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 442-285-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .605. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 192-39, a winning percentage of .831.

St. Norbert has won 137 of its last 152 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .901.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is second in NCAA Division III football in forced turnovers with 32 and in turnover margin at plus-2.22 per game. The Green Knights are also sixth nationally in defensive touchdowns with four.

* - St. Norbert senior quarterback J.T. Crosby is 14th in NCAA Division III football and tops in the Midwest Conference with 186 "points responsible for." Crosby has passed for 20 touchdowns and rushed for 11.

* - St. Norbert is 202-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 122-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 48-34 loss at Illinois College on Oct. 8, 2011.
