The Series:

Benedictine leads St. Norbert 2-1 in an all-time series that dates back to 1988. The Green Knights defeated then-Illinois Benedictine College by a 30-12 score on Sept. 17, 1988 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. Benedictine won the return engagement the following season with a 14-10 triumph on Sept. 16, 1989 in Lisle, Ill. The two teams then met last year in Lisle, Ill., a 34-14 Eagles' win.

Last Meeting:

Benedictine beat St. Norbert 34-14 on Sept. 10, 2016 at The Sports Complex in Lisle, Ill. The Eagles jumped out to a 28-0 halftime lead and outgained St. Norbert 482-424. J.T. Crosby completed 22 of 38 passes for 202 yards with one touchdown and one interception, while Elijah Fort had 23 rushes for 130 yards for the Green Knights. Ryan Sample completed 24 of 38 passes for 372 yards and four touchdowns for Benedictine.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 17-5 in his third season in De Pere.

Benedictine coach Josiah Sears (Indiana, 2007) is 6-5 in his second season in Lisle.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 0-1 overall after suffering a tough 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point this past Saturday.

The Green Knights are led on the ground by senior running back Elijah Fort, who has 34 carries for 107 yards and two touchdowns. Senior quarterback Jack Becker completed 17 of 33 passes for 218 vards with two touchdowns, and also rushed 13 times for 60 yards. Sophomore wide receiver Samuel Staehling caught seven passes for 87 yards and two touchdowns. Iunior wide receiver Drew Chavarria had three catches for 25 vards.

Defensively, senior defensive back Tyler Jensen leads the Green Knights in tackles with nine. Senior defensive back Hunter Prokash had eight tackles with one interception and one fumble recovery. Junior linebackers Matt Barrett and Matt Gurgone had seven tackles apiece. Gurgone had 3 1/2 tackles-for-loss.

St. Norbert is averaging 33.0 points and 390.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 34.0 points and 459.0 yards per game.

About the Eagles:

Benedictine enters the game coming off a 57-14 loss to No. 6-ranked Wheaton this past Saturday in Lisle, Ill.

Senior quarterback Ryan Sample completed 17 of 35 passes for 149 yards with one touchdown and one interception. Junior running back Josh Williams had a team-high 39 yards on 15 carries. Junior running back Grant Jochums had five receptions for 41 yards, while senior wide receiver Dean Pauley had five catches for 23 yards.

Senior defensive back Mark Hammond posted a team-high 10 tackles against Wheaton. Senior linebacker Austin Nirva and junior defensive back Chris Brandon had seven tackles apiece.

Benedictine is averaging 14.0 points and 210.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Eagles are allowing 57.0 points and 545.0 yards per game.

Fort Facts:

Senior running back Elijah Fort carried the ball 34 times for a net of 107 yards and two touchdowns in this past Saturday's 34-33 double-overtime loss to UW-Stevens Point.

Fort's 34 carries are the most for a St. Norbert running back since Aljay Wren had 38 totes in a 20-6 win over Lake Forest on Nov. 8, 2003.

Fort now has 29 career rushing touchdowns to sit fifth all-time in school history. Casey Meehan is the career leader with 42 from 2002-05. Larry Krause (39, 1966-69), A.J. Phillips (32, 2005-08) and Jason Augustynowicz (31, 1998-2001) are the top four.

Overtime Observations:

St. Norbert's 34-33 loss to UW-Stevens Point this past Saturday was the ninth overtime game in school history, and just the third double-overtime affair.

The Green Knights are now 6-3 all-time in overtime games, and had a five-game winning streak in overtime snapped. St. Norbert's last overtime game came in a 28-21 win over Carroll on Sept. 22, 2012 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere.

St. Norbert's previous doubleovertime games came in an 18-17 win over Carroll on Nov. 1, 1997 and a 26-20 triumph over Simpson on Nov. 22, 2003 in the first round of the NCAA Division III Playoffs. Both games were at Minahan Stadium in De Pere.

NACC Nuggets:

Saturday's game against Benedictine marks the second time St. Norbert will play a member of the Northern Athletic Collegiate Conference since the league was chartered in 2006. The Green Knights

The NACC has seven football playing members: Aurora, Benedictine, Concordia-Chicago, Concordia (Wis.), Lakeland, Rockford and Wisconsin Lutheran. Eureka will join the NACC in 2018.

St. Norbert has played Lakeland twice (1961-62), Benedictine twice previously (1988-89) and Concordia (Wis.) four times (1992-95).

Aurora and St. Norbert have scheduled a two-year series for the 2018 and 2019 seasons.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert had its 18th consecutive winning season in 2016.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 443-286-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .605. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 193-39, a winning percentage of .832.

St. Norbert has won 138 of its last 153 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .902.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert posted 172 rushing yards against UW-Stevens Point, the most in eight games against a Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference opponent. It was the most since the Green Knights totaled 184 yards against UW-La Crosse in a 37-23 loss in the first round of the NCAA Division III Playoffs of Nov. 20, 2004.
- * St. Norbert's 33 points against UW-Stevens Point marked the first time in 74 games the Green Knights scored at least that many points against a Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foe. It was the most since a 34-0 win over UW-La Crosse on Oct. 3, 1970.
- * St. Norbert is 203-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 122-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017.
