#### **Game Overview:**

It's Ripon Week as St. Norbert travels south as the Red Hawks' Homecoming guest. The game is the Midwest Conference North Division opener for both teams.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert owns a 27-10 lead over Ripon in a hotly contested series that dates back to 1979. St. Norbert has won 17 of the last 18 meetings in the series, the Green Knights' lone blemish a 19-7 Ripon win at Ingalls Field in 2008. The Green Knights are 12-6 all-time at Ripon in the series and hold an all-time 1,129-691 scoring edge in the rivalry.

#### **Last Meeting:**

St. Norbert defeated Ripon 48-7 on Oct. 22, 2016 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Red Hawks scored on the first place of the second quarter on a 16-yard touchdown run by Samuel Shroyer, but the Green Knights would score seven consecutive touchdowns to close out the win. St. Norbert, which scored two defensive touchdowns, outgained Ripon 303-211. J.T. Crosby completed 14 of 21 passes for 136 yards and four touchdowns, while Samuel Staehling caught eight passes for 100 yards and two scores. Shroyer had a team-high 60 yards rushing on 18 carries for Ripon.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 19-6 in his third season in De Pere. He is 2-0 all-time against Ripon.

Ripon coach Ron Ernst (Nebraska Wesleyan, 1980) is 163-96 in his 27th season in Ripon.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the game 2-2 overall after dispatching Knox 61-17 this past Saturday in De Pere. The Green Knights have scored 127 points in their last two games.

Senior quarterback Jack Becker has completed 37 of 64 passes for 637 yards with 10 touchdowns. Sophomore wide receiver Samuel Staehling, the reigning MWC Offensive Player of the Week, has 16 receptions for 391 yards and eight touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Drew Chavarria has eight catches for 80 yards. Senior running back Elijah Fort has rushed for 504 yards on 96 carries and six touchdowns.

Junior linebacker Matt Gurgone has a team-high 23 tackles with eight tackles-for-loss, also a team best. Junior linebacker Matt Barrett has 20 tackles, while senior defensive back Hunter Prokash has 17 tackles and a team-high two interceptions. Senior defensive back Tyler Jensen has 15 tackles and a team-high six passes defended.

St. Norbert is averaging 41.8 points and 413.2 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 23.2 points and 357.2 yards per game.

#### **About the Red Hawks:**

Ripon enters the game 1-3 overall. The Red Hawks are coming off their first win of the season, a 55-0 triumph over Grinnell this past Saturday at Ingalls Field.

Freshman quarterback Julian Patton leads the Red Hawks' option offense with 343 yards rushing on 62 carries with six touchdowns. Sophomore running back Tyler VanDeVelde has 213 yards rushing on 41 carries and two touchdowns. Patton has completed 13 of 30 passes for 153 yards and two touch-

downs with five interceptions. Junior wide receiver Cameron Mignone has caught nine passes for 163 yards and two touchdowns.

Defensively, sophomore line-backer Lane Barnes leads the Red Hawks with 37 tackles. Junior line-backer Ethan Hoffman has 28 tackles, while senior linebacker Hunter Gruenwald has 25 tackles. Sophomore defensive back Cameron Gruenwald has a teamhigh three interceptions.

Ripon is averaging 23.8 points and 323.2 yards per game. Defensively, the Red Hawks are allowing 21.5 points and 291.5 yards per game.

#### **Streaking Staehling:**

Sophomore wide receiver Samuel Staehling has touched the ball seven times in St. Norbert's last two games, with six going for touchdowns.

Staehling was named MWC Offensive Player of the Week after hauling in four passes for 177 yards and three touchdowns in a 61-17 win over Knox this past Saturday. Staehling caught three passes for 106 yards and three touchdowns in a 66-13 win over Grinnell on Sept. 23.

Staehling, the MWC Newcomer of the Year last season, shares the conference lead with eight touchdown receptions, also good for fifth nationally in NCAA Division III. His 17 career touchdown receptions are already tied for fourth best in St. Norbert career annals.

#### **Becker Bullets:**

Senior quarterback Jack Becker has seen his efficiency rating rise to a lusty 186.73 through four games.

His rating leads the Midwest Conference and is currently fifth nationally in NCAA Division III.

Becker is also 11th nationally in yards per completion at 17.2 yards per reception.

#### **Running Rhodes:**

Senior defensive back Drew Rhodes has given the Green Knights a strong weapon in the returning kicks.

Rhodes has returned seven punts for an average of 23.1 yards per return, which is good for second nationally in NCAA Division III. His mark trails only Mount Union's Jared Ruth's 24.6 yards per return.

Rhodes has also returned seven kickoffs for an average of 21.0 yards per return.

#### **Sixty Twice:**

St. Norbert scored 66 points against Grinnell on Sept. 23 and 61 against Knox this past Saturday. It marked the third time in school history the Green Knights have scored at least 60 points in consecutive games.

The Green Knights scored 62 and 63 points against Lake Forest and Knox on Sept. 27-Oct. 4, 2008. They also scored 68 and 62 points against Beloit and Lawrence on Oct. 8-15, 2016. The 130 points in those two games are a school record for points in consecutive games.

#### Winning Ways:

St. Norbert had its 18th consecutive winning season in 2016.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 445-287-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .605. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 193-39, a winning percentage of .832.

St. Norbert has won 138 of its last 153 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .902.

#### **Quick Hitters:**

- \*- Senior running back Elijah Fort's 33 career rushing touchdowns place him third all-time in school history. Casey Meehan is the career leader with 42 from 2002-05. Larry Krause (39, 1966-69), A.J. Phillips (32, 2005-08) and Jason Augustynowicz (31, 1998-2001) are the top four.
- \* St. Norbert is 205-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 124-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017.
