#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert makes the short trip down Interstate 41 to face Lawrence in another renewal of its Fox River Valley rivalry. The Green Knights are one of three unbeaten in Midwest Conference play along with Macalester and Monmouth.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 27-9-2 lead over Lawrence in a series begun in 1932. The Green Knights have won the last 18 meetings with the Vikings since a 27-24 Lawrence win in 1997 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. Lawrence claims only a 27-13-2 deficit in the series, but four games were played before St. Norbert began sponsoring full varsity intercollegiate football in 1931.

#### Last Meeting:

St. Norbert dispatched Lawrence 63-6 last season for a homecoming win for the Green Knights on Oct. 31, 2015 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights led 46-6 at halftime. St. Norbert had three players rush for over 100 yards - Brandon Carter (136), Jack Becker (130), Curtiss Arndt (108) as it ran for a school-record 508 yards on 49 carries. The Green Knights outgained the Vikings 664-188 in total offense. Elijah Fort had three touchdowns while

Becker and Arndt each scored two. Spenser Thompson-Meyers also kicked a school-record 51-yard field goal as the first half expired.

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 13-3 in his second season in De Pere.

Lawrence coach Rob McCarthy (Concordia-Moorhead, 1989) is 3-12 in his second season in Appleton.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert stands at 3-2 overall and 3-0 in the Midwest Conference after routing Beloit 68-28 this past Saturday in Beloit.

Senior quarterback J.T. Crosby has completed 63 of 113 passes for 933 yards with nine touchdowns and four interceptions while also rushing 46 times for 253 yards and six touchdowns. Junior running back Elijah Fort has 418 yards rushing on 80 carries and four touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Brett Olson had 13 catches for 156 yards and two touchdowns, while senior wide receiver Zach Reeves has 12 catches for 151 yards and one touchdown. Freshman wide receiver Samuel Staehling, the reigning MWC Offensive Player of the Week, has 10 catches for 333 yards and four touchdowns after netting 217 yards receiving against Beloit.

Senior defensive back Ryan Grandlic has a team-high 45 tackles. Sophomore linebacker Matt Barrett, the reigning MWC Defensive Player of the Week, has 43 tackles overall and returned a fumble 80 yards for a touchdown against Beloit. Senior linebacker R.J. Callow has 27 tackles while senior defensive back Alec Swanson has 26 stops.

St. Norbert is averaging 36.2 points and 421.2 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 24.6 points and 356.8 yards per game.

### About the Vikings:

Lawrence fell to 2-3 overall and 1-2 in the Midwest Conference with a 17-7 loss at Macalester this past Saturday in St. Paul, Minn.

Sophomore quarterback Ryan

Butterfield has completed 30 of 59 passes for 284 yards and one touchdown while rushing for 213 yards on 38 carries and two touchdowns. Junior running back Donnel Haley has a team-high 231 yards rushing on 49 carries and one touchdown. Freshman wide receiver Trevor Spina has 18 receptions for 212 yards and one touchdown.

Junior linebacker Jake Gostisha has a team-high 53 tackles along with three interceptions. Sophomore linebacker Hunter Adams has 36 tackles, while junior linebacker Dan Rothbauer has 32 tackles.

Lawrence is averaging 16.4 points and 313.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Vikings are allowing 20.2 points and 319.8 yards per game.

### Off to the Races:

St. Norbert freshman wide receiver Samuel Staehling enjoyed a breakout performance in Saturday's 68-28 win at Beloit.

Staehling finished with 217 yards receiving on four catches with three touchdowns, the fifth-highest single-game receiving yardage total in St. Norbert history. Staehling had receptions of 43, 60, 51 and 63 yards. It was the most receiving yards by a Green Knights since Steve Heim had 226 yards on seven catches against Monmouth on Sept. 22, 1984.

Staehling's 54.3 yards per reception is the second-most in a game in school history, trailing Brandon Spaulding's 63.0 (3-189) set against Ripon on Sept. 30, 2000.

Staehling is the current NCAA Division III national leader in yards per reception at 33.3 (10-333). Harwick's Koree Reed is second at 30.9 (25-773).

### Passing Fancy:

St. Norbert had an efficient passing day in Saturday's 68-28 win over Beloit. The Green Knights attempted just 14 passes, completing 10, but gained 402 yards in the process.

The passing total was the fifth-highest amount in school history, and the only time the 400-yard plateau through the air has been reached with less than 30 attempts.

Senior quarterback J.T. Crosby was 6-for-9 for 317 yards and four touchdowns, while junior Jack Becker was 4-for-5 for 85 yards and one touchdown.

Crosby finished with St. Norbert's first 300-yard passing game in four seasons. The previous low passing attempt and completion totals for a 300-yard game in school history was Dan Luedtke's 21 aerials with 14 completions against Monmouth on Sept. 20, 1997.

### Winning Ways:

St. Norbert clinched its 17th consecutive winning season with a 10-1 showing in 2015. The Green Knights claimed their first 10-win season since 2007 by topping Monmouth 16-7 in the 2015 Midwest Conference Championship game. It was St. Norbert's tenth unbeaten regular season all-time and fifth since 2000.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 439-284-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .604. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 189-38, a winning percentage of .833.

St. Norbert has won 134 of its last 148 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .905.

### Quick Hitters:

\* - St. Norbert had 668 yards of total offense in 57 plays against Beloit this past Saturday, an average of 11.7 yards per play. It marked the first time in school history the Green Knights averaged more than 10 yards per play from scrimmage in a game.

\* - St. Norbert sophomore line-backer Matt Barrett's 80-yard fumble return for a touchdown is the second-longest "scoop and score" in school history. Scott Wuensch holds the school record with a 95-yard return against Wartburg on Sept. 6, 2008.

\* - St. Norbert is 199-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 119-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 48-34 loss at Illinois College on Oct. 8, 2011.
