St. Norbert needs just one point over its final three games to clinch the No. 1 seed for the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs. The Green Knights have already clinched a share of their 10th NCHA championship in 12 years.

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stout 27-6-3. The Green Knights are 25-1-2 in the last 28 games.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 313-92-34 in his 15th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 169-23-17 in the last seven seasons.

UW-River Falls coach Steve Freeman (UW-Stevens Point, 1981) is 234-96-24 in his 12th season.

UW-Stout coach Terry Watkins (UW-Stout, 1972) is 136-168-17 in his 12th season in Menomonie.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert beat UW-River Falls 6-2 on Dec. 8 in Green Bay. Ryan Petersen scored one goal and two assists while Scott Pulak had three assists for St. Norbert. Pat Borgestad scored two goals for River Falls. Kyle Jones had 23 saves for St. Norbert, while Tyler Owens had 23 saves for River Falls.

St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 7-1 on Dec. 7 in Green Bay. Marc Belanger scored two goals for St. Norbert, while Shane Wheeler added three assists. Kyle Jones made 13 saves for the Green Knights, who outshot Stout 33-14.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert picked up three points on the road this past weekend following a 1-1 tie at UW-Superior and a 3-0 win over St. Scholastica. The Green Knights are 18-1-3 overall, 8-0-3 in the NCHA and own a 19-game unbeaten streak. St. Norbert has clinched a share of its 10th NCHA championship in 12 years and needs just one point in its last three games to clinch the No. 1 seed for the Peters Cup Playoffs.

Senior forward Marc Belanger leads St. Norbert with 17 goals and 17 assists for 34 points. Sophomore forward Matt Boyd has 16 goals and 17 assists for 33 points. Sophomore forward Shane Wheeler, who has missed the last six of the last seven games, has five goals and 16 assists for 21 points.

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones has an 12-1-3 record this season with a 1.29 goals against average and .941 save percentage. Freshman Blake Bashor is 6-0-0 with a 1.82 GAA and

.901 save percentage.

St. Norbert's power play is 33-for-134 this season (24.6 percent), while its penalty kill is 113-for-124 (91.1 percent).

About the Falcons:

UW-River Falls enters the weekend at 14-5-3 overall and 6-4-1 in the NCHA. The Falcons have lost three consecutive games, including a weekend sweep last weekend when they lost 3-2 at UW-Stevens Point and 5-0 at UW-Eau Claire.

Senior forward Tyler Dahl leads the Falcons in scoring with six goals and 29 assists for 35 points, and has 148 career points in 106 games. Junior forward Derek Hansberry has 18 goals and 15 assists for 33 points. Senior forward Pat Borgestad leads the NCHA in goals with 21 and also has 11 assists for 32 points.

Sophomore goaltender Stephen Ritter, a transfer at semester, is 6-3 with a 2.48 goals against average and .926 save percentage. Sophomore Tyler Owens is 7-2-2 with a 3.05 goals against average and .896 save percentage.

River Falls' power play is 34-for-124 (27.4 percent), while its penalty kill is 95-for-119 (79.8 percent).

About the Blue Devils:

Stout enters Friday's game with Lake Forest at 14-6-2 overall and 6-4-1 in the NCHA. The Blue Devils beat UW-Eau Claire 4-1 and tied UW-Stevens Point 1-1 this past weekend.

Sophomore forward Joel Gaulrapp leads Stout in scoring, notching 16 goals and 10 assists for 26 points. Gaulrapp has 10 power-play goals this season. Sophomore forward Derek Hanson has 15 goals and 11 assists for 26 points. Junior forward Jeff Wheeler has 10 goals and 13 assists for 23 points.

Senior goaltender Mike Stone has returned to action of late, and owns numbers of 3-2-1 with a 2.08 goals against average and .921 save percentage this season. Junior Matt Koenig is 11-4-1 with a 2.74 goals against average and .908 save percentage.

Stout's power play is 35-for-131 (26.7 percent), while its penalty kill is 97-for-117 (82.9 percent).

Jones Jabber:

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones extended his Division III record for career shutouts to 20 with 29 saves in a 3-0 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 2. The shutout of St. Scholastica was Jones' fifth shutout of this season.

Jones' 20 career shutouts are the second-most all-time by any collegiate goalie. Only current Buffalo Sabre Ryan Miller has more with 26 shutouts at Michigan State from 1999-2002.

By getting his fifth shutout of the 2006-07 season against St. Scholastica on Feb. 3, Jones now has five shutouts in a season for the third time in his career. In NCAA Division III history, a goaltender has put together a five-shutout season just eight times. Jones is the only goaltender to do it multiple times with five shutouts in 2004-05, seven in 2005-06 and five this season. Four of the eight occasions belong to St. Norbert goaltenders, with Chancy Colquhoun getting seven shutouts in 2003-04.

Jones' career record currently stands at 78-10-8, the most wins ever by a Division III goaltender. He has a 1.69 lifetime goals against average and .922 save percentage. Jones' career goals against average currently is the second-best in Division III history, behind Christian Carlsson of Middlebury, who had a 1.40 GAA from 1999-2002.

The next closest active Division III goaltender in wins to Jones is Oswego State's Ryan Scott, who is 57-20-6.

In addition to his 20 shutouts, Jones has 23 career games where he has allowed just one goal. In 97 career starts, Jones is 42-0-1 when allowing one goal or less. Jones has allowed one goal or less in 44.3 percent of his career starts.

Jones also owns or shares NCAA Division III records with shutouts in a season (seven), consecutive shutouts (four) and consecutive shutout minutes (337:22).

Jones, the 2006 NCHA Player of the Year, is 12-1-2 this season with a 1.29 GAA and .941 save percentage. He currently leads Division III in goals against average and is third in save percentage. In NCHA play this season, Jones has a 1.07 goals against average and .954 save percentage.

Amazingly, Jones has never been selected as a first-team All-American by the American Hockey Coaches Association.

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert is currently on a 19-game unbeaten streak, going 16-0-3 since a 4-2 loss to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3.

St. Norbert has had three 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a school record 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 11 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history. Middlebury is the only

other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19-game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-2 over that 31-game stretch.

Kill Comments:

St. Norbert is enjoying a strong season on the penalty kill. The Green Knights are 113-for-124 on the penalty kill this season, a solid 91.1 percent.

Should the Green Knights keep that pace on the penalty kill, it would rank in the top five all time in Division III history.

St. Norbert had its best season ever on the penalty kill a year ago, turning away 170 of 190 chances for 89.5 percent. The Green Knights led Division III in penalty kill in 2003 at 89.4 percent.

In NCHA play, St. Norbert's penalty kill is 52-for-55, a percentage of 94.5 percent.

Seven of the 11 power-play goals St. Norbert has allowed this season came against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference teams. Gustavus Adolphus, St. John's and St. Mary's all scored two power-play goals each, and St. Olaf tallied one. Against foes this season not from the MIAC, St. Norbert's penalty kill is 71-for-75 (94.7 percent).

Boyd Banter:

Sophomore forward Matt Boyd continues a red-hot stretch of games, scoring 18 points in his last 10 games.

Boyd has scored in 19 of 22 games this season, and has had multiple-point games in seven of his last ten contests. Boyd has scored nine goals with nine assists for 18 points in his last 10 games.

Boyd scored overtime game-winners on back-to-back nights, getting the decisive markers against St. Mary's and St. Thomas on Jan. 11-12. He has three career overtime goals.

In 52 career games, Boyd has 26 goals and 38 assists for 64 points.

Belanger Bits:

Senior forward Marc Belanger had his consecutive games scoring streak snapped at 16 when he went scoreless in a 1-1 tie with UW-Superior on Feb. 1. Belanger had scored 13 goals and 13 assists for 26 points during his current streak.

Belanger was one game shy of tying Maris Ziedins' team record of 17 for consecutive games scored in, set from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Belanger has scored in 20 of 22 games this season, also not getting on the scoresheet in a 3-1 win at Concordia-Moorhead on Nov. 10.

Belanger carried a nine-game scoring streak into this season, giving him a point in 29 of his last 31 games. In his last 31 games, Belanger has scored 23 goals with 18 assists for 41 points.

With 121 career points, Belanger is tied for eighth with Rob Garofolo on St. Norbert's career scoring list.
