Game Overview:

St. Norbert and Monmouth meet for sole possession of first place in the Midwest Conference and at least a share of the conference championship. The game is a rematch of last season's MWC Championship Game, claimed by St. Norbert in a 16-7 win in De Pere.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 22-7 series lead over Monmouth in a series that began in 1975. The Green Knights have won 13 of the last 18 games in the series, but the two teams have split the last 10 meetings. St. Norbert is 11-4 all-time at Monmouth in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert captured its 16th Midwest Conference championship by defeating Monmouth 16-7 in the 2015 Midwest Conference Championship Game at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. St. Norbert did not commit a turnover while forcing five by the Fighting Scots. The Green Knights led 3-0 at halftime and 10-0 after three quarters before holding on for the win. Spenser Thompson-Meyers kicked a 39-yard field goal early in the second quarter, and Jack Becker hit Grant Murray with a 2-yard touchdown pass late in the third quarter. Monmouth countered with a 2-yard touchdown

run from Trent Rains early in the fourth quarter to cut the deficit to 10-7. Thompson-Meyers kicked field goals of 24 and 38 yards down the stretch to seal the win. Becker completed 7 of 14 passes for 165 yards, while Elijah Fort rushed 18 times for 83 yards. Zach Reeves caught two passes for 116 yards. Monmouth quarterback Tanner Matlick completed 18 of 32 passes for 194 yards with three interceptions. DeAndre Wright rushed 13 times for 59 yards, while Rains had 57 yards on 12 carries and one touchdown.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 15-3 in his second season in De Pere.

Monmouth coach Chad Braun (Illinois College, 1995) is 16-2 in his second season in Monmouth.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved to 6-2 overall and 6-0 in the Midwest Conference after defeating Illinois College 56-20 this past Saturday in De Pere. It ensured the Green Knights' 18th consecutive winning season.

Senior quarterback J.T. Crosby has completed 110 of 191 passes for 1,508 yards with 19 touchdowns and six interceptions and has also rushed for 442 yards on 77 carries and 10 touchdowns. Junior running back Elijah Fort has a team-high 586 yards rushing on 113 carries with eight touchdowns. Freshman wide receiver Samuel Staehling has a team-high 23 receptions for 569 yards and eight touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Zach Reeves has 21 receptions for 266 yards and one touchdown, while junior wide receiver Brett Olson has 20 receptions for 225 yards and four touchdowns.

Sophomore linebacker Matt Barrett leads the defense with 71 tackles and two fumble recoveries. Senior defensive back Ryan Grandlic has 64 tackles with two interceptions and three fumble recoveries. Senior linebacker R.J. Callow has 44 tackles with 6 1/2 tackles for loss and 2 1/2 quarterback sacks.

St. Norbert is averaging 43.4 points and 418.1 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 18.8 points and 314.4 yards per game.

About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters the game unbeaten at 8-0 overall and 6-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Fightings Scots, ranked No. 20 in the AFCA Division III Poll and No. 25 by D3football.com, are coming off a 52-9 win at Beloit this past Saturday.

quarterback Senior Tanner Matlick powers the Monmouth offense with a Division III-best 217.63 quarterback rating. Matlick has completed 119 of 162 (73.5 percent) passes for 1,940 yards with 22 touchdowns and one interception. Junior wide receiver Brock Thomas has caught 38 passes for 694 yards and seven touchdowns, while freshman wide receiver Jacolby Maxwell has 27 receptions for 405 yards and five touchdowns. Sophomore running back DeAndre Wright has 896 yards rushing on 101 attempts (8.9 yards per carry) with 11 touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Matt Barnes has 88 tackles to lead a Monmouth defense which has allowed just eight touchdowns this season. Junior linebacker Kyle Schultz has 56 tackles, while senior nickel Michael Smith has 39 tackles. Senior nickel Logan Gigl has 37 tackles with 12 1/2 tackles-for-loss and seven quarterback sacks.

Monmouth is averaging 49.3 points and 530.5 yards per game. Defensively, the Fighting Scots are allowing 7.6 points and 215.6 yards per game.

Tale of the Tape:

St. Norbert and Monmouth are both at or near the top of the Midwest Conference in several statistical categories.

The Fighting Scots and Green Knights are the conference leaders in scoring at 49.2 (fifth in Division III) and 43.4 (13th in Division III)

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert clinched its 18th consecutive winning season with this past Saturday's 56-20 win over Illinois College.

The Green Knights have an alltime record of 442-284-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .606. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 192-38, a winning percentage of .835.

St. Norbert has won 137 of its last 151 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .907.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is leading NCAA Division III football in forced turnovers with 30 and in turnover margin at plus-2.38 per game. The Green Knights are also fifth nationally in defensive touchdowns with four.

* - St. Norbert senior quarterback J.T. Crosby is ninth in NCAA Division III football and tops in the Midwest Conference with 174 "points responsible for." Crosby has passed for 19 touchdowns and rushed for 10.

* - St. Norbert is looking for its 17th Midwest Conference football championship since joining the conference in 1984. The Green Knights are currently tied with Lawrence for third-most title in league history. Coe has the most football titles with 21, while Ripon is second with 19. Ripon and Lawrence both played its 90th MWC football season this year, while Coe was in the MWC for 72 football seasons. Monmouth has 11 football titles.

* - St. Norbert is 202-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 122-2 all-time when scoring 40-ormore points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 48-34 loss at Illinois College on Oct. 8, 2011.
