The Series:

UW-Eau Claire leads St. Norbert 6-3 in an all-time series dating back to 1956. St. Norbert is 2-3 at home in the series, with the last meeting in De Pere a 24-20 UW-Eau Claire win in the 2007 NCAA Division III Playoffs.

Last Meeting:

UW-Eau Claire topped St. Norbert 30-23 in double overtime on Sept. Sept. 8, 2018 at Carson Park in Eau Claire. Brian Kulaga's 9-yard run in the second overtime proved the difference. The Blugolds led 16-0 at halftime before St. Norbert answered on Drew Rhodes touchdown passes of 59 yards to Samuel Staehling and 33 yards to Drew Chevarria. The Green Knights recovered an onside kick with 48 seconds left and Spenser

Thompson-Meyers' 29-yard field goal with 3 seconds left forced overtime. Rhodes completed 15 of 41 passes for 212 yards and two touchdowns with one interception for St. Norbert. Kulaga led Eau Claire with 113 yards rushing on 28 carries and two touchdowns. Scott Procter completed 13 of 26 passes for 160 yards.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 34-10 in his fifth season in De Pere.

UW-Eau Claire coach Wesley Beschorner (South Dakota, 2005) is 1-0 in his first season in Eau Claire.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 0-1 after a season-opening 50-40 loss this past Saturday at Aurora.

Iunior quarterback Freddy Poorman completed 32 of 57 passes for 384 yards and four touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling caught 10 passes for 203 yards and three touchdowns, while junior wide receiver Matt Galanopoulos caught seven passes for 74 yards and one touchdown. Sophomore running back Nate Ihlenfeldt averaged 7.0 yards per carry with 112 yards on 16 attempts with one touchdown.

Senior defensive back Joe Peterson and junior linebacker Zach Kratky share the team lead in tackles with seven apiece. Senior defensive lineman Jerome Tillis and sophomore defensive back Joe Jung each have six tackles.

St. Norbert is averaging 40.0 points and 528.0 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 50.0 points and 604.0 yards per game.

About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire enters the game 1-0 overall after a 35-3 win over Loras this past Saturday at Carson Park.

Junior running back Austin Belot led the Eau Claire offense with 168 yards rushing on just 17 carries with two touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Jonathan Malueg completed 8 of 18 passes for 98 yards with two interceptions. Sophomore tight end Killy Kitzmann had a team-high five receptions for 56 yards.

Senior All-American linebacker Sam Romanski paced the defense with 13 tackles, including five tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive back Vince Coenen had nine tackles, while junior linebacker Victor Martinelli had seven tackles with two quarterback sacks. Eau Claire had seven sacks against Loras.

Eau Claire is averaging 35.0 points and 362.0 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Blugolds are allowing 3.0 points and 210.0 yards per game.

Record Report:

St. Norbert set several team and individual records in this past Saturday's 50-40 loss at Aurora.

The Green Knights ran a whopping 100 plays against the Spartans, tying a school record. St. Norbert also ran 100 plays in a 35-14 win over Beloit on Oct. 28, 1989.

St. Norbert attempted 60 passes, surpassing the old record of 53 set in a 21-7 loss to Monmouth on Oct. 21, 1996.

Junior quarterback Freddy Poorman attempted 57 passes, breaking the old mark of 53 by Dan Luedtke in the 1996 Monmouth contest. Poorman's 32 completions tied the St. Norbert mark set by Kurt Rotherham in a 34-30 loss to Michigan Tech on Sept. 13, 1986.

Poorman finished with 384 passing yards, the second-highest total in St. Norbert history. Only Luke Ott's 421 yards in a 52-28 win over Lake Forest on Oct. 27, 2001 is higher.

Staehling Stuff:

Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling had another big day, scoring half of St. Norbert's 40 points against Aurora with three touchdown receptions and a two-point conversion.

Staehling finished with 10 receptions for 203 yards. Staehling had St. Norbert's first 10-reception game since Oct. 22, 2011 when Joe Green had 10 against Grinnell.

Staehling is now fifth in St. Norbert history with 2,287 receiving yards. He trails Steve Heim (2,361 -1982-84) for fourth and Green (2,503 - 2009-12) for third.

Staehling had his fifth game with three receiving touchdowns. Staehling's 34 touchdown receptions trail Mike Whitehouse by three for the St. Norbert career record. Whitehouse had 37 from 1986-89.

Forty Facts:

Saturday's 50-40 loss to Aurora marked just the third time in St. Norbert history the Green Knights lost when scoring at least 40 points in a game.

The Green Knights lost a 57-41 decision to Carroll on Nov. 6, 1993 and a 41-40 heartbreaker to Illinois College on Nov. 10, 2001.

St. Norbert is 214-14 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 130-3 all-time when scoring 40-ormore points.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is looking for its 21st consecutive winning season in 2019. The Green Knights' last season at-orbelow .500 was a 5-5 mark in 1998.

The Green Knights have an alltime record of 460-291-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .610. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 203-39, a winning percentage of .839.

St. Norbert has won 148 of its last 163 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .908.

The Green Knights have won at least seven games in 19 of the last 20 seasons. The lone exception was a 6-4 campaign in 2014.

Last season was St. Norbert's sixth season with at least 10 wins. The Green Knights won a school-record 11 games in 2003 and also won 10 games in 2000, 2006, 2007 and 2015.
