St. Norbert returns home for the first time in three weeks when it hosts Macalester in the Green Knights' Homecoming affair. St. Norbert can clinch a berth in the Midwest Conference championship game with a win over the Scots.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Macalester 3-1 in an all-time series begun in 2014, the year the Scots joined the Midwest Conference as an affiliate member. The Green Knights have won the last three games in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Macalester 47-7 on Oct. 28, 2017 at Macalester Stadium in St. Paul, Minn. The Green Knights led 20-0 at halftime and pulled away in the second half. St. Norbert outgained Macalester 469-264 in total offense and held the Scots to minus-34 yards rushing. Jack Becker completed 21 of 33 passes for 328 yards and five touchdowns. Matt Galanopoulos caught eight passes for 74 yards and one touchdown, while Samuel Staehling caught six passes for 142 yards and two touchdowns. Christian Adams completed 18 of 36 passes for 244 yards and one touch-

down for the Scots, while Jonathan Knee caught seven passes for 100 yards.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 30-8 in his fourth season in De Pere. He is 3-0 all-time against Macalester.

Macalester coach Tony Jennison (UW-La Crosse, 1997) is 56-50 in his 11th season in St. Paul.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert returns home for the first time in three weeks, carrying a 6-1 overall record and 3-0 mark in the Midwest Conference North Division into the Macalester game. The Green Knights blanked Lawrence 46-0 this past Saturday in Appleton.

Senior quarterback Drew Rhodes leads the Green Knights in passing and rushing. Rhodes has completed 89 of 157 passes for 1,036 yards and 10 touchdowns with five interceptions. He has rushed 107 times for 431 yards and two touchdowns. Sophomore wide receiver Matt Galanopoulos has caught 23 passes for 236 vards and three touchdowns, while junior Samuel Staehling has caught 21 passes for 335 yards and three touchdowns. Junior running back Jadon Sackman has 293 rushing yards on 56 carries and five touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Matt Barrett has a team-high 50 tackles with 7 1/2 tackles-for-loss and 3 1/2 quarterback sacks. Senior linebacker Mike Olijnyk has 49 tackles with 14 tackles for loss and three quarterback sacks, while senior linebacker Matt Gurgone has 35 tackles, 13 tacklesfor-loss, four quarterback sacks, four forced fumbles and three interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 37.3 points and 373.7 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 10.6 points and 191.4 yards per game.

About the Scots:

Macalester enters the game 5-2 overall and 2-1 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Scots are coming off a 58-34 loss at Ripon this past Saturday.

Senior running back Jeremy Stephan leads the Scots in rushing with 349 yards on 102 carries with six touchdowns. Freshman quarterback Grady Munro has completed 58 of 88 passes for 705 yards and eight touchdowns with four interceptions, while reserve senior quarterback Cody Petrich has completed 99 of 147 passes for 1,165 yards with 13 touchdowns and four interceptions. Senior wide receiver Alec Beatty has 46 receptions for 827 vards with 11 touchdowns, while senior wide receiver Jonathan Knee has 40 receptions for 494 yards and two touchdowns.

Junior linebacker Josh Bartz leads the Scots with 36 tackles, while junior defensive back Kiante Miles has 31 tackles. Junior linebacker Dane Ku Blake has 29 tackles.

Macalester is averaging 32.6 points and 369.4 yards per game. Defensively, the Scots are allowing 33.4 points and 380.9 yards per game.

Happy Homecomings:

St. Norbert's Homecomings have typically given alumni a cause to celebrate, with the Green Knights going 59-24-1 in the fall classics. Last season, St. Norbert defeated Chicago 10-0 for its Homecoming victory.

The Green Knights have enjoyed great Homecoming success since joining the Midwest Conference for football in 1984, going 31-3. St. Norbert has won 26 of its last 27 Homecoming contests and 19 consecutive dating back to 1999.

Since 1984, St. Norbert has beaten Ripon for Homecoming on 10 different occasions. The only MWC schools to spoil Homecoming was the Univ. of Chicago in 1985 (7-6 loss), Beloit in 1990 (16-10 loss) and Grinnell in 1998 (49-28 loss).

Safety Dance:

St. Norbert had a rare occurrence in this past Saturday's 46-0 win at Lawrence when the Green Knights scored a pair of safeties.

St. Norbert has had two safeties in one game just one other time, in a 62-0 win over Lake Forest on Sept. 27, 2009.

Defensive Dossier:

St. Norbert still ranks in the top nine in five major defensive categories in this week's NCAA Division III national statistics.

The Green Knights are fifth in Division III in total defense (191.4 yards per game) and team passing efficiency defense (84.22 rating). St. Norbert is eighth in rushing defense (54.9 yards per game) and thirddown conversion percentage defense (24.1 percent). The Green Knights are ninth in passing yards allowed at 136.6 per game.

St. Norbert is 12th in scoring defense at 10.6 points per game.

The Green Knights have three shutouts in 2018, the first time they have done so in one year since the 2006 season. St. Norbert last had four shutouts in 2000.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert has assured itself of a 20th consecutive winning season. The Green Knights' last season at-orbelow .500 was a 5-5 mark in 1998.

The Green Knights have an alltime record of 456-289-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .609. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 201-39, a winning percentage of .838.

St. Norbert has won 146 of its last 161 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .907.

Quick Hitter:

* - St. Norbert is 212-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 129-2 all-time when scoring 40-ormore points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017.
