The Series:

St. Norbert leads Chicago 4-1 in an all-time series dating back to 1984. The Green Knights opened the series with a 27-0 win at Stagg Field in Chicago on Nov. 3, 1984. The Maroons topped the Green Knights 7-6 in De Pere on Nov. 2, 1985. St. Norbert then won the last two games 24-15 on Nov. 8, 1986 in Chicago and 23-7 on Nov. 7, 1987 in De Pere. The Green Knights then topped the Maroons 10-0 on Oct. 14, 2017 in De Pere.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Chicago 10-0 on Oct. 14, 2017 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights got a 20-yard field goal from Spenser Thompson-Meyers in the first quarter and a 24-yard touchdown pass from Jack Becker to Sean Ferraro early in the second quarter for the game's only

points. St. Norbert held a 273-135 edge in total offense. Becker completed 10 of 24 passes for 138 yards and one touchdown. Ferraro rushed 28 times for 86 yards. Samuel Staehling caught seven passes for 102 yards for the Green Knights. Chandler Carroll toted the ball 28 times for 63 yards for Chicago. Campbell Garrett completed 9 of 22 passes for 61 yards with two interceptions.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 28-8 in his fourth season in De Pere. He is 1-0 all-time against Chicago.

Chicago coach Chris Wilkerson (Eastern Illinois, 1995) is 33-21 in his sixth season on the Midway. He is 0-1 all-time against St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads to Chicago 4-1 overall and 1-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Green Knights opened divisional play with a 30-17 win over Ripon this past Saturday.

Senior quarterback Drew Rhodes has completed 67 of 122 passes for 803 yards with seven touchdowns and four interceptions, while also rushing 73 times for 264 yards. Junior running back Jadon Sackman has 293 rushing yards on 56 carries and five touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Samuel Staehling has 17 catches for 284 yards and three touchdowns, while sophomore wide receiver Matt Galanopoulos has 15 receptions for 173 yards and one score.

Senior linebacker Matt Barrett, the reigning MWC Defensive Player of the Week, has a team-high 37 tackles along with six tackles-for-loss. Senior linebacker Mike Olijnyk has 36 tackles with a team-high 11 tackles-for-loss. Senior linebacker Matt Gurgone has 25 tackles with 10 tackles-for-loss and team highs with four quarterback sacks and two interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 38.8 points and 379.6 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 10.8 points and 195.8

yards per game.

About the Maroons:

Chicago enters the game 3-2 overall and 1-0 in the MWC North Division. The Maroons opened conference action with a 49-0 win over Lawrence this past Saturday. Chicago has outscored its last three opponents 154-9.

Freshman quarterback Jeffrey Jackson has sparked the Chicago offense, completing 65 of 90 passes for 886 yards with nine touchdowns and three interceptions. He also has 143 rushing yards on 26 carries and two touchdowns. Sophomore running back Vittorio Tricase has a team-high 189 rushing yards on 44 carries and three touchdowns. Freshman wide receiver Jacob Jackson has 29 receptions for 467 yards and four touchdowns.

Sophomore defensive lineman Jackson Ross has a team-high 53 tackles along with 3 1/2 tackles-for-loss. Junior linebacker Zach Atiyeh has 44 tackles, while junior linebacker Henry Winebrake has 32 stops.

Chicago is averaging 34.2 points and 363.4 yards per game. Defensively, the Maroons are allowing 10.8 points and 303.8 yards per game.

Spenser For Hire:

Senior kicker Spenser Thompson-Meyers has been named to the 2018 Fred Mitchell Award September Watch List. He is one of 21 players on the Watch List for the award, which is given to the top kicker in FCS, Division II, Division III and NAIA football.

Thompson-Meyers is perfect on 32 placements so far this season. He is 23-for-23 on point-after attempts and is 9-for-9 on field-goal tries.

His 34 career field goals, a St. Norbert record, is currently the most by an active Division III kicker. His 150 successful extra-point attempts, second in St. Norbert history, is third-most currently in Division III.

Thompson-Meyers has 254 career points, which is currently ninth in Division III among all active play-

ers. He is 48 points shy of matching the school record of 302 set by Casey Meehan from 2002-05.

House Calls:

Junior wide receiver Samuel Staehling has had a receiving touchdown in each of his last two games, giving him three for the season and 28 for his career.

Staehling's total moved him out of a tie for second place in St. Norbert history with Joe Green (2009-12). Staehling trails only Mike Whitehouse, an All-American who had 37 from 1986-89.

Staehling set a St. Norbert season record with 16 receiving touchdowns in 2017.

Top of the Heap:

St. Norbert still ranks in the top four in three major defensive categories in this week's NCAA Division III national statistics.

The Green Knights enter the week third in pass-efficiency defense and fourth in total defense and third-down conversion defense. Opponents have a passing rating of 75.78. The Green Knights are allowing 195.8 yards per game and foes have converted just 19.8 percent of their third-down chances.

On the scoreboard, the Green Knights are tied for 17th nationally allowing just 10.8 points per game.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is searching for its 20th consecutive winning season in 2018.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 454-289-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .608. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 199-39, a winning percentage of .836.

St. Norbert has won 144 of its last 159 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .906.

Quick Hitter:

* - St. Norbert is 211-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 127-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017.
