The Series:

St. Norbert leads Macalester 4-1 in an all-time series begun in 2014, the year the Scots joined the Midwest Conference as an affiliate member. The Green Knights have won the last four games in the series, including a 2-0 mark in St. Paul.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert slipped past Macalester 17-15 on Oct. 27, 2018 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights led 14-0 on touchdown runs of 12 and 15 yards by Matt Galanopoulos before Macalester mounted a rally. Grady Munro found Alec Beatty on touchdown passes of 11 and 17 yards sandwiched around a 29-yard field goal by St. Norbert's Spenser Thompson-Meyers. The Green Knights recovered an onside kick with 3:54

left and ran out the clock. Macalester outgained St. Norbert 300-229. Nate Ihlenfeldt led St. Norbert with 82 rushing yards on 17 carries. Munro completed 24 of 41 passes for 289 yards but was intercepted three times, while Beatty caught 10 passes for 125 yards for the Scots.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 38-11 in his fifth season in De Pere. He is 4-0 all-time against Macalester.

Macalester coach Tony Jennison (UW-La Crosse, 1997) is 59-57 in his 12th season in St. Paul.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 4-2 overall and 3-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Green Knights pitched their second consecutive shutout with a 41-0 win over Lawrence this past Saturday in De Pere.

Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling has 36 receptions for 818 yards - an average of 22.7 yards per catch - with 10 touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Matt Galanopoulos has 33 catches for 314 yards and three scores. Sophomore running back Nate Ihlenfeldt has a teamhigh 541 yards rushing on 79 attempts with five touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Ben Kohl has 206 rushing yards on 26 carries with four touchdowns and has completed 8 of 13 passes for 176 vards and three touchdowns. quarterback Senior Gage McClanahan has completed 59 of 93 passes for 763 yards with five touchdowns and five interceptions.

Junior linebacker Maccabee Barrett tops the Green Knights in tackles with 36. Junior linebacker Zach Kratky has 30 tackles, while senior defensive lineman Blake Olejniczak has 26 tackles. Senior defensive lineman Kordell Draves has 24 tackles and a team-high 7 1/2 tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive back Joe Peterson has 19 tackles and six interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 35.3 points and 439.2 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 18.5 points

and 275.7 yards per game.

About the Scots:

Macalester enters the game with a 3-4 overall record and a 1-2 mark in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Scots are coming off a 14-7 home loss to Ripon this past Saturday.

Freshman quarterback Michael Nadeau has completed 52 of 99 passes for 635 yards with four touchdowns and four interceptions. Sophomore running back Kian Sohrabi has rushed 73 times for 360 yards and one touchdown, while sophomore running back Kai Akimoto has 236 rushing yards on 68 attempts and four touchdowns. Sophomore wide receiver Peter Vitalis has 26 receptions for 295 yards and three scores, while senior wide receiver Reese Bresson has 21 receptions for 308 yards.

Junior defensive lineman John Newton has a team-high 41 tackles with seven tackles-for-loss and three quarterback sacks. Senior linebacker Dane Ku Blake has 39 tackles with 6 1/2 tackles-for-loss and three quarterback sacks. Senior defensive back Mason Cohn has 37 tackles.

Macalester is averaging 17.6 points and 293.0 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Scots are allowing 18.3 points and 336.4 yards per game.

Do Not Cross:

St. Norbert's defense pitched its second straight shutout with a 41-0 win over Lawrence this past Saturday. It marks the third consecutive season the Green Knights have posted back-to-back shutouts.

The Green Knights held Lawrence to 67 yards of offense and two first downs. That came on the heels of St. Norbert holding Beloit to 57 yards and three first downs in a 66-0 win on Oct. 19, for an aggregate of 124 yards and five first downs yielded in the last two games. St. Norbert has outscored its foes 131-6 in MWC North play.

The two first downs are the fewest allowed in a game by St. Norbert in a game since giving up just one in a 23-0 win over St. Joseph's (Ind.) on Nov. 17, 1946.

Staehling Stuff:

Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling extended his St. Norbert record for career touchdown receptions with 41 with a pair against Lawrence this past Saturday.

Staehling's record-breaking 38th touchdown reception came on a 14yard pass from Ben Kohl in a 66-0 win over Beloit on Oct. 19. It surpassed Mike Whitehouse, who had 37 from 1986 to 1989.

Staehling is now second in St. Norbert history with 2,902 receiving yards on 137 receptions. He trails only Whitehouse, who had 3,480 receiving yards.

Staehling is averaging 21.2 yards per reception on his career, which is the national leader in all NCAA divisions.

Staehling had a 90-yard touchdown reception against UW-Eau Claire on Sept. 14, the third reception of his career of at least 90 yards. Staehling had a 96-yard touchdown against Grinnell on Sept. 23, 2017 and a 90-yard score against Beloit on Nov. 4, 2017.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is looking for its 21st consecutive winning season in 2019. The Green Knights' last season at-orbelow .500 was a 5-5 mark in 1998.

The Green Knights have an alltime record of 464-292-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .611. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 206-39, a winning percentage of .841.

St. Norbert has won 151 of its last 166 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .910.

The Green Knights have won at least seven games in 19 of the last 20 seasons. The lone exception was a 6-4 campaign in 2014.

Last season was St. Norbert's sixth season with at least 10 wins. The Green Knights won a school-record 11 games in 2003 and also won 10 games in 2000, 2006, 2007 and 2015.
