#### **Game Overview:**

St. Norbert travels to Grinnell for the first time since the 2012 season when it takes on the Pioneers this Saturday. The game is the first of two crossover games with a Midwest Conference South Division opponent, neither of which count in the standings.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert holds an 19-1 lead in the all-time series, which began in 1986. Grinnell's only win in the series came in a 49-28 win in 1998 in De Pere, a year when the Pioneers went 10-0. The Green Knights have won the last 15 meetings in the series.

#### **Last Meeting:**

St. Norbert blanked Grinnell 23-0 on Nov. 9, 2013 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. Brad Boockmeier scored on a 66-yard run on the first play from scrimmage and Randy Hill kicked field goals of 32, 22 and 24 yards for the Green Knights. Boockmeier finished with 127 yards rushing on 21 carries and also caught five passes for 29 yards. T.J. Goetz led Grinnell with 159 passing yards, completing 20 of 43 aerials but was intercepted five times.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 17-6 in his third season in De Pere. This is his first meeting with Grinnell.

Grinnell coach Jeff Pedersen (Grinnell, 2002) is 21-51 in his eighth season in Grinnell. He is 0-5 all-time against St. Norbert.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the game 0-2 overall after dropping a 29-7 decision at home to Benedictine on Sept. 9. The Green Knights, along with the rest of the Midwest Conference, were idle this past Saturday.

The Green Knights are led on the ground by senior running back Elijah Fort, who has 56 carries for 175 yards and two touchdowns. Senior quarterback Jack Becker has completed 21 of 41 passes for 254 yards with two touchdowns, and also rushed 17 times for 51 yards. Sophomore wide receiver Samuel Staehling has nine atches for 108 yards and two touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Drew Chavarria has five receptions for 47 yards.

Senior defensive back Hunter Prokash and junior linebacker share the team lead in tackles with 14. Junior linebacker Matt Gurgone has 12 tackles with 5 1/2 tackles-forloss. Senior defensive back Tyler Jensen has 12 tackles, while senior defensive back Bison Woods has 11 stops.

St. Norbert is averaging 20.0 points and 293.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 31.5 points and 498.5 yards per game.

#### **About the Pioneers:**

Grinnell enters Saturday's game 1-1 overall. The Pioneers are coming off a 15-6 win over Trinity Bible on Sept. 9 in Ellendale, N.D.

Senior running back Carson Dunn leads the Pioneers in rushing with 44 carries for 231 yards and two touchdowns. Dunn is also the leading receiver with 14 receptions for 93 yards. Senior quarterback Tony Bergida has completed 41 of 73 passes for 332 yards and two touchdowns and four interceptions.

Sophomore wide receiver David Taylor has caught 10 passes for 108 yards and one touchdown, while sophomore wide receiver Max Hill has 10 receptions for 68 yards.

Junior linebacker Ryan Slager leads the Pioneers defensively with 29 tackles with two tackles-for-loss and one quarterback sack. Junior defensive lineman Jeff Keele has 11 tackles, while junior linebacker Hassan Thompson has made 10 stops.

Grinnell is averaging 14.0 points and 294.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Pioneers are allowing 31.0 points and 281.0 yards per game.

#### **Crossover Comments:**

The 2017 season marks the return of the two crossover games against Midwest Conference North and South Division opponents prior to divisional play starting in Week 6.

St. Norbert joined the Midwest Conference for football in 1984 and divisional play continued until 1997. Divisional play returned in 2014 and 2015 before taking a one-year hiatus.

The Green Knights are 24-8 all-time in the crossover games against the South Division. St. Norbert has lost both of its crossover games in a season only once - in defeates to Coe and Knox in 1995 en route to a 1-8 finish.

#### **Fort Facts:**

Senior running back Elijah Fort is two points away from reaching 200 career points.

Fort has 33 overall touchdowns at St. Norbert, with 29 rushing, three receiving and one on a punt return, for 198 points.

Fort's 29 career rushing touch-downs place him fifth all-time in school history. Casey Meehan is the career leader with 42 from 2002-05. Larry Krause (39, 1966-69), A.J. Phillips (32, 2005-08) and Jason Augustynowicz (31, 1998-2001) are the top four.

Fort's 56 rushing attempts are the second-highest total in the Midwest Conference. He trails Lake Forest's Joey Valdivia's 63 carries.

#### **Start Stuff:**

St. Norbert is 0-2 for the second time since 2010, but twice previously the Green Knights have rebounded from an 0-2 start to win the Midwest Conference championship and advance to the NCAA Division III Playoffs.

The Green Knights opened the 2010 season with a 40-7 loss to St. Thomas and a 34-31 loss at Beloit, but won seven of their last eight regular-season games to claim the MWC title and earn the league's automatic NCAA qualifier.

In 1989, St. Norbert lost to UW-Stevens Point 31-20 and Benedictine 14-10 - the same two opponents as this year - and won eight straight games to close the regular season. The Green Knights were awarded a berth in the 16-team NCAA Playoffs, which were all at-large berths at the time.

St. Norbert also started 0-2 last season and went 7-1 in Midwest Conference play to finish in second place.

#### Winning Ways:

St. Norbert had its 18th consecutive winning season in 2016.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 443-287-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .604. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 193-39, a winning percentage of .832.

St. Norbert has won 138 of its last 153 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .902.

#### **Quick Hitters:**

- \* St. Norbert has lived up to its name, being the least penalized team in the Midwest Conference at 17.5 yards per game. St. Norbert opponents have the most penalty yardage at a whopping 123.5 yards per game.
- \* St. Norbert is 203-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 122-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017.
