St. Norbert hosts its neighbor from just down Interstate 41 to face Lawrence in another renewal of its Fox River Valley rivalry. The Green Knights are currently one of two unbeaten teams in the Midwest Conference North Division.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 28-9-2 lead over Lawrence in a series begun in 1932. The Green Knights have won the last 19 meetings with the Vikings since a 27-24 Lawrence win in 1997 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. Lawrence claims only a 28-13-2 deficit in the series, but four games were played before St. Norbert began sponsoring full varsity intercollegiate football in 1931.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert routed Lawrence 62-0 on Oct. 15, 2016 at Banta Bowl in Appleton. The Green Knights scored five second-quarter touchdowns en route to a 41-0 lead. J.T. Crosby completed 12 of 19 passes for 199 yards and two touchdowns while rushing 13 times for 83 yards and three touchdowns. Elijah Fort added 80 yards rushing for three touchdowns on 11 car-

ries. Samuel Staehling caught two passes for 104 yards and one touchdown. Lawrence was held to 200 yards of total offense, while the Green Knights gained 550.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 21-6 in his third season in De Pere.

Lawrence coach Rob McCarthy (Concordia-Moorhead, 1989) is 5-21 in his third season in Appleton.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 4-2 overall and 2-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division after a hard-fought 10-0 Homecoming win over Chicago this past Saturday.

Sophomore wide receiver Samuel Staehling leads the Green Knights in receiving with 29 for 532 yards with nine touchdowns. Senior quarterback Jack Becker has completed 63 of 117 passes for 930 yards with 13 touchdowns and two interceptions. Senior running back Elijah Fort has 552 yards rushing on 109 carries and six touchdowns.

Junior linebacker Matt Barrett leads the Green Knights in tackles with 35. Junior linebacker Matt Gurgone has 33 tackles with a Midwest Conference-best 14 tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive back Hunter Prokash has 27 tackles with two interceptions, while senior linebacker Ben Kornowski has 20 tackles and six tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive back Sam Koss has 19 tackles and two interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 32.3 points and 359.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 15.5 points and 281.5 yards per game.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the game 1-5 overall and is 0-2 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Vikings dropped a 21-18 decision at home to Macalester this past Saturday.

Sophomore running back Wasonu Allen leads the Vikings in rushing with 402 yards on 72 carries and two touchdowns. Freshman

quarterback D'Andre Weaver has completed 12 of 31 passes for 186 yards and one touchdown with one interception. Freshman wide receiver Nick Pastrone has caught 12 passes for 158 yards.

Senior linebacker Jake Gostisha leads the Vikings defensively with 54 tackles and six tackles-for-loss. Senior linebacker Dan Rothbauer and junior defensive lineman Cullen Ellis have 34 tackles apiece. Sophomore defensive back Terrell Myers has 21 tackles and a teamhigh three interceptions.

Lawrence is averaging 14.8 points and 249.5 yards per game. Defensively, the Vikings are allowing 31.2 points and 437.8 yards per game.

Shutout Stuff:

St. Norbert's 10-0 shutout of Chicago this past Saturday marked the first time in eight years the Green Knights have posted back-to-back shutouts.

The Green Knights, who blanked Ripon 17-0 on Oct. 7, last posted consecutive shutouts in 2009. St. Norbert stopped Beloit 44-0 on Oct. 31, 2009 and Illinois College 49-0 on Nov. 7, 2009.

St. Norbert, which also had consecutive shutouts of Monmouth and Carroll in 2006, last had three consecutive shutouts in 2000. The Green Knights blanked Knox 21-0 on Oct. 7, Monmouth 45-0 on Oct. 14 and Grinnell 34-0 on Oct. 21 of that season.

The Green Knights have had consecutive shutouts in 11 seasons: 1935, '36, '38, '41, '46, '50, '52, 2000, '06, '09 and '17. St. Norbert's stretch in 1941 was also three straight.

Tough Sledding:

St. Norbert posted its second consecutive game of allowing under 150 yards of total offense when it yielded just 135 yards in a 10-0 win over Chicago this past Saturday.

The Green Knights allowed 125 yards in a 17-0 win over Ripon on Oct. 7 for a two-game total of 260 yards allowed.

Only two other times since 1990 has St. Norbert allowed under 150

yards in consecutive games. The Green Knights allowed 127 yards in a 44-0 win over Beloit on Oct. 31, 2009 and 119 yards in a 49-0 win over Illinois College on Nov. 7, 2009 for a two-game total of 246 yards.

Since 1990, the best two-game aggregate total defensive yardage for St. Norbert came in 1990. The Green Knights set a school record in total defense by "allowing" minus-21 yards in a 29-0 win over Illinois College on Sept. 29. St. Norbert then held Lake Forest to 135 yards in a 19-7 win on Oct. 6.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert had its 19th consecutive winning season in 2016.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 447-287-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .606. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 195-39, a winning percentage of .833.

St. Norbert has won 140 of its last 155 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .903.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert junior linebacker Matt Gurgone leads the Midwest Conference with 14 tackles-for-loss, which is also the fifth-best mark nationally in Division III.
- * St. Norbert is allowing just 61.7 yards rushing per game, the best total in the Midwest Conference and 10th nationally in Division III.
- * St. Norbert leads the Midwest Conference and is 11th nationally in Division III in fewest penalty yards at 36.5 yards per game.
- * St. Norbert paces the Midwest Conference in third-down conversion defense, allowing 25 of 93 opportunities (26.9 percent).
- * St. Norbert is 205-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 124-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017
