Game Overview:

It's Ripon Week for St. Norbert as the Green Knights host the Red Hawks in a battle between contending squads. The game is the Midwest Conference North Division opener for both teams.

The Series:

St. Norbert owns a 28-10 lead over Ripon in a hotly contested series that dates back to 1979. St. Norbert has won 18 of the last 19 meetings in the series, the Green Knights' lone blemish a 19-7 Ripon win at Ingalls Field in 2008. The Green Knights are 15-4 all-time at home in the series and hold an all-time 1,146-691 scoring edge in the rivalry.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Ripon 17-0 on Oct. 7, 2017 in a defensive battle at Ingalls Field in Ripon. The Green Knights led 3-0 at halftime before Jack Becker found Matt Galanopoulos (32 yards) and Samuel Staehling (3 yards) on second-half touchdown passes. St. Norbert outgained Ripon 228-125 in total offense. Becker completed 16 of 29 passes for 155 yards and two touchdowns to lead St. Norbert. Ripon was led by 38 yards rushing by Brent Anderson. The Red Hawks finished with 38 passing yards.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 27-8 in his fourth season in De Pere. He is 3-0 all-time against Ripon.

Ripon coach Ron Ernst (Nebraska Wesleyan, 1980) is 170-99 in his 28th season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into the game 3-1 overall. The Green Knights posted their second consecutive shutout with a 34-0 win over Knox this past Saturday in Galesburg, Ill.

Junior running back Jadon Sackman tops the Green Knights on the ground with 267 yards on 46 carries and three touchdowns. Senior quarterback Drew Rhodes has completed 51 of 101 passes for 597 yards with six touchdowns and three interceptions. Rhodes has also rushed for 237 yards on 61 carries. Freshman running back Nate Ihlenfeldt has 13 receptions for 124 yards and two touchdowns, while junior wide receiver Samuel Staehling has 13 receptions for 180 yards and two touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Matt Barrett has a team-high 28 tackles along with four tackles-for-loss. Senior linebacker Mike Olijnyk has 27 tackles with a team-high nine tackles-for-loss. Senior linebacker Matt Gurgone has 20 tackles with eight tackles-for-loss and team bests with three quarterback sacks and two interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 41.0 points and 388.8 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 9.3 points and 182.8 yards per game.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game 3-1 overall. The Red Hawks, who have defeated their last three opponents by a combined 151-10 margin, topped Grinnell 53-7 this past Saturday in Grinnell, Iowa.

Ripon's option offense is currently third in Division III averaging 342.2 yards per game while gaining 6.6 yards per carry. Sophomore running back Austin Bunders has 321 yards on 33 attempts and six touch-

downs, while freshman quarter-back Cormac Madigan has 313 yards on 31 attempts with three touchdowns. Junior fullback Tyler VanDeVelde has 262 rushing yards on 45 carries and four touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Julian Patton has completed 20 of 42 passes for 383 yards and seven touchdowns. Bunders is the leading receiver with seven catches for 138 yards and one touchdown.

Senior linebacker Ethan Hoffman is pacing the Red Hawks' defense with 46 tackles. Junior defensive back Lane Barnes has 27 tackles and three interceptions. Senior defensive lineman Dakota Jordan has 18 tackles with a team-high five tackles-for-loss.

Ripon is averaging 44.8 points and 459.8 yards per game. Defensively, the Red Hawks are allowing 10.2 points and 270.8 yards per game.

Shutout Stuff:

St. Norbert's 34-0 shutout of Knox this past Saturday marked the second time in as many years the Green Knights have posted back-to-back shutouts.

The Green Knights, who blanked Grinnell 91-0 on Sept. 22, shutout Ripon 17-0 and Chicago 10-0 on Oct. 7 and Oct. 14 of last season.

St. Norbert last had three consecutive shutouts in 2000. The Green Knights blanked Knox 21-0 on Oct. 7, Monmouth 45-0 on Oct. 14 and Grinnell 34-0 on Oct. 21 of that season.

The Green Knights have had consecutive shutouts in 12 seasons: 1935, '36, '38, '41, '46, '50, '52, 2000, '06, '09, '17 and '18. St. Norbert's stretch in 1941 was also three straight.

Battle in the Trenches:

A key element to the game features Ripon's high-powered option offense against St. Norbert's sturdy rushing defense.

The Red Hawks enter the game third in Division III in rushing yards per game at 342.3 yards per game. The Green Knights are 19th nationally against the run, allowing

just 62.5 yards per game.

The opposite also will be in play. St. Norbert's rushing offense is 29th in Division III at 239.5 yards per game. Ripon is allowing just 103.3 yards per game on the ground.

Top of the Heap:

St. Norbert ranks in the top five in three major defensive categories in this week's NCAA Division III national statistics.

The Green Knights enter the week fourth in both team passing efficiency defense and third-down conversion percentage defense. Opponents' passing efficiency rating is 72.55, while foes are 13-for-67 (19.4 percent) on third down.

St. Norbert is fifth in total defense at 182.8 yards per game.

On the scoreboard, the Green Knights are tied for 12th nationally allowing just 9.3 points per game. St. Norbert is also tied for 12th in first downs allowed with 48, an average of 12 per game.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is searching for its 20th consecutive winning season in 2018.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 453-289-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .608. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 198-39, a winning percentage of .835.

St. Norbert has won 143 of its last 158 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .905.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert is 11th in Division III in net punting. The Green Knights are netting 37.6 yards per punt so far this season. Junior punter Jeff Allen is 21st nationally in gross punting at 40.5 yards per punt.
- * St. Norbert is 210-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 127-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017.
