Game Overview:

St. Norbert opens the 2019 season with a trip to face future Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference colleague Aurora. The game marks the end of a two-year home-and-home series between the Green Knights and Spartans. St. Norbert joins the NACC full-time in July 2021.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Aurora 1-0 in an all-time series begun in the 2018 season. The Green Knights will meet the Spartans on a regular basis when St. Norbert moves to the Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference in 2021.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Aurora 16-7 on Sept. 1, 2018 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Spartans struck first for a 7-0 lead, but the Green Knights answered with a 34-yard field goal from Spenser Thompson-Meyers and a 20-yard interception return for a touchdown by Matt Gurgone for a 10-7 halftime lead. Third-quarter field goals of 38 and 21 yards off the toe of Thompson-Meyers closed out the scoring. St. Norbert outgained Aurora

358-164 in total offense. Drew Rhodes completed 14 of 22 passes for 118 yards, while the Green Knights rushed for 240 yards. Gavin Zimbelman completed 13 of 34 passes for 130 yards for Aurora.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 34-9 in his fifth season in De Pere.

Aurora coach Don Beebe (Chadron State, 1989) is 0-0 in his first season in Aurora.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the 2019 season ranked No. 25 in the D3football.com Poll. The Green Knights finished 10-2 last season and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III Playoffs.

Sophomore running back Nate Ihlenfeldt is the Green Knights' leading rusher at 362 yards on 77 carries and two touchdowns. Sophomore running back Brandon Dudley had 313 rushing yards on 52 carries with four touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Matt Galanopoulos had 40 receptions for 375 yards and three touchdowns while also rushing 34 times for 215 vards and five scores. Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling had 29 receptions for 469 yards and six touchdowns.

Senior defensive back Joe Peterson is St. Norbert's leading returning tackler with 39 stops while also posting four interceptions. Senior defensive lineman Kordell Draves had 38 tackles, while senior defensive back Walter McBride had 34 stops.

St. Norbert averaged 33.3 points and 359.3 yards per game last season. Defensively, the Green Knights allowed 13.1 points and 227.8 yards per game.

About the Spartans:

Aurora enters the 2019 season coming off a 5-5 overall mark while tying for second place in the Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference at 5-2.

Junior running back Tyran Bailey led the Spartans in rushing last sea-

son with 1,111 yards on 174 carries with eight touchdowns. Senior running back Connor Olson had 377 rushing yards on 80 carries with four touchdowns. Junior quarterback Gavin Zimbelman completed 152 of 278 passes for 1,809 yards with 12 touchdowns and nine interceptions. Junior wide receiver Emilio Starks caught 31 passes for 384 yards with three touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Cole Sinn led the Spartans in tackles last year with 77, while junior defensive back Casey Dycus had 50 stops and two interceptions.

Aurora averaged 24.9 points and 361.1 yards per game last season. Defensively, the Spartans allowed 20.1 points and 387.4 yards per game.

Opening Day Observations:

St. Norbert is 10-9 in its last 19 season openers. The Green Knights have won three of their last five season openers, sweeping Carthage in a home-and-home series to open the 2014 and 2015 seasons before falling to UW-Stevens Point in 2016 and 2017. St. Norbert topped Aurora in 2018.

The first four season-opening wins in the last 18 years all came against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foes Hamline University and the University of St. Thomas. The Green Knights defeated the Pipers 34-22 in St. Paul in 2000 and won 26-22 in 2001 in De Pere. St. Norbert then beat St. Thomas 35-31 in 2002 and 21-19 in 2003. St. Norbert topped Wartburg 42-35 in overtime in 2009's lidlifter to earn a split in the two-year series.

The four MIAC games from 2000-03 were the Green Knights' first openers against a non-Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference or NCAA Division II foe since 1983, the last time SNC won an opener 2000 (24-14 prior to over Monmouth in 1983). The Green Knights opened against NCAA Division II Michigan Tech from 1984 to 1987, UW-Stevens Point in 1988 and 1989, UW-Oshkosh from 1990 to 1999, UW-Whitewater in 2004 and 2005, Olivet Nazarene in

St. Norbert, entering its 86th year of varsity football, is 40-39-6 in season openers.

Roster Report:

St. Norbert has 116 players listed on its roster as of Sept. 2.

On the 2019 roster, 70 players are from Wisconsin. Illinois has the second-highest total with 28 players hailing from the Land of Lincoln. California is third with six players, followed by five from Michigan. Texas is represented with three players, while Florida, Georgia, Minnesota and Washington all have one apiece.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert finished with a 20th consecutive winning season in 2018. The Green Knights' last season at-orbelow .500 was a 5-5 mark in 1998.

The Green Knights have an alltime record of 460-290-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .610. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 203-39, a winning percentage of .839.

St. Norbert has won 148 of its last 163 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .908.

The Green Knights have won at least seven games in 19 of the last 20 seasons. The lone exception was a 6-4 campaign in 2014.

Last season was St. Norbert's sixth season with at least 10 wins. The Green Knights won a school-record 11 games in 2003 and also won 10 games in 2000, 2006, 2007 and 2015.

Quick Hitter:

* - St. Norbert is 214-13 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 130-2 all-time when scoring 40-ormore points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points came in a 34-33 double-overtime loss at UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 2, 2017.
