The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 28-3 lead on Lake Forest in the all-time series, which began in 1984. The Green Knights had won 10 consecutive games in the series until a 31-3 Lake Forest win on Nov. 16, 2013 in Lake Forest, Ill., which is the last game in the series played at Lake Forest. The Foresters' only other wins in the series came in 1986 and 2002.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Lake Forest 35-21 on Oct. 1, 2016 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights jumped out to a 28-0 lead before the Foresters cut the deficit to 28-14, but a J.T. Crosby 11-yard touchdown run with 9:43 left sealed the win. St. Norbert outgained Lake Forest 432-315 in total offense. Crosby completed 15 of 24 passes for 196 yards and also rushed 17 times for 82 yards and two touchdowns. Elijah Fort finished with

108 rushing yards on 13 carries and one touchdowns. Joey Valdivia led Lake Forest with 118 yards rushing on 27 carries, while Jagan Cleary completed 19 of 36 passes for 200 yards with three interceptions.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 39-11 in his fifth season in De Pere. He is 1-0 all-time against Lake Forest.

Lake Forest coach Jim Catanzaro (Greenville, 2000) is 60-48 in his 11th season in Lake Forest.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the contest 5-2 overall and 4-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Green Knights fashioned a 49-7 win at Macalester this past Saturday.

Senior wide receiver Samuel Staehling owns 39 receptions for 870 yards - an average of 22.3 yards per catch - with 11 touchdowns. wide receiver Matt Junior Galanopoulos has 34 catches for 331 yards and three touchdowns. Sophomore running back Nate Ihlenfeldt has a team-high 702 yards rushing on 94 attempts with seven touchdowns, and is the MWC leader at 100.3 rushing yards per game. Sophomore quarterback Ben Kohl has 224 rushing yards on 37 carries with four touchdowns and has completed 9 of 14 passes for 187 vards and three touchdowns. Senior quarterback Gage McClanahan has completed 64 of 101 passes for 839 yards with six touchdowns and five interceptions.

Junior linebacker Maccabee Barrett leads the Green Knights in tackles with 43 and also has five tackles-for-loss. Junior linebacker Zach Kratky has 35 tackles, while senior defensive lineman Kordell Draves has 28 tackles and a teamhigh 8 1/2 tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive lineman Blake Olejniczak has 28 tackles with five tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive back Joe Peterson has 25 tackles with six interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 37.3 points and 430.7 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Green

Knights are allowing 16.9 points and 259.4 yards per game.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the game 7-1 overall and 4-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Foresters clipped Lawrence 42-14 this past Saturday in Appleton.

Senior quarterback Bill Degnan has completed 87 of 150 passes for 1,307 yards with 13 touchdowns and four interceptions. Sophomore running back Stone Matthews has 567 rushing yards on 106 attempts and five touchdowns, while junior running back Alex Adams has 442 rushing yards on 101 carries with five touchdowns. Freshman wide receiver A.J. Jackson is the only Forester in double digits in receptions with 35 for 618 yards and six touchdowns.

Senior defensive lineman Jordan McInerney has a team-high 64 tackles with 21 tackles-for-loss and 14 1/2 quarterback sacks. Senior linebacker Johnny Laponte has 52 tackles, while sophomore defensive back Anthony Rieck has 39 tackles.

Lake Forest is averaging 32.0 points and 321.6 yards per game this season. Defensively, the Foresters are allowing 11.6 points and 235.6 yards per game.

Matchup Musings:

Saturday's game will feature the Midwest Conference's No. 1 offense against the top-ranked defense based on yardage gained and allowed.

St. Norbert is averaging 430.7 yards per game, well ahead of Chicago's 412.1 yards per game for the top total offense in the MWC. Lake Forest is yielding just 245.5 yards per game, just ahead of St. Norbert's 259.4 yards per game. Lake Forest is 12th nationally in total defense while St. Norbert is 15th.

Lake Forest's offense is fourth in the MWC at 321.6 yards per game.

tions to 42 with a score this past Saturday at Macalester.

Staehling's record-breaking 38th touchdown reception came on a 14-yard pass from Ben Kohl in a 66-0 win over Beloit on Oct. 19. It surpassed Mike Whitehouse, who had 37 from 1986 to 1989.

Staehling is now second in St. Norbert history with 2,954 receiving yards on 140 receptions. He trails only Whitehouse, who had 3,480 receiving yards.

Staehling is averaging 21.1 yards per reception on his career, which is currently second among active players in all NCAA divisions.

Staehling had a 90-yard touchdown reception against UW-Eau Claire on Sept. 14, the third reception of his career of at least 90 yards. Staehling had a 96-yard touchdown against Grinnell on Sept. 23, 2017 and a 90-yard score against Beloit on Nov. 4, 2017.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is looking for its 21st consecutive winning season in 2019. The Green Knights' last season at-orbelow .500 was a 5-5 mark in 1998.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 465-292-20 in 83 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .611. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 207-39, a winning percentage of .841.

St. Norbert has won 152 of its last 167 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .910.

The Green Knights have won at least seven games in 19 of the last 20 seasons. The lone exception was a 6-4 campaign in 2014.

Last season was St. Norbert's sixth season with at least 10 wins. The Green Knights won a school-record 11 games in 2003 and also won 10 games in 2000, 2006, 2007 and 2015.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert is 217-14 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 133-3 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * This is St. Norbert's last scheduled visit to Lake Forest before the Green Knights move to the NACC in 2021.
