St. Norbert continues post-season play with a NCHA Semifinal game against St. Scholastica. St. Norbert and St. Scholastica met for the 2007 Peters Cup Championship, with St. Norbert winning 3-0.

The Series:

St. Norbert is 35-6-2 all-time against St. Scholastica. The Green Knights are 32-1-2 in the last 35 meetings, and have outscored the Saints 127-22 in the last 22 games. Six of the last nine games have been shutout wins in St. Norbert's favor. St. Norbert is 24-0-2 all-time at home against St. Scholastica under Tim Coghlin.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 317-92-35 in his 15th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 173-23-18 in the last seven seasons.

St. Scholastica coach Mark Wick (St. Scholastica, 1985) is 45-51-14 in his fourth season in Duluth.

This Year:

St. Norbert and St. Scholastica tied 2-2 on Nov. 30 in Green Bay. Jordan Chong scored both goals for the Saints, while Sam Tikka and Matt Boyd scored for St. Norbert. Steve Bounds made 21 saves for St. Scholastica, while Kyle Jones made 22 saves for St. Norbert.

St. Norbert beat St. Scholastica 3-0 on Feb. 2 in Duluth. Mike Bernardy, Marc Belanger and Ryan Petersen scored goals for St. Norbert. Kyle Jones made 29 saves for the Green Knights while Steve Bounds made 32 saves for the Saints.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert extended its unbeaten streak to 24 games with a NCHA Quarterfinal sweep of Lake Forest this past weekend. The Green Knights are 22-1-4 overall and have been ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com poll for eight of the last nine weeks. St. Norbert has won at least a share of seven straight NCHA championships and 10 in the last 12 years.

Senior forward Marc Belanger leads St. Norbert with 21 goals and 20 assists for 41 points. Sophomore forward Matt Boyd has 16 goals and 20 assists for 36 points. Sophomore forward Shane Wheeler has seven goals and 18 assists for 25 points.

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones has a 16-1-3 record this season with a 1.18 goals against average and .943 save percentage. Freshman Blake Bashor is 6-0-1 with a 1.96 goals against average and .899 save percentage.

St. Norbert's power play is 38-for-159 this season (23.9 percent), while its penalty kill is 136-for-150 (90.7 percent).

About the Saints:

St. Scholastica enters the NCHA Semifinals with a 10-12-5 record after beating UW-River Falls in a quarterfinal series 5-2 and 3-3. The Saints are 2-0-3 in their last five games and 5-3-4 on the road.

Junior forward A.J. Tucker leads St. Scholastica in scoring with 15 goals and 17 assists and 32 points. Sophomore forward Jordan Chong has 11 goals and 10 assists for 21 points, while sophomore defenseman Jordan Baird has 10 goals and nine assists for 19 points.

Junior goaltender Steve Bounds is 6-6-2 with a 2.41 goals against average and .908 save percentage. Senior Tyler Johnson is 4-4-3 with a 3.07 goals against average and .894 save percentage.

St. Scholastica's power play is 20for-133 (15.0 percent) while its penalty kill is 124-for-147 (84.4 percent).

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert is currently on a 24game unbeaten streak, going 20-0-4 since a 4-2 loss to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3.

In addition to the current streak, St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a school record 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 11 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history. Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-2 over that 31-game stretch.

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 31-2-4 overall and are 20-0-4 against NCHA opponents.

Jones Jabber:

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones extended his Division III record for career shutouts to 22 with back-toback shutouts of Lake Forest on Feb. 22-23. It marked the fourth time in his career Jones has pitched at least two consecutive shutouts.

Jones' 22 career shutouts are the second-most all-time by any collegiate goalie. Only current Buffalo Sabre Ryan Miller has more with 26 shutouts at Michigan State from 1999-2002.

By getting his fifth shutout of the 2007-08 season against St. Scholastica on Feb. 2. Jones has had five shutouts in a season for the third time in his career. In NCAA Division III history, a goaltender has put together a five-shutout season just nine times. Jones is the only goaltender to do it multiple times with five shutouts in 2004-05, seven in 2005-06 and seven this season. Four of the nine occasions belong to St. Norbert goaltenders, with Chancy Colquhoun getting seven shutouts in 2003-04.

Jones' career record currently stands at 82-10-8, the most wins ever by a Division III goaltender. He has a 1.66 lifetime goals against average and .923 save percentage. Jones' career goals against average currently is the second-best in Division III history, behind Christian Carlsson of Middlebury, who had a 1.40 GAA from 1999-2002.

The next closest active Division III goaltender in wins to Jones is Oswego State's Ryan Scott, who is 61-20-6. In addition to his 22 shutouts, Jones has 24 career games where he has allowed just one goal. In 101 career starts, Jones is 45-0-1 when allowing one goal or less. Jones has allowed one goal or less in 45.5 percent of his career starts.

Jones also owns or shares NCAA Division III records with shutouts in a season (seven), consecutive shutouts (four) and consecutive shutout minutes (337:22).

Jones, the 2006 and 2008 NCHA Player of the Year, is 16-1-3 this season with a 1.18 GAA and .940 save percentage. He currently leads Division III in goals against average and save percentage. Lebanon Valley's Lincoln Matlock in 2002 was the last goaltender to lead Division III in both categories.

Jones' 1.18 goals against average is on pace to set a new NCAA Division III season record, topping the mark of 1.21 set by Middlebury's Francois Bourbeau in 1998. In fact the top nine GAA's in Division III history are by East Region players, with the best GAA ever posted by a West Regional netminder was 1.55 by St. Olaf's Dan Kehler in 2005.

Jones is one of only two players in NCHA history to be named NCHA Player of the Year twice. Bemidji State's Mike Alexander was named NCHA Player of the Year in 1985 and 1986.

Jones also needs just two saves for 2,000 career stops.

Amazingly, Jones has never been selected as a first-team All-American by the American Hockey Coaches Association.

Peters Cup Patter:

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just one NCHA Peters Cup Playoff series on the road. The Green Knights, after a third-place finish in the NCHA in 2000-01, played at UW-River Falls in the semifinal round and were eliminated 1-0 in an overtime minigame. St. Norbert finished second in 1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game by UW-Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

St. Norbert has played 31 of the last 32 NCHA Peters Cup Playoff rounds it has played in on home ice. The Green Knights are 42-11-1 alltime in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs, and are 41-7 at home alltime in the Peters Cup tournament. St. Norbert has played only away series against UW-River Falls (twice) and UW-Stevens Point on the all-time in Peters Cup play.

Kill Comments:

St. Norbert is enjoying a strong season on the penalty kill. The Green Knights are 136-for-150 on the penalty kill this season, a solid 90.7 percent. That number currently leads Division III.

Should the Green Knights keep that pace on the penalty kill, it would rank in the top ten all time in Division III history.

St. Norbert had its best season ever on the penalty kill a year ago, turning away 170 of 190 chances for 89.5 percent. The Green Knights led Division III in penalty kill in 2003 at 89.4 percent.

In NCHA play this season, St. Norbert's penalty kill was 68-for-74, a percentage of 91.9 percent.

Seven of the 14 power-play goals St. Norbert has allowed this season came against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference teams. Gustavus Adolphus, St. John's and St. Mary's all scored two power-play goals each, and St. Olaf tallied one. Against foes this season not from the MIAC, St. Norbert's penalty kill is 101-for-108 (93.5 percent).

UW-Stout scored twice on the power play on Feb. 9, the first NCHA team to score twice with the man advantage against the Green Knights this season.

Belanger Bits:

Senior forward Marc Belanger had his consecutive games scoring streak snapped at 16 when he went scoreless in a 1-1 tie with UW-Superior on Feb. 1. Belanger had scored 13 goals and 13 assists for 26 points during his streak.

Belanger was one game shy of tying Maris Ziedins' team record of 17 for consecutive games scored in, set from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Belanger has scored in 25 of 27 games this season, also not getting on the scoresheet in a 3-1 win at Concordia-Moorhead on Nov. 10.

Belanger carried a nine-game scoring streak into this season, giving him a point in 34 of his last 36 games. In his last 36 games, Belanger has scored 27 goals with 21 assists for 48 points.

With 128 career points, Belanger is in seventh in career scoring at St.

Belanger's 60 career goals tie him with Hughes for sixth all-time at St. Norbert. Belanger trails Scott Jewitt (61) by one for fifth, Bruce Henderson (62) by two for fourth and Jason Deitsch by four (64) for third.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 91-4-4 in its last 99 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last seven seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 104-7-6 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 113-11-7 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 192-33-13 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Milestone Matter:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin was named NCHA Coach of the Year for the fifth time (1998, 2002, '05, '06, '08) following recent voting by league coaches.

That mark ties Coghlin with Bemidji State's Bob Peters (1982, '84, '85, '86, '91) for most NCHA Coach of the Year honors. Joe Baldarotta had won it four times while at UW-Stevens Point.

Coghlin became just the second coach in Northern Collegiate Hockey Association history to record 300 career wins while coaching in the league with the Green Knights' 4-3 overtime win over St. Thomas on Jan. 12. Coghlin's record while St. Norbert has been a member of the NCHA is 307-83-34 in 14 seasons. Coghlin joined Peters as the only two coaches to hit that milestone. Peters went 370-134-36 in 17 years (1982, 1984-99).

Coghlin has had a hand in 13 of the last 20 NCHA regular-season championships. Coghlin was the captain on UW-Stevens Point's 1989 national champion, which also won the NCHA. He was then an assistant in 1991-92 and 1992-93 at UW-Stevens Point when the Pointers claimed championships. Coghlin's team have won 10 regularseason NCHA crowns during his tenure at St. Norbert.

According to the 2008 NCAA Ice Hockey Records Book, Coghlin entered the 2007-08 season third in history among all college hockey coaches in winning percentage. Only Massachusetts-Dartmouth's John Rolli (.787, 466-119-20, 1985-present) and Alfred Winsor Jr. of Harvard (.761, 86-27-0, 1906-17, 1922) had better winning percentages than Coghlin's .745 entering this season.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 193-1-3 in school history at home when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

The most recent tie came Nov. 30 when St. Scholastica claimed a 2-2 draw after trailing 2-1 entering the final period.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 175-0-2 at home when up after two periods. The overall home unbeaten streak when up after two stanzas is 192 games (189-0-3).

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 120 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert earned the No. 1 ranking for the first time this season when it earned the top spot in the Dec. 10, 2007 poll, and remained there for four consecutive polls until dropping to second Jan. 28. St. Norbert moved back into the top spot on Feb. 4 and is now in its fourth-straight week at No. 1. The Green Knights are 43-10-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 120-week stretch, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 35 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2007 final polls.

St. Norbert is 5-0-1 against ranked foes this season. St. Norbert is 67-26-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 206 games when scoring five goals or more with a 201-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

* - St. Norbert has allowed five goals in a game just once in its last 80 games - a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007. The Green Knights have gone 33 consecutive games without allowing five goals.
