#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert is in the hunt for its seventh NCHA Peters Cup Championship when it hosts UW-Stout. The Blue Devils are making their first NCHA Finals appearance. The winner receives the NCHA's automatic berth into the NCAA Division III Tournament.

#### Broadcast:

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stout 27-6-4. The Green Knights are 25-1-3 in the last 29 games overall and are 17-1 in their last 18 home games in the series. Stout is 0-9 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center and has been outscored 55-13 in games there.

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 318-92-35 in his 15th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 174-23-18 in the last seven seasons.

UW-Stout coach Terry Watkins (UW-Stout, 1972) is 140-169-18 in his 12th season in Menomonie.

### This Year:

St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 7-1 on Dec. 7 in Green Bay. Marc Belanger scored two goals for St. Norbert, while Shane Wheeler added three assists. Kyle Jones made 13 saves for the Green Knights, who outshot Stout 33-14.

St. Norbert and UW-Stout tied 3-3 on Feb. 9 in Menomonie. Marc Belanger's extra-attacker goal with 16 seconds remaining in regulation was the equalizer. Nick Klaren scored two goals for Stout. Mike Stone made 26 saves for Stout, while Blake Bashor made 25 stops for the Green Knights.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert extended its unbeaten streak to 25 games with a NCHA Semifinal win over St. Scholastica by a 1-0 score this past Saturday. The Green Knights are 23-1-4 overall and have been ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III poll for nine of the last 10 weeks. St. Norbert has won at least a share of seven straight NCHA championships and 10 in the last 12 years.

Senior forward Marc Belanger leads St. Norbert with 21 goals and 20 assists for 41 points. Sophomore forward Matt Boyd has 16 goals and 20 assists for 36 points. Sophomore forward Shane Wheeler has seven goals and 18 assists for 25 points.

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones has a 17-1-3 record this season with a 1.13 goals against average and .947 save percentage. Freshman Blake Bashor is 6-0-1 with a 1.96 goals against average and .899 save percentage.

St. Norbert's power play is 38-for-163 this season (23.3 percent), while its penalty kill is 140-for-154 (90.9 percent).

### About the Blue Devils:

UW-Stout enters the Peters Cup title game with an 18-7-3 record and went 7-5-2 in the NCHA. The Blue Devils opened the year 10-1-1, went through a 3-5 stretch, and are now 5-1-2 in their last eight games.

Sophomore forward Derek Hanson leads the Blue Devils in scoring with 21 goals and 19 assists for 40 points, along with 13 power-play goals. Sophomore forward Joel Gaulrapp has 18 goals and 17 assists for 35 points and 10 power-play goals. Junior defenseman Jack Wolgemuth has seven goals and 23 assists for 30 points.

Senior goaltender Mike Stone has seen most of the action down the stretch run, going 7-3-2 with a 2.02 goals against average and .924 save percentage.

Stout's power play is 49-for-174 (28.2 percent) while its penalty kill is 122-for-147 (83.0 percent).

### Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert is currently on a 25-game unbeaten streak, going 21-0-4 since a 4-2 loss to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3.

In addition to the current streak, St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a school record 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 12 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history. Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19-game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-2 over that 31-game stretch.

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 32-2-4 overall and are 21-0-4 against NCHA opponents.

**Jones Jabber:**

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones extended his Division III record for career shutouts to 23 with a 1-0 shutout win over St. Scholastica on March 1. It marked the third time in his career Jones has pitched three consecutive shutouts.

Jones' 23 career shutouts are the second-most all-time by any collegiate goalie. Only current Buffalo Sabre Ryan Miller has more with 26 shutouts at Michigan State from 1999-2002.

The St. Scholastica shutout on March 1 was a milestone for Jones, giving him the outright NCAA Division III record for shutouts in a season with eight.

Jones currently has a consecutive shutout sequence of 217 minutes 42 seconds. It is the second-longest stretch of his career, trailing his NCAA Division III record of 337:22 set from Jan. 13-28, 2006. Jones now has four stretches in his career of at least 150 consecutive minutes of shutout hockey.

In his last 10 games, Jones is 8-0-2 with a 0.59 goals against average and .972 save percentage with six shutouts.

Jones' career record currently stands at 83-10-8, the most wins ever by a Division III goaltender. He has a 1.64 career goals against average and .924 save percentage. Jones' career goals against average currently is the second-best in Division III history, behind Middlebury's Christian Carlsson, who had a 1.40 GAA from 1999-2002.

The next closest active Division III goaltender in wins behind Jones' 83

is Oswego State's Ryan Scott, who is 61-21-6.

In addition to his 23 shutouts, Jones has 24 career games where he has allowed just one goal. In 102 career starts, Jones is 46-0-1 when allowing one goal or less. Jones has allowed one goal or less in 46.1 percent of his career starts.

Jones also owns or shares NCAA Division III records with shutouts in a season (eight), consecutive shutouts (four) and consecutive shutout minutes (337:22).

Jones, the 2006 and 2008 NCHA Player of the Year, is 17-1-3 this season with a 1.13 GAA and .947 save percentage. He currently leads Division III in goals against average and save percentage. If both marks hold up they would be NCAA Division III season records.

Jones' 1.13 goals against average is on pace to set a new NCAA Division III season record, topping the mark of 1.21 set by Middlebury's Francois Bourbeau in 1998. In fact the top nine GAA's in Division III history are by East Region players, with the best GAA ever posted by a West Regional net-minder was 1.55 by St. Olaf's Dan Kehler in 2005.

Jones is one of only two players in NCHA history to be named NCHA Player of the Year twice. Bemidji State's Mike Alexander was named NCHA Player of the Year in 1985 and 1986.

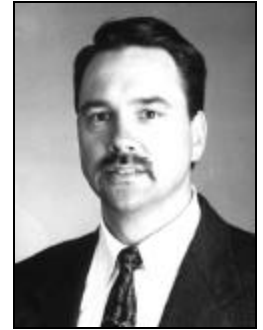
Amazingly, Jones has never been selected as a first-team All-American by the American Hockey Coaches Association.

## Peters Cup Patter:

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just one NCHA Peters Cup Playoff series on the road. The Green Knights, after a third-place finish in the NCHA in 2000-01, played at UW-River Falls in the semifinal round and were eliminated 1-0 in an overtime mini-game. St. Norbert finished second in 1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game by UW-Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

St. Norbert has played 32 of the last 33 NCHA Peters Cup Playoff rounds it has played in on home ice. The Green Knights are 43-11-1 all-time in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs, and are 42-7 at home all-time in the Peters Cup tournament. St. Norbert has played only away series against UW-River Falls (twice) and UW-Stevens Point on the all-time in Peters Cup play.

## Kill Comments:

St. Norbert is enjoying a strong season on the penalty kill. The Green Knights are 140-for-154 on the penalty kill this season, a solid 90.9 percent. That number currently leads Division III.

Should the Green Knights keep that pace on the penalty kill, it would rank in the top ten all time in Division III history.

St. Norbert had its best season ever on the penalty kill a year ago, turning away 170 of 190 chances for 89.5 percent. The Green Knights led Division III in penalty kill in 2003 at

89.4 percent.

In NCHA play this season, St. Norbert's penalty kill was 68-for-74, a percentage of 91.9 percent.

Seven of the 14 power-play goals St. Norbert has allowed this season came against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference teams. Gustavus Adolphus, St. John's and St. Mary's all scored two power-play goals each, and St. Olaf tallied one. Against foes this season not from the MIAC, St. Norbert's penalty kill is 109-for-116 (93.9 percent).

UW-Stout scored twice on the power play on Feb. 9, the first NCHA team to score twice with the man advantage against the Green Knights this season.

## Pitchers' Duel:

St. Norbert's 1-0 win over St. Scholastica this past Saturday was just the second time the Green Knights have ever been on the winning end of a 1-0 score.

The Green Knights also beat UW-Superior 1-0 on Jan. 21, 2006 with Kyle Jones also getting that win.

St. Norbert is now 2-3 all-time in 1-0 games. Lake Forest beat St. Norbert 1-0 at Alumni Fieldhouse in Lake Forest, Ill., on Nov. 5, 1999, which is also the last time St. Norbert has been shutout in an NCHA game.

The other two 1-0 games in school history were a pair of classic games against Middlebury College. The Panthers beat on Dec. 2, 2000 at the Cornerstone Community Center and on Mar. 20, 2004 at Kreitzberg Arena in Northfield, Vt., for the NCAA Division III championship.

Ironically, St. Norbert goaltender Chancy Colquhoun and Middlebury goaltender Marc Scheuer squared off against each other in both of those games as freshmen and then as seniors in their last collegiate games. Scheuer made 24 saves in the game at Green Bay and 29 saves in the national championship game. Colquhoun made 23 saves in the game at the Cornerstone and had 32 stops during the national title contest.

St. Norbert has been shutout only four times since the start of the 1997-98 season, three in the aforementioned 1-0 losses. The Green Knights most recent shutout that wasn't by a 1-0 score came in a 3-0 loss to Middlebury in the 2006 national championship game.

St. Norbert also had a scoreless tie with UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 27, 1995, the only one in school history.

### **Belanger Bits:**

Senior forward Marc Belanger had his consecutive games scoring streak snapped at 16 when he went scoreless in a 1-1 tie with UW-Superior on Feb. 1. Belanger had scored 13 goals and 13 assists for 26 points during his streak.

Belanger was one game shy of tying Maris Ziedins' team record of 17 for consecutive games scored in, set from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Belanger has scored in 25 of 28 games this season, also not getting on the scoresheet in a 3-1 win at Concordia-Moorhead on Nov. 10 and in a 1-0 win over St. Scholastica on March 1.

Belanger carried a nine-game scoring streak into this season, giving him a point in 34 of his last 37 games. In his last 37 games, Belanger has scored 27 goals with 21 assists for 48 points.

With 128 career points, Belanger is in seventh in career scoring at St. Norbert. He trails Connor Hughes by nine points for sixth at 137 points.

Belanger's 60 career goals tie him with Hughes for sixth all-time at St. Norbert. Belanger trails Scott Jewitt (61) by one for fifth, Bruce Henderson (62) by two for fourth and Jason Deitsch by four (64) for third.

### Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 92-4-4 in its last 100 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last seven seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 105-7-6 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 114-11-7 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 193-33-13 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

### Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 194-1-3 in school history at home when leading after two

periods. The Green Knights' lone loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

The most recent tie came Nov. 30 when St. Scholastica claimed a 2-2 draw after trailing 2-1 entering the final period.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 176-0-2 at home when up after two periods. The overall home unbeaten streak when up after two stanzas is 193 games (190-0-3).

### Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 121 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert earned the No. 1 ranking for the first time this season when it earned the top spot in the Dec. 10, 2007 poll, and remained there for four consecutive polls until dropping to No. 2 on Jan. 28. St. Norbert moved back into

the top spot on Feb. 4 and is now in its fifth-straight week at No. 1. The Green Knights are 44-10-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 121-week stretch, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 36 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2007 final polls.

St. Norbert is 5-0-1 against ranked foes this season. St. Norbert is 67-26-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin.

### Ice Chips:

\* - St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 206 games when scoring five goals or more with a 201-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights have scored five goals in a game just 10 times this season.

\* - St. Norbert has allowed five goals in a game just once in its last 81 games - a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007. The Green Knights have gone 34 consecutive games without allowing five goals.
