#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert and Monmouth meet to decide the 2017 Midwest Conference titleist in the league's championship game. The winner also earns the league's automatic qualifier to the NCAA Division III Playoffs. Both teams went unbeaten against Midwest Conference opposition this season.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 22-8 series lead over Monmouth in a series that began in 1975. The Green Knights have won 13 of the last 19 games in the series, but the Monmouth holds a 6-5 edge in the last 11 meetings. St. Norbert is 11-5 all-time at Monmouth in the series. The Green Knights are also 4-0 all-time against Monmouth in MWC Championship Games.

#### Last Meeting:

Monmouth topped St. Norbert 38-14 on Nov. 5, 2016 at Zorn Memorial Stadium in Monmouth, Ill. The Fighting Scots jumped out to a 21-0 lead after the first quarter and held a 31-7 edge after three quarters. Monmouth held a 469-142 edge in total offense and a 27-7 nod in first downs. J.T. Crosby completed 10 of 22 passes for 135 yards with one touchdown and one interception. Samuel Staehling caught four passes for 101 yards and one touchdown. Tanner Matlick paced Monmouth, completing 20 of 28 passes for 203 yards. DeAndre Wright rushed 33 times for 155 yards and

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 23-6 in his third season in De Pere.

Monmouth coach Chad Braun (Illinois College, 1995) is 26-4 in his third season in Monmouth.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the championship game 7-2 overall after finishing an unblemished 5-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Green Knights closed out North Division play with a 47-7 win over Beloit this past Saturday in De Pere.

Sophomore wide receiver Samuel Staehling, the reigning MWC Offensive Player of the Week, reeled in three touchdown passes against Beloit to set a new school season record of 16. He has 40 receptions for 908 yards. Senior quarterback Jack Becker has completed 95 of 174 passes for 1,597 yards with 24 touchdowns and five interceptions. Senior running back Elijah Fort has 588 yards on 122 attempts and six touchdowns, while sophomore running back Jadon Sackman has 355 yards rushing on 63 carries and three touchdowns.

Junior linebacker Matt Barrett leads the Green Knights in tackles with 52. Junior linebacker Matt Gurgone has 43 stops with 16 tackles-for-loss. Senior linebacker Ben Kornowski has 34 tackles and 11.5 tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive back Hunter Prokash has 31 tackles with a team-high three interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 36.2 points and 400.2 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 12.6 points and 261.0 yards per game.

### About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters the championship game 8-1 overall after finishing MWC South Division play 5-0. The Fighting Scots, whose only loss was a 36-13 setback at Wartburg on Sept. 9, is coming off a 52-10 win over Knox this past Saturday.

Junior running back DeAndre Wright leads the Scots on the ground with 941 yards rushing on 168 carries with 12 touchdowns. Junior quarterback Hayden Nelson has completed 122 of 209 passes for 1,583 yards with 20 touchdowns and 11 interceptions. Junior wide receiver Yansay Williams has caught 31 passes for 465 yards and nine touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Kyle Schultz leads Monmouth with 87 tackles. Sophomore linebacker Clark Gaden has 57 tackles, while senior defensive back D.J. Frank has 44 stops. Junior defensive back Lamar Watson has a team-high 6 1/2 quarterback sacks with 11 tackles-for-loss.

Monmouth is averaging 40.3 points and 422.3 yards per game. Defensively, the Fighting Scots are allowing 10.8 points and 205.0 yards per game.

### Chipper Chatter:

The 2017 Midwest Conference championship game marks the return the North and South divisional winners meeting for the conference title.

The MWC held championship games in 1976 and 1977, and then from 1982-97 until Coe and Cornell departed for the IIAC. The league again had MWC title games in 2014 and 2015 before a one-year hiatus.

St. Norbert is 4-0-1 in MWC Championship games, defeating Monmouth in all four wins. The Green Knights won 20-15 at Monmouth in 1987, 12-0 in De Pere in 1988, 17-6 at Monmouth in 1989 and 16-7 in De Pere in 2015. St. Norbert battled Coe to a 7-7 tie in the 1985 title game.

### House Calls:

Sophomore wide receiver Samuel Staehling grabbed three receiving touchdowns in this past Saturday's 47-7 win over Beloit and broke the St. Norbert season record in the process.

Staehling now has 16 touchdown receptions in nine games this season. That total snapped a tie with Greg Benesh (1975) and Judd O'Connell (2007) for most touch-

down receptions in a season in school history at 13.

Staehling's 16 touchdown receptions are tied for the NCAA Division III lead with Franklin's Deontez Alexander. The only other player at all levels of NCAA football with that total is West Virginia's David Sills, who also has 16.

Staehling is third in school history in career touchdown receptions with 25 despite having played in just 19 collegiate games. He trails Mike Whitehouse (37, 1986-89) and Joe Green (27, 2009-12).

### Mirror, Mirror:

St. Norbert and Monmouth are virtually even in major statistical categories.

Monmouth has an edge in both scoring offense (40.3-36.2) and scoring defense (10.8-12.6). The Fighting Scots also have a small nod in total offense (422.3-400.2) and total defense (205.0-261.0).

The Green Knights have the fourth-best rushing defense in the country at 52.4 yards per game. Monmouth is yielding 93.3 yards per game on the ground.

### Winning Ways:

With its win over Macalester on Oct. 28, St. Norbert clinched its 19th consecutive winning season.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 450-287-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .608. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 198-39, a winning percentage of .835.

St. Norbert has won 143 of its last 158 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .905.

### Quick Hitters:

\* - St. Norbert is second nationally in Division III this season with six blocked punts.

\* - St. Norbert is 208-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 126-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017.
