Game Overview:

St. Norbert opens Midwest Conference action with a trip to west-central Illinois to face Knox. The Green Knights are looking for their 17th Midwest Conference championship this season. St. Norbert is 131-14 in its last 145 Midwest Conference games.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds an 18-2 lead over Knox in a series dating back to the 1988 season. The Green Knights have won the last 15 meetings with the Prairie Fire, with Knox's last win coming in a 21-19 triumph in 1998 in Galesburg, Ill. St. Norbert, which holds a 793-304 scoring edge in the series, is 8-2 all-time on the road in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Knox 42-7 on Sept. 14, 2013 at Knosher Bowl in Galesburg, Ill. The Green Knights jumped out to a 28-0 halftime lead and went on to claim their 15th consecutive win in the series. Brad Boockmeier rushed 16 times for 167 yards and three touchdowns for St. Norbert, while James Tringali completed 10 of 14 passes for 163 yards and one touchdown. Michael Heim caught three passes for 111 yards and one touchdown. Derek Mortensen led Knox with 141 yards rushing on 23 attempts, while Luke

Oosterbaan completed 10 of 23 passes for 119 yards with one touchdown and two interceptions.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 10-3 in his second season in De Pere.

Knox coach Damon Tomeo (Pomona-Pitzer, 1999) is 6-26 in his fourth season in Galesburg. Tomeo was 14-30 in four seasons at Minnesota State-Moorhead to give him an overall record of 20-56 in eight seasons.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert fell to 0-2 overall when it lost a 34-14 decision at Benedictine this past Saturday. It marks the first time since 2010 the Green Knights have opened a season 0-2.

Senior quarterback J.T. Crosby has completed 38 of 68 passes for 375 yards with two touchdowns and four interceptions. Junior running back Elijah Fort has 130 yards rushing on 31 attempts and one touchdown. Junior wide receiver Drew Chavarria has 12 catches for 95 yards, while senior wide receiver Zach Reeves has seven receptions for 87 yards.

Senior defensive back Ryan Grandlic has a team-high 22 tackles. Sophomore linebacker Matt Barrett has 15 tackles, while junior linebacker Ben Kornowski has 14 tackles with four tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive back Alec Swanson has 14 tackles with four passes defended.

St. Norbert is averaging 14.0 points and 300.5 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 35.5 points and 441.5 yards per game.

About the Prairie Fire:

Knox enters this week's game 0-2 overall. The Prairie Fire opened its season with a 21-14 home loss to Eureka on Sept. 3 and followed with a 42-32 road loss at Beloit this past Saturday.

Junior quarterback Matt McCaffrey leads the Prairie Fire offense by completing 49 of 81 passes for 638 yards with three touchdowns and three interceptions. Sophomore wide receiver Dalton James has 16 receptions for 206 yards and one touchdown, while sophomore wide receiver Pat Marzolino has 11 catches for 134 yards and one touchdown. Senior running back Jared Zanger has a team-high 53 yards rushing on 14 carries.

Senior linebacker Brock Gabel and sophomore defensive back Logan Hollis share the team lead in tackles with 17 stops apiece. Sophomore linebacker Quinn Sharp and junior defensive back Donnye Sommerville both have 12 tackles apiece, with Sommerville totaling two passes defended.

Knox is averaging 23.0 points and 401.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Prairie Fire is allowing 31.5 points and 357.0 yards per game.

Passing Ponderings:

St. Norbert has attempted 87 passes in its two games this season, the most in the 11-team Midwest Conference.

The Green Knights' 87 pass attempts lead Knox (85 attempts) and Macalester (80) for most aerials lofted in the league. St. Norbert is averaging 5.0 yards per passing attempt.

Knox leads the MWC in passing offense at 331.0 yards per game, while Macalester is second at 315.5 yards per game. St. Norbert is fifth in passing offense at 216.0 yards per game.

Monmouth (311.5 yards passing per game) and Lake Forest (304.0) are third and fourth, respectively, in the MWC in passing offense.

Passing Ponderings II:

St. Norbert has attempted at least 43 passes in each of its two games this season.

The Green Knights threw 43 passes in their season opener, a 37-14 loss to UW-Stevens Point. St. Norbert then lofted 44 aerials in this past Saturday's 34-14 loss at Benedictine.

It marks the first time in 33 years the Green Knights have attempted at least 40 passes in consecutive games. St. Norbert attempted 46 passes on Sept. 17, 1983 in a 30-17 loss to

Dubuque. The Green Knights followed seven days later with 50 pass attempts in a 24-7 loss to UW-Stevens Point.

Start Stuff:

St. Norbert is 0-2 for the first time since 2010, but twice previously the Green Knights have rebounded from an 0-2 start to win the Midwest Conference championship and advance to the NCAA Division III Playoffs.

The Green Knights opened the 2010 season with a 40-7 loss to St. Thomas and a 34-31 loss at Beloit, but won seven of their last eight regular-season games to claim the MWC title and earn the league's automatic NCAA qualifier.

In 1989, St. Norbert lost to UW-Stevens Point 31-20 and Benedictine 14-10 - the same two opponents as this year - and won eight straight games to close the regular season. The Green Knights were awarded a berth in the 16-team NCAA Playoffs, which were all at-large berths at the time.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert clinched its 17th consecutive winning season with a 10-1 showing in 2015. The Green Knights claimed their first 10-win season since 2007 by topping Monmouth 16-7 in the 2015 Midwest Conference Championship game. It was St. Norbert's tenth unbeaten regular season all-time and fifth since 2000.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 436-284-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .603. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 186-38, a winning percentage of .830.

St. Norbert has won 131 of its last 145 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .903.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is 196-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 117-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 48-34 loss at Illinois College on Oct. 8, 2011.
