St. Norbert faces Chicago for the first time in 30 years in a key Midwest Conference North Division game. The Green Knights also put an 18-game Homecoming winning streak on the line against the Maroons.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Chicago 3-1 in an all-time series dating back to 1984. The Green Knights opened the series with a 27-0 win at Stagg Field in Chicago on Nov. 3, 1984. The Maroons topped the Green Knights 7-6 in De Pere on Nov. 2, 1985. St. Norbert then won the last two games 24-15 on Nov. 8, 1986 in Chicago and 23-7 on Nov. 7, 1987 in De Pere.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Chicago 23-7 on Nov. 7, 1987 in front of a crowd of 2,647 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights erased a 7-6 half-time deficit with 17 unanswered second-half points. Karl Zacharias kicked field goals of 43, 40 and 34 yards, while Greg Vanderfin hit Mike Whitehouse on a 29-yard touchdown and ran for a 10-yard score. Vanderfin threw for 139 yards, while Whitehouse caught eight passes for 136 yards.

Scott Gross completed 12 of 36 passes for 162 yards for the Maroons, but was intercepted five times.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 20-6 in his third season in De Pere.

Chicago coach Chris Wilkerson (Eastern Illinois, 1995) is 27-17 in his fifth season on the Midway.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 3-2 overall and 1-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division after blanking archrival Ripon 17-0 this past Saturday in Ripon.

Senior running back Elijah Fort leads the Green Knights on the ground with 552 yards rushing on 109 attempts with six touchdowns. Senior quarterback Jack Becker has completed 53 of 93 passes for 792 yards with 12 touchdowns and two interceptions. Sophomore wide receiver Samuel Staehling paces the Green Knights in receptions with 22 for 430 yards with nine touchdowns.

Junior linebacker Matt Gurgone has a team-high 28 tackles with 10 tackles-for-loss, also a team best. Junior linebacker Matt Barrett has 27 tackles, while senior defensive back Hunter Prokash has 21 stops with a team-high two interceptions. Senior defensive back Tyler Jensen has 16 tackles and a team-high six passes defended.

St. Norbert is averaging 36.8 points and 376.2 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 18.6 points and 310.8 yards per game.

About the Maroons:

Chicago enters the game with a 3-2 overall record and a 1-0 ledger in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Maroons dispatched Lawrence 28-8 this past Saturday in Chicago in their first Midwest Conference game since 1987.

Freshman quarterback Campbell Garrett leads the Maroons' offense, completing 74 of 130 passes for 868 yards and seven touchdowns with seven interceptions. Senior running back Chandler Carroll has 503 yards rushing on 111 attempts and nine touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Jamie Rieger has 19 receptions for 296 yards and two touchdowns.

Freshman defensive lineman Jackson Ross leads Chicago in tackles with 44, including 3 1/2 quarterback sacks. Freshman defensive back Ryan Montgomery has 38 tackles. Senior defensive lineman Peter Casey has 11 1/2 tackles-forloss, while sophomore defensive lineman Ben Christensen has nine tackles-for-loss.

Chicago is averaging 27.4 points and 340.8 yards per game. Defensively, the Maroons are allowing 17.4 points and 288.0 yards per game.

Happy Homecomings:

St. Norbert's Homecomings have typically given alumni a cause to celebrate, with the Green Knights going 58-24-1 in the fall classics. Last season, St. Norbert pummeled Ripon 48-7 for its Homecoming victory.

The Green Knights have enjoyed great Homecoming success since joining the Midwest Conference for football in 1984, going 30-3. St. Norbert has won 25 of its last 26 Homecoming contests and 18 consecutive dating back to 1999.

Since 1984, St. Norbert has beaten Ripon for Homecoming on nine different occasions. The only MWC schools to spoil Homecoming was the Univ. of Chicago in 1985 (7-6 loss), Beloit in 1990 (16-10 loss) and Grinnell in 1998 (49-28 loss).

Defensive Dossier:

St. Norbert's 17-0 shutout of Ripon this past Saturday marked the first time in the 38-game series history the Red Hawks have been blanked by the Green Knights.

The shutout also marks the fifth consecutive season the Green Knights have posted at least one. St. Norbert last had five-season stretch with at least one shutout from 2002 to 2006. The most consecutive seasons with at least one shutout in

school history is seven, spanning 1948 to 1954.

The Green Knights also held Ripon to 125 yards of total offense. That mark is the lowest total ever for Ripon against St. Norbert, and the lowest for the Green Knights against any opponent since holding Lawrence to 120 yards on Oct. 13, 2012.

Streaking Staehling:

Sophomore wide receiver Samuel Staehling caught one touchdown pass in this past Saturday's 17-0 win over Ripon. Staehling has seven touchdown receptions in his last three games and holds nine on the season.

Staehling, in just 15 games, is fourth in career touchdown receptions at St. Norbert with 18. He trails Mike Whitehouse (37, 1986-89), Joe Green (27, 2009-12) and Judd O'Connell (23, 2006-07) in St. Norbert annals.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert had its 18th consecutive winning season in 2016.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 446-287-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .606. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 194-39, a winning percentage of .833.

St. Norbert has won 139 of its last 154 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .903.

Quick Hitters:

- *- Senior running back Elijah Fort's 33 career rushing touchdowns place him third all-time in school history. Casey Meehan is the career leader with 42 from 2002-05. Larry Krause (39, 1966-69), A.J. Phillips (32, 2005-08) and Jason Augustynowicz (31, 1998-2001) are the top four.
- * St. Norbert is 205-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 124-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017.
