Game Overview:

St. Norbert wraps up non-conference action for 2016 with a trip to the western suburbs of Chicago to face Benedictine. The matchup is the first between the two schools since 1989.

The Series:

St. Norbert and Benedictine are tied 1-1 in an all-time series that dates back to 1988. The Green Knights defeated then-Illinois Benedictine College by a 30-12 score on Sept. 17, 1988 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. Benedictine won the return engagement the following season with a 14-10 triumph on Sept. 16, 1989 in Lisle, Ill.

Last Meeting:

Benedictine defeated St. Norbert 14-10 on Sept. 16, 1989 in Lisle, Ill. The Eagles took a 14-0 lead midway through the second quarter, but St. Norbert cut the deficit to 14-7 at halftime on a Tom Guetzloff 1-yard run just 10 seconds before halftime. John Bastuga's 26-yard field goal with 14:44 remaining were the game's final points. Greg Vanderfin completed 15 of 29 passes for 127 yards for St. Norbert, which had 251 yards of total offense. Todd McCormick completed 11 of 18 passes for 186 yards with two touchdowns for Benedictine, which had 326 yards of total offense.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 10-2 in his second season in De Pere.

Benedictine coach Josiah Sears (Indiana, 2007) is 0-1 in his first season in Lisle.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert opened the 2016 season this past Saturday with a 37-14 home loss to UW-Stevens Point. It was the Green Knights' first loss in a season opener since 2013.

The Green Knights were led offensively by senior quarterback J.T. Crosby, who completed 16 of 30 passes for 173 yards with one touchdown and two interceptions. Freshman wide receiver Bright Boachie had a team-high five receptions for 74 yards. Junior wide receiver Brett Olson had four catches for 24 yards, while junior running back Elijah Fort had four receptions for 17 yards.

Junior linebacker Ben Kornowski and senior defensive back Ryan Grandlic both finished with 11 tackles against Stevens point, with Kornowski registering three tacklesfor-loss. Junior defensive back Tyler Jensen finished with eight tackles.

St. Norbert is averaging 14.0 points and 177.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 37.0 points and 401.0 yards per game.

About the Eagles:

Benedictine enters the game at 0-1 overall. The Eagles lost their season opener at No. 8-ranked Wheaton (III.) by a 26-7 score this past Saturday.

Junior quarterback Ryan Sample led the Benedictine offense by competing 27 of 45 passes for 276 yards with one touchdown and two interceptions. Senior wide receiver Jake Valas caught nine passes for 82 yards, while senior wide receiver Elijah Walker hauled in six catches for 81 yards and one touchdown. Junior running back Derrick Miles rushed 13 times for 28 yards.

Junior linebacker Maison Bittner and senior defensive back Jarrett Lecas shared the team lead in tackles against Wheaton with eight apiece. Junior linebacker Victor Johnson had six tackles along with three fumble recoveries.

Benedictine is averaging 7.0 points and 276.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Eagles are allowing 26.0 points and 471.0 yards per game.

Passing Ponderings:

St. Norbert attempted 43 passes in Saturday's game against UW-Stevens Point, its most in a game since the 2011 season.

Senior J.T. Crosby completed 16 of 30 passes for 173 yards and one touchdown with two interceptions. Junior Jack Becker completed 5 of 13 passes for 32 yards against the Pointers. St. Norbert was 21-for-43 for 205 yards with one touchdown and two interceptions in the game.

The Green Knights last attempted that many passes in a game when they threw 44 times in a 48-34 loss at Illinois College on Oct. 8, 2011. Mike Fabrizio completed 24 of 44 passes for 311 yards with two touchdowns and three interceptions.

NACC Nuggets:

Saturday's game against Benedictine marks the first time St. Norbert will play a member of the Northern Athletic Collegiate Conference since the league was chartered in 2006.

The NACC has seven football playing members: Aurora, Benedictine, Concordia-Chicago, Concordia (Wis.), Lakeland, Rockford and Wisconsin Lutheran.

St. Norbert has played Lakeland twice (1961-62), Benedictine twice (1988-89) and Concordia (Wis.) four times (1992-95).

Benedictine is scheduled to return the home-and-home series to De Pere in 2017. Aurora and St. Norbert have scheduled a two-year series for the 2018 and 2019 seasons.

ties, with St. Norbert converting three and Stevens Point converting seven.

The Green Knights have not had 19 third-down conversion opportunities since Oct. 13, 2012, when they converted 14 in a 79-7 rout of Lawrence at Schneider Stadium.

St. Norbert was 2-for-2 on fourth-down opportunities. The Green Knights are now 18-for-23 (78.3 percent) on fourth-down conversions in Dan McCarty's 12-game head coaching tenure.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert clinched its 17th consecutive winning season with a 10-1 showing in 2015. The Green Knights claimed their first 10-win season since 2007 by topping Monmouth 16-7 in the 2015 Midwest Conference Championship game. It was St. Norbert's tenth unbeaten regular season all-time and fifth since 2000.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 436-283-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .604. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 186-38, a winning percentage of .830.

St. Norbert has won 131 of its last 145 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .903.

Quick Hitters:

- * Senior running back Brad Boockmeier and senior defensive back Alec Swanson have been named permanent captains for 2016. The Green Knights will also name two additional captains for each game on a game-by-game basis.
- * St. Norbert set a school record for punting yardage in a game with 496 yards against UW-Stevens Point. The previous mark was 489 yards against John Carroll in the 2013 season opener.
- * St. Norbert is 196-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 117-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 48-34 loss at Illinois College on Oct. 8, 2011.
