Game Overview:

St. Norbert travels to the Chippewa Valley for its second non-conference game of the season when it faces UW-Eau Claire at historic Carson Park. The game is the first in a two-year home-and-home series between the Green Knights and Blugolds.

The Series:

UW-Eau Claire leads St. Norbert 5-3 in an all-time series dating back to 1956. The Green Knights are 1-2 in games at Carson Park. Eau Claire won the last meeting "on the island" between the two teams with a 24-13 decision on Sept. 13, 1980.

Last Meeting:

UW-Eau Claire topped St. Norbert 24-20 on Nov. 17, 2007 in a first-round NCAA Division III Playoff game at a blustery Minahan Stadium in De Pere. Mitch Schaeuble's 28-yard touchdown to Chris Hull with 46 seconds remaining rallied the Blugolds, who held a 317-299 advantage in total offense. Cody Craig completed 18 of 35 passes for 191 yards and two touchdowns, while Judd O'Connell caught eight passes for 88 yards for the Green Knights. Schaeuble completed 17 of 32 passes for 222 yards, while

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 25-7 in his fourth season in De Pere.

UW-Eau Claire coach Dan Larson (UW-Eau Claire, 2003) is 4-17 in his third season in Eau Claire.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert opened the 2018 season with a hard-fought 16-7 win over Aurora this past Saturday at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. It was the first time since 2015 the Green Knights won their season opener.

Senior quarterback Drew Rhodes completed 14 of 22 passes for 118 yards and also rushed 26 times for 99 yards. Junior running back Jadon Sackman added 87 yards rushing on 16 carries as the Green Knights rushed for 240 yards overall. Sophomore wide receiver Matt Galanopoulos caught six passes for 34 yards.

Senior linebackers Ben Kornowski and Mike Olijnyk each had seven tackles against Aurora. Olijnyk had 3 1/2 tackles-for-loss and one quarterback sack, while Kornowski had two tackles-for-loss. Senior linebacker Matt Gurgone had four tackles, with two quarterback sacks, two tackles-for-loss, one interception returned for a touchdown and two forced fumbles.

St. Norbert is averaging 16.0 points and 358.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 7.0 points and 164.0 yards per game.

About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire enters the game 1-0 after trimming Loras 45-13 this past Saturday in Dubuque, Iowa. The Blugolds won their season opener for the first time since 2010.

Senior running back Brian Kulaga led the Blugolds with 109 yards rushing on just nine carries. Senior quarterback Scott Procter completed 8 of 11 passes for 114 yards while also rushing 11 times for 42 yards. Junior wide receiver Antwan Moore caught four passes for 54 yards.

Freshman linebacker Alex Mashek had seven tackles and an interception for the Blugolds, while sophomore defensive back Sam Burzynski added seven tackles. Junior linebacker Joey Esposito had six tackles, while junior linebacker Sam Romanski had three tacklesfor-loss and two quarterback sacks.

Eau Claire is averaging 45.0 points and 406.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Blugolds are allowing 13.0 points and 208.0 yards per game.

Find A Way:

St. Norbert's 16-7 win over Aurora this past Saturday came with the Green Knights going without scoring an offensive touchdown. Matt Gurgone's 20-yard interception return in the second quarter was St. Norbert's lone touchdown of the day.

It marked the first time in 80 years St. Norbert won a game without scoring an offensive touchdown. The Green Knights' last such victory came on Oct. 8, 1938 in a 9-0 win over South Dakota State. The contest was the dedication game for Minahan Stadium.

Bob Toonen kicked a 19-yard field goal and then returned an interception 56 yards for a touchdown to account for all of St. Norbert's scoring in its win over the Jackrabbits.

Spenser For Hire:

Senior kicker Spenser Thompson-Meyers booted three field goals in Saturday's 16-7 win over Aurora. He connected from 34, 38 and 21 yards.

His hat trick marked the second time in his career Thompson-Meyers had three field goals in a game. His first also came in a 16-7 win over Monmouth in the 2015 Midwest Conference championship game.

Thompson-Meyers now has 28 career field goals, setting a new St. Norbert record. Thompson-Meyers surpassed his predecessor Randy Hill, who made 26 field goals from 2012-14.

Keep Away:

St. Norbert had possession of the football for a lusty 37 minutes 7 seconds in this past Saturday's 16-7 win over Aurora. The Green Knights had the ball for 11:47 in the fourth quarter, including the last 7:48 on a 14-play drive to run out the clock.

The Green Knights also held Aurora to 1-for-14 on third-down conversions. That was St. Norbert's best effort since holding Cornell to a 1-for-13 rate in a 31-3 win on Oct. 3, 2015.

State School Snippets:

Saturday's game against UW-Eau Claire marks the 168th time in St. Norbert football history the Green Knights will battle a University of Wisconsin System school on the gridiron.

St. Norbert has played all eight current members of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, as well as former members UW-Milwaukee and UW-Superior. St. Norbert owns at least one win over all eight current WIAC members and is 80-79-8 all-time against the league.

St. Norbert has played UW-Oshkosh 37 times (14-20-3 all-time), the most meetings with any St. Norbert opponent. The Green Knights have also battled UW-Whitewater 31 times (9-19-3), UW-Stevens Point 28 times (13-14-1), UW-Milwaukee 23 times (19-4) and UW-La Crosse on 21 occasions (13-7-1).

The Green Knights have lost 20 consecutive games against the WIAC since a 25-7 win over UW-Platteville on Nov. 5, 1983 in De Pere. All 20 of those games have been played since 1988.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is searching for its 20th consecutive winning season in 2018.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 451-288-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .607. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 198-39, a winning percentage of .835.

St. Norbert has won 143 of its last 158 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .905.

Quick Hitter:

* - St. Norbert is 208-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 126-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017
