The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 19-3 series lead over Illinois College in a series begun in 1984. The Green Knights won the first nine meetings in the series before the Blueboys won 41-40 on Nov. 10, 2001 at Jacksonville, Ill. St. Norbert had then won the next eight meetings before the Blueboys captured games in 2010 and 2011. The Green Knights have won the last two meetings.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert pulled away with two fourth-quarter touchdowns to beat Illinois College 21-2 on Sept. 26, 2015 at England Stadium in Jacksonville, Ill. The Green Knights led 7-0 at halftime and 7-2 after three quarters before Jack Becker's 26-yard run and Elijah Fort's 1-yard run provided the game's final margin. St. Norbert outgained Illinois College 291-289 in total offense. Brad Boockmeier rushed 22 times for 96 yards and one touchdown, while Becker

completed 14 of 19 passes for 130 yards. Brady Huber completed 21 of 37 passes for 196 yards for the Blueboys but was intercepted three times. Bo Davis added 49 yards rushing on 10 carries.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 15-3 in his second season in De Pere.

Illinois College coach Ray DeFrisco (North Park, 2002) is 5-3 in his first season in Jacksonville.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert moved to 5-2 overall and 5-0 in the Midwest Conference after topping Ripon 48-7 this past Saturday in De Pere. It was the Green Knights' 18th consecutive Homecoming victory.

Senior quarterback J.T. Crosby has completed 89 of 153 passes for 1,268 yards with 15 touchdowns and five interceptions and has also rushed for 381 yards on 67 carries and nine touchdowns. Junior running back Elijah Fort has a team-high 521 yards rushing on 101 carries with seven touchdowns. Freshman wide receiver Samuel Staehling has a team-high 20 receptions for 537 yards and seven touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Zach Reeves has 15 receptions for 169 yards and one touchdown, while junior wide receiver Brett Olson has 15 receptions for 164 yards and three touchdowns.

Sophomore linebacker Matt Barrett tops the defense with 60 tackles. Senior defensive back Ryan Grandlic has 53 tackles with two interceptions and three fumble recoveries. Senior linebacker R.J. Callow, the reigning MWC Defensive Player of the Week, has 39 tackles.

St. Norbert is averaging 41.6 points and 422.7 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 18.6 points and 313.6 yards per game.

About the Blueboys:

Illinois College enters the game with a 5-3 overall record and a 4-2 mark in the Midwest Conference.

The Blueboys had a four-game winning streak snapped in a 69-7 home loss to Monmouth this past Saturday.

Sophomore running back Jason Barbour leads the Blueboys in rushing with 403 yards on 87 attempts and five touchdowns. Junior running back Greg Cross has 212 yards rushing on 63 carries with four touchdowns. Junior quarterback Blake Matson has completed 83 of 137 passes for 961 yards with nine touchdowns and one interception. Junior wide receiver Logan Uyetake has caught 38 passes for 535 yards and four touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Austin Ellsworth has caught 32 passes for 498 yards and four touchdowns.

Junior linebacker Matt Graef leads Illinois College with 80 tackles and nine tackles-for-loss. Junior linebacker Ryan Torrence has 67 tackles, while junior defensive back Steve Reyna has 43 tackles.

Illinois College is averaging 30.3 points and 417.5 yards per game. Defensively, the Blueboys are allowing 30.8 points and 373.6 yards per game.

Turnover Talk:

St. Norbert enjoyed a boffo afternoon taking away the football in a 48-7 win over Ripon this past Saturday. The Green Knights recorded four interceptions and recovered three fumbles - two of which were returned for touchdowns.

The Green Knights did not commit a turnover against the Red Hawks giving it a whopping plus-7 in turnover ratio. St. Norbert last had seven takeaways in a game in a 48-2 win over Monmouth on Oct. 2, 2010. The Green Knights had five interceptions and recovered two fumbles.

St. Norbert surged to the NCAA Division III lead in turnover margin following the game at plus-2.71 per game (26 takeaways, seven giveaways). Mary Hardin-Baylor is second nationally at plus-2.29 per game, while UW-Whitewater and Sul Ross State are tied for third at plus-2.14 per game.

The Green Knights are fourth nationally in fumbles recovered with 13. Sul Ross State is the national

leader with 16 while Westminster-Mo. and Mass.-Maritime have both recovered 14.

Hundred Thrice:

St. Norbert freshman wide receiver Samuel Staehling has recorded three consecutive games with 100 yards receiving after catching eight passes for 100 yards and two touchdowns in Saturday's 48-7 win over Ripon.

Staehling had 217 yards in a 68-28 win over Beloit on Oct. 8 and then added 104 yards in a 62-0 win over Lawrence on Oct. 15.

Staehling became the first St. Norbert player since 2009 to record three straight games with 100 yards receiving. Jeremy Gezella had 102 yards against Knox on Oct. 3, 2009, followed by 104 yards against Monmouth and 136 yards against Carroll the next two weeks.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert clinched its 17th consecutive winning season with a 10-1 showing in 2015. The Green Knights claimed their first 10-win season since 2007 by topping Monmouth 16-7 in the 2015 Midwest Conference Championship game. It was St. Norbert's tenth unbeaten regular season all-time and fifth since 2000.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 441-284-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .605. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 191-38, a winning percentage of .834.

St. Norbert has won 136 of its last 150 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .907.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is ninth in NCAA Division III in defensive touchdowns scored with three. St. Lawrence and Mary Hardin-Baylor are tied for the national lead with six.

* - St. Norbert is 201-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 121-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 48-34 loss at Illinois College on Oct. 8, 2011.
