Game Overview:

St. Norbert pays its final visit to Ingalls Field as a member of the Midwest Conference when it faces Ripon on Saturday in the Green Knights' North Division opener. St. Norbert is departing for the Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference after the 2020-21 school year.

The Series:

St. Norbert owns a 29-10 lead over Ripon in a hotly contested series that dates back to 1979. St. Norbert has won 19 of the last 20 meetings in the series, the Green Knights' lone blemish a 19-7 Ripon win at Ingalls Field in 2008. The Green Knights are 13-6 all-time at Ripon in the series and hold an all-time 1,176-708 scoring edge in the rivalry.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Ripon 30-17 on Oct. 6, 2018 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights jumped out to a 24-3 halftime lead en route to the win. St. Norbert held a 343-248 edge in total offense. Drew Rhodes completed 16 of 21 passes for 206 yards to lead the Green Knights, while Samuel Staehling added four receptions for 104 yards and one touchdown. Spenser Thompson-Meyers added three field goals for the Green Knights.

The Red Hawks got 75 rushing yards on 11 carries out of Tyler VanDeVelde.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 35-11 in his fifth season in De Pere. He is 4-0 all-time against Ripon.

Ripon coach Ron Ernst (Nebraska Wesleyan, 1980) is 175-104 in his 29th season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 1-2 overall. The Green Knights were defeated 34-14 at Monmouth on Sept. 28.

Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling has 22 receptions for 520 yards - an average of 23.6 yards per reception - with six touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Matt Galanopoulos has 24 receptions for 217 yards and two touchdowns. Junior quarterback Freddy Poorman has completed 47 of 87 passes for 576 yards with five touchdowns and three interceptions, while senior quarterback Gage McClanahan has completed 32 of 47 passes for 441 yards with three touchdowns and five interceptions. Sophomore running back Nate Ihlenfeldt has 30 rushes for 161 yards and one touchdown.

Junior linebacker Zach Kratky leads the Green Knights in tackles with 25. Junior linebacker Maccabee Barrett has 20 tackles and a team high 3 1/2 tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive lineman Kordell Draves and senior defensive back Joe Peterson each have 15 tackles. Peterson has four interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 27.0 points and 409.7 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 35.0 points and 429.0 yards per game.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game 1-3 overall. The Red Hawks are coming off a 20-0 home loss to Monmouth this past Saturday.

Sophomore quarterback Cormac Madigan fuels Ripon's triple-option offense, rushing 59 times for 309

yards. Junior slot Austin Bunders has 35 carries for 156 yards and four touchdowns, while senior fullback Tyler VanDeVelde has 37 carries for 139 yards. Madigan has completed 24 of 64 passes for 277 yards with three touchdowns and four interceptions. VanDeVelde has a team-high seven receptions for 18 yards.

Senior defensive back Lane Barnes is having another banner season for the Red Hawks, totaling 44 tackles with 5 1/2 tackles-for-loss. Sophomore linebacker Reece Schreckengust has 25 tackles, while senior defensive back Armando Mosqueda has 23 stops. Senior defensive back Cameron Gruenwald has 22 tackles and a team-high two interceptions.

Ripon is averaging 24.0 points and 283.2 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Red Hawks are allowing 24.0 points and 291.2 yards per game.

Staehling Stuff:

Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling finished with seven receptions for 145 yards and one touchdown in St. Norbert's 34-14 loss Sept. 28 at Monmouth. It was Staehling's 11th career 100-yard receiving game.

Staehling has 22 receptions for 520 yards this season, and is the NCAA Division III leader at 173.3 receiving yards per game.

Staehling's touchdown reception against Monmouth was the 37th of his career, tying him with Mike Whitehouse for the St. Norbert record. Whitehouse played from 1986 to 1989.

Staehling is now second in St. Norbert history with 2,604 receiving yards on 123 receptions. He trails only Whitehouse, who had 3,480 receiving yards.

Staehling is averaging 21.2 yards per reception on his career, which is the national leader at all NCAA divisions. Staehling's career receiving yards total is currently eighth among all active NCAA Division III players.

Staehling had a 90-yard touchdown reception against UW-Eau Claire on Sept. 14, the third recep-

tion of his career of at least 90 yards. Staehling had a 96-yard touchdown against Grinnell on Sept. 23, 2017 and a 90-yard score against Beloit on Nov. 4, 2017.

Passing Fancy:

St. Norbert enters the Grinnell game averaging a lofty 349.7 passing yards per game. That total is currently good for fourth in the NCAA Division III national statistics.

The Green Knights have never averaged 300 passing yards per game over a single season in its history. St. Norbert has five seasons where it has averaged at least 250 passing yards per game.

The Green Knights averaged 291.6 passing yards per game in 2001, followed by 260.4 in 2007. St. Norbert netted 257.3 per game in 1983, 251.5 in 2004 and 250.9 in 1999.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is looking for its 21st consecutive winning season in 2019. The Green Knights' last season at-or-below .500 was a 5-5 mark in 1998.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 461-292-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .609. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 203-39, a winning percentage of .839.

St. Norbert has won 148 of its last 163 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .908.

The Green Knights have won at least seven games in 19 of the last 20 seasons. The lone exception was a 6-4 campaign in 2014.

Last season was St. Norbert's sixth season with at least 10 wins. The Green Knights won a school-record 11 games in 2003 and also won 10 games in 2000, 2006, 2007 and 2015.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert opponents are averaging 11.3 penalties and 101 penalty yards per game. The Green Knights are averaging 5.0 penalties and 44.7 penalty yards per game.

* - St. Norbert is 214-14 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 130-3 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
