St. Norbert will finish its home schedule for 2019 when it hosts Lawrence for the final time as a Midwest Conference member. The Green Knights have defeated the Vikings 21 consecutive times.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 30-9-2 lead over Lawrence in a series begun in 1932. The Green Knights have won the last 21 meetings with the Vikings since a 27-24 Lawrence win in 1997 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. Lawrence claims only a 30-13-2 deficit in the series, but four games were played before St. Norbert began sponsoring full varsity intercollegiate football in 1931.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert trimmed Lawrence 46-0 on a cold, blustery night on Oct. 20, 2018 at The Banta Bowl in Appleton. The Green Knights scored nine points in the last 1:06 of the second quarter to take an 18-0 lead at halftime and pulled away from there. St. Norbert outgained Lawrence 426-59 in total offense, as the Vikings finished with four first downs and minus-27 yards rushing. Drew Rhodes rushed 18 times for 102 yards and completed 8 of 15

passes for 98 yards and two touchdowns for St. Norbert. Nate Ihlenfeldt added 75 rushing yards on 15 carries and one touchdown. Wyatt Lee led Lawrence with 23 tackles.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 37-11 in his fifth season in De Pere. He is 4-0 all-time against Lawrence.

Lawrence coach Rob McCarthy (Concordia-Moorhead, 1989) is 9-37 in his fifth season in Appleton.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 3-2 overall and 2-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division after a 66-0 Homecoming win over Beloit this past Saturday.

Sophomore running back Nate Ihlenfeldt leads the Green Knights offensively with 497 rushing yards and five touchdowns on 69 carries Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling has 29 receptions for 603 yards and eight touchdowns, while iunior wide receiver Galanopoulos has 28 receptions for quarterback Gage McClanahan has completed 38 of 59 passes for 520 yards with three touchdowns and five interceptions. Sophomore quarterback Ben Kohl has rushed for 111 yards on 17 carries with three touchdowns while completing 5 of 7 passes for 71 vards and one touchdown.

Junior linebacker Maccabee Barrett owns the team lead in tackles with 33. Junior linebacker Zach Kratky has 29 tackles, while senior defensive lineman Blake Olejniczak has 21 tackles. Senior defensive lineman Kordell Draves has 20 tackles and a team-high six tackles-forloss. Senior defensive back Joe Peterson has 18 tackles and six interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 34.2 points and 422.8 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 22.2 points and 317.4 yards per game.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the game 1-5 overall and 0-2 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Vikings dropped a 16-6 home deci-

sion to Macalester this past Saturday.

Senior running back Wasonu Allen tops Lawrence on the ground with 333 yards and two touchdowns on 67 carries. Junior wide receiver Ethan Simmons has 285 yards on 41 carries and one touchdown and has with 17 receptions for 216 yards. Sophomore wide receiver Tanner Morris has 18 receptions for 197 yards with two touchdowns. Junior quarterback Billy Wallisch has completed 41 of 108 passes for 462 yards and one touchdown with nine interceptions.

Sophomore defensive back Jaxon Stratton has a team-high 48 tackles, while sophomore linebacker Eder Bellegarde has 45 stops. Sophomore defensive lineman Zachary Adams has 39 tackles with seven tacklesfor-loss, while senior defensive lineman Jasaad Graves has 28 tackles, 11 1/2 tackles-for-loss and four quarterback sacks.

Lawrence is averaging 13.0 points and 268.0 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Buccaneers are allowing 21.0 points and 289.5 yards per game.

Halt!:

The St. Norbert defense had a banner day in Saturday's 66-0 win over Beloit, allowing the Buccaneers just 57 yards of total offense and three first downs.

It marked the third time in the last two seasons St. Norbert has allowed an opponent less than 100 yards of offense in a game. The Green Knights held Grinnell to 49 yards in a 91-0 win on Sept. 22, 2018 and Lawrence to 59 yards in a 46-0 win on Oct. 20, 2018. The school record is minus-21 yards in a 29-0 win over Illinois College on Sept. 29, 1990.

The three first downs was the second time since 1960 the Green Knights have held an opponent to that few. St. Norbert held Lawrence to three in a 79-7 win over the Vikings on Oct. 13, 2012. The school record is one first down allowed in a 23-0 win over St. Joseph's (Ind.) on Sept. 17, 1946.

record for career touchdown receptions with 39.

Staehling's record-breaking 38th touchdown reception came on a 14-yard pass from Ben Kohl in a 66-0 win over Beloit on Oct. 19. It surpassed Mike Whitehouse, who had 37 from 1986 to 1989.

Staehling is now second in St. Norbert history with 2,687 receiving yards on 130 receptions. He trails only Whitehouse, who had 3,480 receiving yards.

Staehling is averaging 20.7 yards per reception on his career, which is the national leader at all NCAA divisions.

Staehling had a 90-yard touchdown reception against UW-Eau Claire on Sept. 14, the third reception of his career of at least 90 yards. Staehling had a 96-yard touchdown against Grinnell on Sept. 23, 2017 and a 90-yard score against Beloit on Nov. 4, 2017.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is looking for its 21st consecutive winning season in 2019. The Green Knights' last season at-orbelow .500 was a 5-5 mark in 1998.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 463-292-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .610. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 205-39, a winning percentage of .840.

St. Norbert has won 150 of its last 165 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .909.

The Green Knights have won at least seven games in 19 of the last 20 seasons. The lone exception was a 6-4 campaign in 2014.

Last season was St. Norbert's sixth season with at least 10 wins. The Green Knights won a school-record 11 games in 2003 and also won 10 games in 2000, 2006, 2007 and 2015.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert senior defensive back Joe Peterson is leading Division III in interceptions per game at 1.2, getting six in five games.
- * St. Norbert is 215-14 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 131-3 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
