### St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview NCAA DIVISION III FROZEN FOUR

**Sat., March 22 - No. 1 St. Norbert (25-1-4) vs. No. 5 Norwich (23-6) - 2:30 p.m. EDT**  
**Sun., March 23 - vs. No. 2 Plattsburgh State (24-4) or No. 4 Elmira (20-3-5) - 4 p.m. EDT**  
**Herb Brooks Arena (7,700) - Lake Placid, New York**

#### Frozen Four Overview:

New York's North Country hosts the Frozen Four as four teams converge on Lake Placid to determine the 2008 NCAA Division III champion. St. Norbert is aiming for a national title in its fifth Frozen Four appearance, and is the youngest team among the four teams in the tournament. Two wins this weekend would produce the first team national championship in school history.

### The Series:

Norwich leads St. Norbert 2-0 in the all-time series. The Cadets picked up a 5-2 win at the Cornerstone Community Center on Dec. 1, 2000. Norwich also won a NCAA national semifinal game by a 6-3 score on March 21, 2003 at Kreitzberg Arena.

St. Norbert leads Plattsburgh State in the all-time series 1-0. The Green Knights won the only meeting 4-1 in a NCAA national semifinal on March 19, 2004 at Kreitzberg Arena in Northfield, Vt.

St. Norbert leads Elmira 2-1 in the all-time series. Elmira beat St. Norbert 5-4 in overtime on Nov. 24, 2001 in Pine Valley, N.Y. The Green Knights then swept a two-game series on Oct. 25-26, 2002 by scores of 6-2 and 8-2 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 320-92-35 in his 15th season in De Pere. Coghlin owns a 55-20-4 all-time post-season record. Since the 1996-97 season, Coghlin owns a glossy 289-56-27 record in those 12 seasons with 10 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances, 10 NCHA regular-season championships, seven NCHA Peters Cup titles and five NCAA Division III Frozen Fours. The Green Knights are 176-23-18 in the last seven seasons. He was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's 1989 national champion.

Norwich coach Mike McShane (New Hampshire, 1971) is 281-80-13 in his 13th season in Northfield. In 27 years of collegiate coaching he is 525-298-44 overall. He spent six years at St. Lawrence with two NCAA Division I tournament berths and was at Providence for nine years with three NCAA tournament bids.

Plattsburgh State coach Bob Emery (Boston College, 1986) is 421-137-42 in his 19th season along the shore of Lake Champlain. Emery led the Cardinals to NCAA Division III championships in 1992 and 2001.

Elmira coach Tim Ceglarski (Boston College, 1987) is 109-63-18 in his seventh season in Elmira.

### NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its tenth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in the last 12 years. The Green Knights are 10-9-1 all-time in NCAA competition. The Green Knights broke through to their first Frozen Four in 2003 with a quarter-final win over UW-River Falls before losing to Norwich in the semifinals. In 2004, St. Norbert beat River Falls in the quarterfinals and Plattsburgh State in the semifinals before losing in overtime to Middlebury 1-0 in the national championship game. In 2006, St. Norbert beat UW-Superior in the quarterfinals and Hobart in the semifinals before losing to Middlebury 3-0 in the national title game. St. Norbert lost 4-3 in overtime to Oswego State in a 2007 national semifinal.

Norwich is making its tenth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its seventh trip to the Frozen Four. Norwich is 16-8-2 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. The Cadets won national championships in 2000 and 2003.

Plattsburgh State is making its 16th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its 10th trip to the Frozen Four. The Cardinals won national championships in 1992 and 2001 and are 20-15-8 all-time in the tournament.

Elmira is making its 11th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its fifth trip to the Frozen Four. The Eagles are 11-15-2 all-time in the tournament.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert extended its unbeaten streak to a school-record 27 games with a NCAA Division III Quarterfinal win over St. Thomas by a 2-1 overtime score this past Saturday. The Green Knights are 25-1-4 overall and have been ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III poll for 10 of the last 11 weeks. St. Norbert has won at least a share of seven straight NCHA champi-

onships and 10 in the last 12 years. The Green Knights have also won seven Peters Cup titles in the last 11 years.

Senior forward Marc Belanger leads St. Norbert with 22 goals and 20 assists for 42 points. Sophomore forward Matt Boyd has 16 goals and 21 assists for 37 points. Sophomore forward Tyler Allen has 10 goals and 16 assists for 26 points, while sophomore forward Shane Wheeler has seven goals and 19 assists for 26 points.

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones has an 19-1-3 record this season with a 1.18 goals against average and .945 save percentage. Freshman Blake Bashor is 6-0-1 with a 1.96 goals against average and .899 save percentage.

St. Norbert's power play is 39-for-170 this season (22.9 percent), while its penalty kill is 147-for-162 (90.7 percent). St. Norbert is scoring 3.77 goals per game and is allowing just 1.43 goals per game. The Green Knights own the nation's top scoring defense and penalty kill.

**About the Cadets:**

Norwich enters the Frozen Four with a 23-6 overall record. The Cadets won the ECAC East championship with a 15-4 record. Norwich has won five straight games since losing back-to-back games to Castleton State and Colby in mid-February. Norwich beat Manhattanville 7-2 in last Saturday's national quarterfinal.

Senior forward Rick Cleaver leads the Cadets in scoring with 31 goals and is second in Division III in goals

scored. Junior forward Nikita Kashirsky has 20 goals and 22 assists for 42 points, while sophomore forward D.J. Fimiani has six assists and 28 assists for 34 points. Senior forward Eric Lauriault is third on the team in goals with 15 markers along with 18 assists for 33 points.

Sophomore goaltender David Thompson has seen most of the action for the Cadets, posting a 15-2 record with a .902 save percentage and 2.12 goals against average. Sophomore Ryan Klingensmith is 7-2 with a 2.00 GAA and .910 save percentage.

Norwich is 38-for-144 (26.4 percent) on the power play, while its penalty kill is 122-for-140 (87.1 percent). The Cadets are scoring 4.86 goals per game and are allowing 2.28 goals per game.

**About the Cardinals:**

Plattsburgh State enters the Frozen Four with a 24-4 overall record. The Cardinals won the SUNYAC championship with a 14-2 league record. Plattsburgh, which beat Hobart 5-2 in a national quarterfinal on Saturday, has won three straight games since a 4-2 loss to Potsdam State on Feb. 15.

Freshman forward Dylan Clarke has 19 goals and 15 assists for 34 points, and has scored seven game-winning goals this season. Junior forward Riley Hill has 14 goals and 18 assists for 32 points. Sophomore forward Joey Wilson has 11 goals and 20 assists for 31 points.

Freshman goaltender Bryan Hince has fashioned a 21-4 record

with a 2.02 goals against average and .916 save percentage.

Plattsburgh is 55-for-190 (28.9 percent) on the power play and is 107-for-124 (86.3 percent) on the penalty kill. The Cardinals are scoring 4.79 goals per game while allowing 2.04 goals per game.

### About the Soaring Eagles:

Elmira enters the Frozen Four with a 20-3-5 record. The Soaring Eagles on the ECAC West championship with a 10-2-3 record. Elmira, which beat Trinity 6-1 in a national quarterfinal last Saturday, lost the ECAC West playoff championship to Manhattanville 1-0 on March 8.

Senior forward Michael Richard leads Elmira in scoring with 10 goals and 13 assists for 43 points. Sophomore forward Rusty Masters, a juniors teammate of St. Norbert forward Tyler Allen, has 21 goals and 12 assists for 33 points with seven game-winning goals. Senior defenseman Russell Smith has six goals and 25 assists for 31 points.

Sophomore goaltender Casey Tuttle is 19-3-5 this season with a .928 save percentage and 1.79 goals against average.

Elmira is 42-for-172 (24.4 percent) on the power play and 103-for-119 (86.6 percent) on the penalty kill. The Soaring Eagles are scoring 3.89 goals per game and are allowing 1.79 goals per game.

### Youth Is Served:

St. Norbert has forged its fifth Frozen Four appearance despite having one of its most youthful rosters in program history.

Of the 25 Green Knights who

have played at least five games this year, St. Norbert has an average of 1.80 years of experience (with 4 years given to each senior and 1 to each freshman) per player. St. Norbert has two seniors, three juniors and 20 total freshmen and sophomores.

Norwich is the most experienced team in the Frozen Four, with an average tenure of 2.44 years per player.

Elmira has an average of 2.23 years per player, while Plattsburgh has an average of 2.07 years per player.

### Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert is currently on a 27-game unbeaten streak, going 23-0-4 since a 4-2 loss to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3. The 27-game unbeaten streak is a school record.

In addition to the current streak, St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 12 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history. Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19-game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 34-2-4 overall and are 22-0-4 against NCHA opponents.

### **Jones Jabber:**

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones extended his Division III record for career shutouts to 23 with a 1-0 shutout win over St. Scholastica on March 1. It marked the third time in his career Jones has pitched three consecutive shutouts.

Jones' 23 career shutouts are the second-most all-time by any collegiate goalie. Only current Buffalo Sabre Ryan Miller has more with 26 shutouts at Michigan State from 1999-2002.

The St. Scholastica shutout on March 1 was a milestone for Jones, giving him the outright NCAA Division III record for shutouts in a season with eight.

Jones had a consecutive shutout sequence of 234 minutes 49 seconds snapped March 8 against UW-Stout. It is the second-longest stretch of his career, trailing his NCAA Division III record of 337:22 set from Jan. 13-28, 2006. Jones now has four stretches in his career of at least 150 consecutive minutes of shutout hockey.

In the 2008 postseason, Jones is 5-0 with a .962 save percentage and 0.74 goals against average.

Jones' career record currently stands at 85-10-8, the most wins ever by a Division III goaltender. He has a 1.64 career goals against average and .924 save percentage. Jones' career goals against average currently is the second-best in Division III history, behind Middlebury's Christian Carlsson, who had a 1.40 GAA from 1999-2002.

The next closest active Division III goaltender in wins this season behind Jones' 85 is Oswego State's Ryan Scott, who finished his career with the Lakers 61-21-6.

In addition to his 23 shutouts, Jones has 25 career games where he has allowed just one goal. In 104 career starts, Jones is 47-0-1 when allowing one goal or less. Jones has allowed one goal or less in 46.2 per-

cent of his career starts.

Jones also owns or shares NCAA Division III records with shutouts in a season (eight), consecutive shutouts (four) and consecutive shutout minutes (337:22).

Jones, the 2006 and 2008 NCHA Player of the Year, is 19-1-3 this season with a 1.18 GAA and .945 save percentage. He currently leads Division III in goals against average and save percentage.

Jones' 1.18 goals against average is on pace to set a new NCAA Division III season record, topping the mark of 1.21 set by Middlebury's Francois Bourbeau in 1998. In fact, the top nine GAA's in Division III history are by East Region players, with the best GAA ever posted by a West Regional netminder was 1.55 by St. Olaf's Dan Kehler in 2005.

Jones is one of only two players in NCHA history to be named NCHA Player of the Year twice. Bemidji State's Mike Alexander was named NCHA Player of the Year in 1985 and 1986.

Amazingly, in his first three season

Jones has never been selected as a first-team All-American by the American Hockey Coaches Association.

**Captain Clutch:**

St. Norbert junior forward and captain Ryan Petersen has enjoyed a strong goal-scoring touch during his career while playing in the NCAA Tournament.

In six career NCAA Tournament games, Petersen has scored six goals with no assists. He has scored goals in five of the games.

Petersen's goal at 8:28 of overtime this past Saturday gave the Green Knights a 2-1 win over St. Thomas in a NCAA quarterfinal.

During his freshman year, Petersen scored two goals in St. Norbert's 8-2 rout of UW-Superior in a NCAA quarterfinal. Petersen then added a marker in a 5-4 overtime win over Hobart in a national semifinal in Elmira, N.Y. Petersen, nor any other Green Knights, scored in a 3-0 loss to Middlebury in the 2006 national championship game.

Last season, Petersen scored the

game's first goal in a 4-1 win over Bethel in a national quarterfinal, and netted another marker in a 4-3 overtime loss to Oswego State in the semi-finals.

**Postseason Patter:**

St. Norbert is 5-0 during the 2008 postseason. The Green Knights went 4-0 during the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs and won their lone NCAA Tournament game this season.

St. Norbert is outscoring its opponents 16-4 this postseason, with three of the goals against coming in a 4-3 overtime win over UW-Stout on March 8 in the NCHA Peters Cup championship game.

Junior forward Steven Sleep leads St. Norbert in playoff scoring this season with seven points, all assists. Sophomore forward Tyler Allen has three goals and three assists for six points, while senior forward Marc Belanger has three goals and two assists for five points.

Kyle Jones has played every minute in net for St. Norbert. Jones has a 5-0

record with a 0.74 goals against average and .962 save percentage this postseason.

St. Norbert is 5-for-24 (20.8 percent) on the power play and is 18-for-19 on the penalty kill (94.7 percent) this postseason.

**Working Overtime:**

St. Norbert tied a NCAA Division III record when it picked up its fourth overtime win of the season when it beat St. Thomas 2-1 in overtime this past Saturday in a NCAA Division III quarterfinal game.

St. Norbert claimed overtime wins on consecutive nights for the first time in program history when it beat St. Mary's 3-2 and St. Thomas 4-3, both on Matt Boyd game-winners, on Jan. 11-12. The Green Knights also beat UW-Stout 4-3 in overtime on March 8 for the NCHA Peters Cup title.

In its 20-year history, St. Norbert is 14-10-35 in overtime games. The Green Knights are 12-9-34 in overtime games under Tim Coghlin (Coghlin officially has 35 ties, but one stalemate ended after 60 minutes when the NCHA Playoffs did not use overtime periods).

St. Norbert has won two overtime games in the same season just one other time - in 1995-96. The Green Knights beat St. Scholastica 4-3 on Jan. 5, 1996 and survived a wild 8-7 triumph over Lake Forest on Feb. 4, 1996.

Three other teams have won four overtime games in a season at the NCAA Division III level, most recently Plattsburgh State in 2005.

Colby in 1998 and UW-Stevens Point in 1989, captained by Coghlin, also won four overtime games in one year.

St. Norbert's eight overtime games this season are also a school record. Seven of the overtime games have been at the Cornerstone Community Center, with St. Norbert going 4-0-4 in overtime games and 4-0-3 at home.

**One-Goal Observations:**

St. Norbert has been able to fashion its 27-game unbeaten streak this season thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

The Green Knights are an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games this season. St. Norbert is 5-0 at home in one-goal games and has gone 3-0 away from home in such contests.

St. Norbert picked up its second 1-0 win in school history on March 1 when it beat St. Scholastica in a NCHA Peters Cup Semifinal game at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the prior four seasons combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 45-41 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' last three games have all been victorious one-goal decisions, the first time in school history that has occurred.

**St. Norbert vs. Ranked Teams in 2007-2008**

### Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 19-14-4 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights have played at least one weekend a season against eastern foes for the past 14 years.

St. Norbert is 11-7-3 all-time on East Region ice. The Green Knights are 7-5-2 all-time in the State of New York. The Green Knights won the Pathfinder Bank Oswego Hockey Classic earlier this season, beating Curry 5-2 and Amherst 3-1.

The Green Knights are 7-2-1 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 1-1-1 mark last season.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 1-2 against the ECAC East, going 0-2 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

### Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey Association has placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 15 out of a possible 24 times. St. Norbert has made two title game appearances, in 2004 and 2006. Bemidji State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991) and UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 - Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 - Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 - River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986) and UW-Superior (2002) have all won Division III national titles while members of the NCHA.

In 25 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team among the final four 23 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost

to Union in the 1984 quarterfinals and St. Norbert lost to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

### Kill Comments:

St. Norbert is enjoying a strong season on the penalty kill. The Green Knights are 147-for-162 on the penalty kill this season, a solid 90.7 percent. That number currently leads Division III.

Should the Green Knights keep that pace on the penalty kill, it would rank in the top five all-time in Division III history.

St. Norbert had its best season ever on the penalty kill a year ago, turning away 170 of 190 chances for 89.5 percent. The Green Knights led Division III in penalty kill in 2003 at 89.4 percent.

In NCHA play this season, St. Norbert's penalty kill was 68-for-74, a percentage of 91.9 percent.

Seven of the 15 power-play goals St. Norbert has allowed this season came against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference teams. Gustavus Adolphus, St. John's and St. Mary's all

scored two power-play goals each, and St. Olaf tallied one. Against foes this season not from the MIAC, St. Norbert's penalty kill is 109-for-116 (93.9 percent).

UW-Stout scored twice on the power play on Feb. 9, the first NCHA team to score twice with the man advantage against the Green Knights this season. The Blue Devils added one power-play marker in seven chances in the Peters Cup title game March 8.

#### **Belanger Bits:**

Senior forward Marc Belanger scored the overtime game-winner against UW-Stout on March 8 for the NCHA Peters Cup championship. It was Belanger's team-high fifth game-winning goal of the season.

Belanger had a consecutive games scoring streak snapped at 16 when he went scoreless in a 1-1 tie with UW-Superior on Feb. 1. Belanger had scored 13 goals and 13 assists for 26 points during his streak. Belanger was one game shy of tying Maris Ziedins' team record of 17 for consecutive games scored in, set from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Belanger has scored in 26 of 30 games this season. He also did not get on the scoresheet in a 3-1 win at Concordia-Moorhead on Nov. 10, in a 1-0 win over St. Scholastica on March 1 and in a 2-1 win over St. Thomas on March 15.

Belanger carried a nine-game scoring streak into this season, giving him a point in 35 of his last 39 games. In his last 39 games, Belanger has scored 28 goals with 21 assists for 49 points.

With 129 career points, Belanger is in seventh in career scoring at St. Norbert. He trails Connor Hughes by eight points for sixth at 137 points.

Belanger's 61 career goals tie him with Scott Jewitt for fifth all-time at St. Norbert. Belanger trails Bruce Henderson (62) by one for fourth and Jason Deitsch by three (64) for third.

#### **Home Sweet Cornerstone:**

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the

Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 94-4-4 in its last 102 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last seven seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 107-7-6 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 116-11-7 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 195-33-13 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

This season marks the eighth time in school history St. Norbert has won at least 14 home games in a single season.

#### **Tough After Two:**

St. Norbert is 195-1-3 in school history at home when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

The most recent tie came Nov. 30 when St. Scholastica claimed a 2-2 draw after trailing 2-1 entering the final period.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 177-0-2 at home when up after two periods. The overall home unbeaten streak when up after two stanzas is 194 games (191-0-3).

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 122 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert earned the No. 1 ranking for the first time this season when it earned the top spot in the Dec. 10, 2007 poll, and remained there for four consecutive polls until dropping to No. 2 on Jan. 28. St. Norbert moved back into the top spot on Feb. 4 and is now in its sixth-straight week at No. 1. The Green Knights are 46-10-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 122-week stretch, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 37 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003,

2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert is 7-0-1 against ranked foes this season. St. Norbert is 69-26-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin.

#### **Ice Chips:**

\* - St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 206 games when scoring five goals or more with a 201-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights have scored five goals in a game just 10 times this season.

\* - St. Norbert has allowed five goals in a game just once in its last 83 games - a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007. The Green Knights have gone 36 consecutive games without allowing five goals.

\* - St. Norbert is 20-0-2 when it scores first this season, and is 5-1-2 when it does not.

\* - St. Norbert is 16-0-2 this season when leading after one period, and is 24-0-3 when leading or tied after two periods. The Green Knights are 1-1-1 when trailing after two this year.

\* - This is only the third NCAA Division III Frozen Four ever where the host institution will not be one of the participants, and only the second in an arena that does not regularly play host to a Division III squad. The only other true neutral Frozen Four was held in 1993 in Maplewood, Minn., when UW-Stevens Point beat UW-River Falls for the national championship. The 2007 Frozen Four at Wessman Arena in Superior, Wis., also did not have the host team playing.

\* - St. Norbert has been eliminated by the eventual NCAA Division III champion in six of its last seven NCAA post-season appearances. The Green Knights lost in a mini-game in 1999 to Middlebury, which won its fifth consecutive national title as the East's No. 5 seed. St. Norbert then lost a series (tie and loss) to UW-Superior in 2002, then dropped its national semifinal contest to Norwich in 2003. Middlebury beat St. Norbert in the 2004 and 2006 national championship games. St. Thomas, the 2005 national runner-up, upset St. Norbert 3-2 in a national quarterfinal. The Green Knights lost 4-3 in overtime in a national semifinal in 2007 to champion Oswego State.
