Game Overview:

St. Norbert begins post-season play with a NCHA Quarterfinal series against Lake Forest. The Green Knights have won a NCHA Quarterfinal series every year since 1998.

Broadcast:

The Series:

St. Norbert has played Lake Forest 58 times, more than any other opponent, and holds a 35-20-3 advantage. The Green Knights have played the Foresters at least once every season in the 20 years St. Norbert has had a hockey program. Lake Forest won the first 14 games in the series, with St. Norbert posting a 35-6-3 ledger since. St. Norbert is 22-1 against Lake Forest at home under Tim Coghlin in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 315-92-35 in his 15th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 171-23-18 in the last seven seasons.

Lake Forest coach Tony Fritz is 337-390-40 in his 30th season in Lake Forest.

This Year:

St. Norbert beat Lake Forest 6-0 on Jan. 19 at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights outshot Lake Forest 49-8, with the eight shots allowed tying a St. Norbert record. Matt Boyd scored two goals while Tyler Allen, Nick Tabisz, Taylor Langford and Adam Hammerbeck added markers for St. Norbert.

St. Norbert beat Lake Forest 6-2 on Feb. 16 at Alumni Memorial Rink. St. Norbert led 4-2 after two periods before breaking the game open. The Green Knights outshot the Foresters 60-28. Taylor Langford and Ryan Petersen both had one goal and one assist for St. Norbert.

Playoff Format:

The quarterfinals will have a two-game series format. There will be a five-minute overtime played in case of a tie in regulation. If the teams split or tie both of the two games, a 20-minute "mini-game" will be played following the completion of Saturday night's game. If the mini-game results in a tie, the game will continue in a sudden-death format using 20-minute overtime periods.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert wrapped up the regular season with a 6-2 win at Lake Forest this past Saturday. The Green Knights are 20-1-4 overall and finished 10-0-4 in the NCHA. St. Norbert owns a 22-game unbeaten streak and has won its 10th NCHA championship in 12 years and its seventh consecutive title.

Senior forward Marc Belanger leads St. Norbert with 19 goals and 18 assists for 37 points. Sophomore forward Matt Boyd has 16 goals and 19 assists for 35 points. Sophomore forward Shane Wheeler has seven

goals and 16 assists for 23 points.

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones has a 14-1-3 record this season with a 1.31 goals against average and .940 save percentage. Freshman Blake Bashor is 6-0-1 with a 1.96 goals against average and .899 save percentage.

St. Norbert's power play is 34-for-146 this season (23.3 percent), while its penalty kill is 129-for-143 (90.2 percent).

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs with a 3-21-1 overall record. The Foresters were 1-13 in the NCHA. The Foresters lost at home last Saturday to St. Norbert 6-2.

Junior forward Mike Kneeland leads the Foresters in scoring with seven goals and 11 assists for 18 points. Freshman forward Peter Pfeffer has six goals and nine assists for 15 points, while sophomore forward Adam Love has eight goals and five assists for 13 points.

Junior goaltender Scott Campbell is 3-11-1 with a 4.09 goals against average and .910 save percentage. Junior Brandon Kohuch is 0-10 with a 5.03 goals against average and .872 save percentage.

Lake Forest's power play is 14-for-121 (11.6 percent), while its penalty kill is 123-for-152 (80.9 percent).

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert is currently on a 22-game unbeaten streak, going 18-0-4 since a 4-2 loss to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3.

In addition to the current streak, St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a school record 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 11 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history. Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-

03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19-game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-2 over that 31-game stretch.

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 29-2-4 overall and are 18-0-4 against NCHA opponents.

Jones Jabber:

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones extended his Division III record for career shutouts to 20 with 29 saves in a 3-0 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 2. The shutout of St. Scholastica was Jones' fifth shutout of this season.

Jones' 20 career shutouts are the second-most all-time by any collegiate goalie. Only current Buffalo Sabre Ryan Miller has more with 26 shutouts at Michigan State from 1999-2002.

By getting his fifth shutout of the 2007-08 season against St. Scholastica on Feb. 2, Jones now has five shutouts in a season for the third time in his career. In NCAA Division III history, a goaltender has put together a five-shutout season just eight times. Jones is the only goaltender to do it multiple times with five shutouts in 2004-05, seven in 2005-06 and five this season. Four of the eight occasions belong to St. Norbert goaltenders, with Chancy Colquhoun getting seven shutouts in 2003-04.

Jones' career record currently

stands at 80-10-8, the most wins ever by a Division III goaltender. He has a 1.69 lifetime goals against average and .922 save percentage. Jones' career goals against average currently is the second-best in Division III history, behind Christian Carlsson of Middlebury, who had a 1.40 GAA from 1999-2002.

The next closest active Division III goaltender in wins to Jones is Oswego State's Ryan Scott, who is 60-20-6.

In addition to his 20 shutouts, Jones has 24 career games where he has allowed just one goal. In 99 career starts, Jones is 43-0-1 when allowing one goal or less. Jones has allowed one goal or less in 44.4 percent of his career starts.

Jones also owns or shares NCAA Division III records with shutouts in a season (seven), consecutive shutouts (four) and consecutive shutout minutes (337:22).

Jones, the 2006 and 2008 NCHA Player of the Year, is 14-1-3 this season with a 1.31 GAA and .940 save percentage. He currently leads Division III in goals against average and is second in save percentage. In NCHA play this season, Jones had a 1.14 goals against average and .950 save percentage.

Jones, who is expected to make his 100th career start this weekend, is one of only two players in NCHA history to be named NCHA Player of the Year twice. Bemidji State's Mike Alexander was named NCHA Player of the Year in 1985 and 1986.

Amazingly, Jones has never been selected as a first-team All-

Peters Cup Patter:

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just one NCHA Peters Cup Playoff series on the road. The Green Knights, after a third-place finish in the NCHA in 2000-01, played at UW-River Falls in the semifinal round and were eliminated 1-0 in an overtime mini-game. St. Norbert finished second in 1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game by UW-Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

St. Norbert has played 30 of the last 31 NCHA Peters Cup Playoff rounds it has played in on home ice. The Green Knights are 40-11-1 all-time in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs, and are 39-7 at home all-time in the Peters Cup tournament. St. Norbert has played only away series against UW-River Falls (twice) and UW-Stevens Point on the all-time in Peters Cup play.

Kill Comments:

St. Norbert is enjoying a strong season on the penalty kill. The Green Knights are 129-for-143 on the penalty kill this season, a solid 90.2 percent. That number currently leads Division III.

Should the Green Knights keep that pace on the penalty kill, it would rank in the top ten all time in Division III history.

St. Norbert had its best season ever on the penalty kill a year ago,

turning away 170 of 190 chances for 89.5 percent. The Green Knights led Division III in penalty kill in 2003 at 89.4 percent.

In NCHA play this season, St. Norbert's penalty kill was 68-for-74, a percentage of 91.9 percent.

Seven of the 14 power-play goals St. Norbert has allowed this season came against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference teams. Gustavus Adolphus, St. John's and St. Mary's all scored two power-play goals each, and St. Olaf tallied one. Against foes this season not from the MIAC, St. Norbert's penalty kill is 101-for-108 (93.5 percent).

UW-Stout scored twice on the power play on Feb. 9, the first NCHA team to score twice with the man advantage against the Green Knights this season.

Belanger Bits:

Senior forward Marc Belanger had his consecutive games scoring streak snapped at 16 when he went scoreless in a 1-1 tie with UW-Superior on Feb. 1. Belanger had scored 13 goals and 13 assists for 26 points during his streak.

Belanger was one game shy of tying Maris Ziedins' team record of 17 for consecutive games scored in, set from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Belanger has scored in 23 of 25 games this season, also not getting on the scoresheet in a 3-1 win at Concordia-Moorhead on Nov. 10.

Belanger carried a nine-game scoring streak into this season, giving him a point in 32 of his last 34 games. In his last 34 games, Belanger has scored 25 goals with

Belanger's 58 career goals leaves him seventh all-time at St. Norbert. He needs two goals to match Hughes in sixth with 60 career markers.

Boyd Banter:

Sophomore forward Matt Boyd has scored 20 points in his last 13 games.

Boyd has scored in 21 of 25 games this season. Boyd has scored nine goals with 11 assists for 20 points in his last 13 games.

Boyd scored overtime game-winners on back-to-back nights, getting the decisive markers against St. Mary's and St. Thomas on Jan. 11-12. He has three career overtime goals.

In 55 career games, Boyd has 26 goals and 40 assists for 66 points.

Boyd has not scored a goal since Jan. 26 against UW-Stevens Point.

Milestone Matter:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin was named NCHA Coach of the Year for the fifth time following recent voting by league coaches.

That mark ties Coghlin with Bemidji State's Bob Peters (1982, 1984, 1985, 1986, 1991) for most NCHA Coach of the Year honors. Joe Baldarotta had won it four times while at UW-Stevens Point.

Coghlin became just the second coach in Northern Collegiate Hockey Association history to record 300 career wins while coaching in the league with the Green Knights' 4-3 overtime win over St. Thomas on Jan. 12. Coghlin's record while St. Norbert has been a member of the NCHA is 305-83-34 in 14 seasons.

Coghlin joined Bemidji State's Bob Peters as the only two coaches to hit that milestone. Peters went 370-134-36 in 17 years (1982, 1984-99).

According to the 2008 NCAA Ice Hockey Records Book, Coghlin entered the 2007-08 season third in history among all college hockey coaches in winning percentage. Only

Massachusetts-Dartmouth's John Rolli (.787, 466-119-20, 1985-present) and Alfred Winsor Jr. of Harvard (.761, 86-27-0, 1906-17, 1922) had better winning percentages than Coghlin's .745 entering this season.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 191-1-3 in school history at home when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

The most recent tie came Nov. 30 when St. Scholastica claimed a 2-2 draw after trailing 2-1 entering the final period.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 173-0-2 at home when up after two periods. The overall home unbeaten streak when up after two stanzas is 190 games (187-0-3).

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 119 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert earned the No. 1 ranking for the first time this season when it earned the top spot in the Dec. 10, 2007 poll, and remained there for four consecutive polls until dropping to second Jan. 28. St. Norbert moved back into the top spot on Feb. 4 and is now in its third-straight week at No. 1. The Green Knights are 41-10-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 119-week stretch, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 34 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2007 final polls.

St. Norbert is 5-0-1 against ranked foes this season. St. Norbert is 67-26-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin has had a hand in 13 of the last 20 NCHA regular-season championships. Coghlin was the captain on UW-Stevens Point's 1989 national champion, which also won the NCHA. He was then an assistant in 1991-92 and 1992-93 at UW-Stevens Point when the Pointers claimed championships. Coghlin's team have won 10 regular-season NCHA crowns during his tenure at St. Norbert.

* - St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 205 games when scoring five goals or more with a 200-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

* - St. Norbert has allowed five goals in a game just once in its last 78 games - a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007. The Green Knights have gone 31 consecutive games without allowing five goals.
