St. Norbert and Monmouth meet to decide the 2019 Midwest Conference titleist in the league's championship game. The winner of the only conference championship game in NCAA Division III football also earns the league's automatic qualifier to the NCAA Playoffs.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 23-10 series lead over Monmouth in a series that began in 1975. The Green Knights have won 14 of the last 22 games in the series, but Monmouth holds a slim 8-6 edge in the last 14 meetings. St. Norbert is 11-7 all-time at Monmouth in the series but the Green Knights have dropped their last four games at Zorn Memorial Stadium.

Last Meeting:

Monmouth defeated St. Norbert 34-14 earlier this season on Sept. 28 at Zorn Memorial Stadium in Monmouth, Ill. The Fighting Scots, who led 31-7 after the first quarter, took advantage of eight St. Norbert turnovers. Monmouth held a 348-337 advantage in total offense. St. Norbert scored on a 66-yard touchdown pass from Freddy Poorman to Samuel Staehling and a 1-yard run by Ben Kohl. Poorman completed 11 of 20 passes for 144 yards,

while Gage McClanahan completed 19 of 29 passes for 187 yards. Brennan White completed 11 of 18 passes for 194 yards for Monmouth. Devin Lawrence rushed 14 times for 78 yards and one score to lead the Fighting Scots on the ground.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 40-11 in his fifth season in De Pere.

Monmouth coach Chad Braun (Illinois College, 1995) is 41-9 in his fifth season in Monmouth.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the contest 6-2 overall after winning the Midwest Conference North Division at 5-0. The Green Knights clinched the MWC North with a 34-20 win this past Saturday over Lake Forest.

Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling has 40 receptions for 943 yards - an average of 23.6 yards per catch - with 11 touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Matt Galanopoulos has 37 catches for 378 yards and four touchdowns. Sophomore running back Nate Ihlenfeldt has a team-high 771 yards rushing on 109 attempts with seven touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Ben Kohl has 224 rushing yards on 40 carries with five touchdowns and has completed 9 of 14 passes for 187 yards and three touchdowns. Senior quarterback Gage McClanahan has completed 75 of 117 passes for 1,035 vards with eight touchdowns and five interceptions.

Junior linebacker Maccabee Barrett leads the Green Knights in tackles with 53 and also has seven tackles-for-loss. Junior linebacker Zach Kratky has 37 tackles, while senior defensive lineman Kordell Draves has 37 tackles and a teamhigh 12 tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive lineman Blake Olejniczak has 31 tackles with seven tacklesfor-loss. Senior defensive back Walter McBride has 28 tackles.

St. Norbert is averaging 36.9 points and 427.0 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 17.3 points and 274.4 yards per game.

About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters the game 6-2 overall and captured the MWC South Division title with a 4-0 record. The Fighting Scots tripped Knox 31-3 this past Saturday.

Sophomore running back Devin Lawrence leads Monmouth in rushing with 709 yards on 113 carries with seven touchdowns, while freshman running back Henderson Francois has 412 rushing yards on 85 carries and six touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Walker Dycus has completed 41 of 71 passes for 469 yards with two touchdowns and two interceptions, while senior quarterback Brennan White has completed 45 of 85 passes for 395 yards with two touchdowns and four interceptions. Sophomore wide receiver Jake Uryasz has caught a team-high 31 passes for 405 yards and three touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Clark Gaden leads Monmouth defensively with 70 tackles, 10 1/2 tackles-for-loss and two quarterback sacks. Senior defensive back Nick Miyler has 46 tackles, while junior defensive back Connor Graeff has made 39 stops. Junior defensive back Naulon Simms has 37 tackles with seven tackles-for-loss.

Monmouth is averaging 21.5 points and 288.6 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Fighting Scots are allowing 17.8 points and 287.6 yards per game.

Chipper Chatter:

St. Norbert and Monmouth will be meeting in the Midwest Conference Championship Game for the seventh time.

The MWC held championship games in 1976 and 1977, and then from 1982-97 until Coe and Cornell departed for the IIAC. The league again had MWC title games in 2014 and 2015 before a one-year hiatus. The championship game returned in 2017.

St. Norbert is 5-1-1 in MWC Championship games, defeating Monmouth in all five wins. The Green Knights won 20-15 at Monmouth in 1987, 12-0 in De Pere in 1988, 17-6 at Monmouth in 1989, 16-7 in De Pere in 2015 and 10-7 in De Pere in 2018. St. Norbert battled

Staehling Stuff:

Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling became the second player in St. Norbert history to eclipse 3,000 career receiving yards after 73 yards against Lake Forest this past Saturday.

Staehling has a St. Norbert-record 42 career touchdown receptions. His record-breaking 38th touchdown reception came on a 14-yard pass from Ben Kohl in a 66-0 win over Beloit on Oct. 19. It surpassed Mike Whitehouse, who had 37 from 1986 to 1989.

Staehling is second in St. Norbert history with 3,027 receiving yards on 141 receptions. He trails only Whitehouse, who had 3,480 receiving yards.

Staehling is averaging 21.5 yards per reception on his career, which is currently first among active players in all NCAA divisions.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert has clinched its 21st consecutive winning season. The Green Knights' last season at-orbelow .500 was a 5-5 mark in 1998.

The Green Knights have an alltime record of 466-292-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .612. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 208-39, a winning percentage of .842.

St. Norbert has won 153 of its last 168 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .911.

The Green Knights have won at least seven games in 19 of the last 20 seasons. The lone exception was a 6-4 campaign in 2014.

Last season was St. Norbert's sixth season with at least 10 wins. The Green Knights won a school-record 11 games in 2003 and also won 10 games in 2000, 2006, 2007 and 2015.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is 218-14 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 133-3 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

* - This is St. Norbert's last scheduled visit to Monmouth before the Green Knights move to the NACC in 2021.
