Game Overview:

St. Norbert travels to west-central Illinois to face Monmouth in a nonconference game. The Green Knights face the Fighting Scots in one of their two crossover games against Midwest Conference South Division opponents that do not count in the league standings.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 23-9 series lead over Monmouth in a series that began in 1975. The Green Knights have won 14 of the last 21 games in the series, but Monmouth holds a slim 7-6 edge in the last 13 meetings. St. Norbert is 11-6 all-time at Monmouth in the series but the Green Knights have dropped their last three games at Zorn Memorial Stadium.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert clipped Monmouth 10-7 in the 2018 Midwest Conference Championship Game on Nov. 10, 2018 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. Ben Kornowski returned a 43-yard interception for a touchdown just 1:40 into the game, while Spenser Thompson-Meyers added a 24-yard field goal later in the first quarter. Yansay Williams hauled in an 82-yard touchdown

pass from Hayden Nelson late in the third quarter for Monmouth's only points. St. Norbert outgained Monmouth 343-246 in total offense, including 43 yards over the last 4:21 to run out the clock. Drew Rhodes completed 12 of 23 passes for 119 yards and also rushed 26 times for 81 yards for St. Norbert. Nelson completed 12 of 27 passes for 156 yards with six interceptions for Monmouth, which also got 82 yards rushing from DeAndre Wright on 22 carries.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 35-10 in his fifth season in De Pere.

Monmouth coach Chad Braun (Illinois College, 1995) is 35-9 in his fifth season in Monmouth.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 1-1 overall. The Green Knights were idle this past weekend after defeating UW-Eau Claire 27-21 on Sept. 14 in De Pere.

quarterback Freddy Junior Poorman has completed 36 of 67 passes for 432 yards and four touchdowns with one interception. Senior quarterback Gage McClanahan has completed 13 of 18 passes for 254 yards with three touchdowns and one interception. Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling has 15 receptions for 375 yards and five touchdowns, while wide receiver junior Matt Galanopoulos has 15 catches for 159 vards and two touchdown. Sophomore running back Nate Ihlenfeldt has rushed for a teamhigh 136 yards on 22 attempts with one touchdown.

Junior linebacker Zach Kratky, senior defensive back Joe Peterson and junior linebacker Maccabee Barrett all share the team lead in tackles with 12 apiece. Peterson intercepted three passes against UW-Eau Claire. Senior defensive lineman Kordell Draves has 11 tackles this season.

St. Norbert is averaging 33.5 points and 446.0 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Green

Knights are allowing 35.5 points and 469.5 yards per game.

About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters the game 0-2 overall. The Fighting Scots opened the season with a 38-0 home loss to Wheaton on Sept. 7 before dropping a 38-9 decision at Wartburg on Sept. 14.

Sophomore running back Devin Lawrence leads Monmouth offensively with 164 rushing yards on 39 attempts. Senior quarterback Brennan White has completed 18 of 44 passes for 137 yards and one touchdown with three interceptions. Junior wide receiver Nathan Graham and sophomore wide receiver Jake Uryasz each have three receptions for 52 yards, with Uryasz getting one touchdown.

Senior linebacker Clark Gaden has a team-high 18 tackles with 2.5 tackles-for-loss. Sophomore linebacker Reggie Willis has 14 tackles, while senior defensive back Nick Miyler has 12 stops.

Monmouth is averaging 4.5 points and 174.0 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Fighting Scots are allowing 38.0 points and 372.0 yards per game.

Staehling Stuff:

Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling finished with five receptions for 172 yards and two touchdowns in a 27-21 win over UW-Eau Claire on Sept. 14. He was named to the D3football.com Team of the Week for his performance.

Staehling had a 90-yard touchdown reception against Eau Claire, the third reception of his career of at least 90 yards. Staehling had a 96yard touchdown against Grinnell on Sept. 23, 2017 and a 90-yard score against Beloit on Nov. 4, 2017.

Staehling is now fourth in St. Norbert history with 2,459 receiving yards. He trails Joe Green (2,503 - 2009-12) for third and Greg Rotherham (2,531 - 1974-77) for second. Mike Whitehouse holds the school record with 3,480 from 1986-89).

Staehling's 36 career touchdown receptions trail Whitehouse by one

Big Win:

St. Norbert's 27-21 win over UW-Eau Claire on Sept. 14 was a long time coming against a Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foe.

It was the first win on the gridiron over the WIAC for the Green Knights since a 25-7 win over UW-Platteville on Nov. 5, 1983 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. It also marked the first win over the WIAC in football for a sitting MWC member since 1935. St. Norbert joined the MWC for football in 1984.

Six of St. Norbert's losses against the WIAC since its win over Platteville were by seven points or less, with two in overtime.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is looking for its 21st consecutive winning season in 2019. The Green Knights' last season at-orbelow .500 was a 5-5 mark in 1998.

The Green Knights have an alltime record of 461-291-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .610. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 203-39, a winning percentage of .839.

St. Norbert has won 148 of its last 163 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .908.

The Green Knights have won at least seven games in 19 of the last 20 seasons. The lone exception was a 6-4 campaign in 2014.

Last season was St. Norbert's sixth season with at least 10 wins. The Green Knights won a school-record 11 games in 2003 and also won 10 games in 2000, 2006, 2007 and 2015.

Quick Hitters:

* - Jake Berken's 31-yard interception return for a touchdown was St. Norbert's first defensive score against a WIAC foe in 36 years. John Whitehouse's 16-yard interception return against UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 24, 1983 was the last one.

* - St. Norbert is 214-14 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 130-3 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
