St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey 2007-08 Season Notes

No. 1 St. Norbert College (27-1-4)

NCAA Division III Champion

NCHA Peters Cup & Regular-Season Champion

Season Overview:

St. Norbert won its first NCAA Division III championship with a 2-0 win over Plattsburgh State on March 23 in Lake Placid, N.Y. The Green Knights, who defeated Norwich 3-0 a day earlier, became the first team in Division III history to win both Frozen Four games via shutout. The Green Knights finished the season with a 27-1-4 overall record and ended the year with a 29-game unbeaten streak.

The Coach:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 322-92-35 in his 15th season in De Pere. Coghlin owns a 57-20-4 all-time post-season record. Since the 1996-97 season, Coghlin owns a glossy 291-56-27 record in those 12 seasons with 10 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances, 10 NCHA regular-season championships, seven NCHA Peters Cup titles and five NCAA Division III Frozen Fours. The Green Knights are 178-23-18 in the last seven seasons. He was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's 1989 national champion.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert made its tenth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in the last 12 years. The Green Knights are 12-9-1 all-time in NCAA competition. St. Norbert won its first national championship in 2008, beating St. Thomas, Norwich and Plattsburgh State by a combined 7-1 in the NCAA Tournament.

The Green Knights broke through to their first Frozen Four in 2003 with a quarterfinal win over UW-River Falls before losing to Norwich in the semifinals. In 2004, St. Norbert beat River Falls in the quarterfinals and Plattsburgh State in the semifinals before losing in overtime to Middlebury 1-0 in the national championship game. In 2006, St. Norbert beat UW-Superior in the quarterfinals and Hobart in the semifinals before losing to Middlebury 3-0 in the national title game. St. Norbert lost 4-3 in overtime to Oswego State in a 2007 national semifinal.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert extended its unbeaten streak to a school-record 29 games with its NCAA Division III championship. The Green Knights were 27-1-4 overall and were ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III poll for 10 of the last 11 weeks of voting. St. Norbert has won at least a share of seven straight NCHA championships and 10 in the last 12 years. The Green Knights have also won seven Peters Cup titles in the last 11 years.

Senior forward Marc Belanger led St. Norbert with 23 goals and 22 assists for 45 points. Sophomore forward Matt Boyd had 17 goals and 22 assists for 39 points. Sophomore forward Tyler Allen had 11 goals and 17 assists for 28 points, while sophomore forward Shane Wheeler had seven goals and 20 assists for 27 points.

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones finished with a 21-1-3 record this season with a 1.06 goals against average and .950 save percentage. Freshman Blake Bashor was 6-0-1 with a 1.96 goals against average

and .899 save percentage.

St. Norbert's power play was 41-for-178 this season (23.0 percent), while its penalty kill is 158-for-173 (90.3 percent). St. Norbert scored 3.69 goals per game and allowed just 1.34 goals per game, a Division III record. The Green Knights owned the nation's top scoring defense and penalty kill.

Youth Is Served:

St. Norbert won its first national championship despite having one of its most youthful rosters in program history.

Of the 25 Green Knights who have played at least five games this year, St. Norbert had an average of 1.80 years of experience (with 4 years given to each senior and 1 to each freshman) per player. St. Norbert has two seniors, three juniors and 20 total freshmen and sophomores.

Norwich was the most experienced team in the Frozen Four, with an average tenure of 2.44 years per player.

Elmira had an average of 2.23 years per player, while Plattsburgh had an average of 2.07 years per player.

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert finished the year riding the crest of a 29-game unbeaten streak, going 25-0-4 since a 4-2 loss to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3. The 29-game unbeaten streak is a school record.

The Green Knights' 29-game unbeaten streak is tied for the second-longest in Division III history. Middlebury went 29 straight games without a loss from Dec. 31, 1994 to Jan. 7, 1996. Massachusetts-Dartmouth holds the Division III record at 38 games from Jan. 16, 1985 to March 2, 1986.

In addition to the current streak, St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 12 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history.

Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19-game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-2 over that 31-game stretch.

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 36-2-4 overall and are 22-0-4 against NCHA opponents.

Jones Jabber:

Senior goaltender Kyle Jones wrapped up his career in style with a pair of virtuoso performances at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

Jones, the 2008 NCAA Division III Player of the Year, shutout Norwich on 26 saves in a national semifinal game on March 22, and followed that up with a 32-save shutout against Plattsburgh State in the national championship game on March 23.

Jones' 25 career shutouts are the second-most all-time by any collegiate goalie. Only current Buffalo Sabre Ryan Miller has more with 26 shutouts at Michigan State from 1999-2002.

Jones, whose 25 shutouts are 11 more than the next closest goaltender in Division III history, posted 10 shutouts during the 2007-08

season. Only Greg Gardner of Niagara ever had more in one season, posting 12 in 1999-2000. Miller in 2000-01 and Cornell's David McKee in 2004-05 with 10 are the only other goaltenders to have at least 10 shutouts in a season in collegiate hockey history.

Jones had a consecutive shutout sequence of 234 minutes 49 seconds snapped March 8 against UW-Stout. It is the second-longest stretch of his career, trailing his NCAA Division III record of 337:22 set from Jan. 13-28, 2006. Jones, who ended the season with a consecutive shutout streak of 168:06, finished his career with five stretches of at least 150 consecutive minutes of shutout hockey.

Jones' career record currently stands at 87-10-8, the most wins ever by a Division III goaltender. He has a 1.61 career goals against average and .926 save percentage. Jones' career goals against average is the second-best in Division III history, behind Middlebury's Christian Carlsson, who had a 1.40 GAA from 1999-2002. His career save percentage is second to St. John's Adam Hanna, who had a .928 save percentage from 2004-06.

The next closest active Division III goaltender in wins this season behind Jones' 87 was Oswego State's Ryan Scott, who finished his career with the Lakers 61-21-6.

In addition to his 25 shutouts, Jones had 25 career games where he allowed just one goal. In 106 career starts, Jones was 49-0-1 when allowing one goal or less. Jones has allowed one goal or less in 47.2 per-

cent of his career starts.

Jones also owns or shares NCAA Division III records with shutouts in a season (10), consecutive shutouts (four) and consecutive shutout minutes (337:22).

Jones, the 2006 and 2008 NCHA Player of the Year, finished 21-1-3 this season with a 1.09 GAA and .950 save percentage. He led Division III in goals against average and save percentage.

Jones' 1.09 goals against average set a new NCAA Division III season record, topping the mark of 1.21 set by Middlebury's Francois Bourbeau in 1998. His .950 save percentage broke the old Division III record of .946, set by Plattsburgh State's Niklas Sundberg in 1999.

Jones is one of only two players in NCHA history to be named NCHA Player of the Year twice. Bemidji State's Mike Alexander was named NCHA Player of the Year in 1985 and 1986.

Postseason Patter:

St. Norbert was 7-0 during the 2008 postseason, the first time it has ever won seven post-season games in one year. The Green Knights went 4-0 during the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs and won their three NCAA Tournament game this season.

St. Norbert outscored its opponents 21-4 this postseason, with three of the goals against coming in a 4-3 overtime win over UW-Stout on March 8 in the NCHA Peters Cup championship game.

Junior forward Steven Sleep led St. Norbert in playoff scoring this season with nine points, with one

goals and eight assists. Sophomore forward Tyler Allen and senior forward Marc Belanger each had four goals and four assists for eight points.

Kyle Jones played every minute in net for St. Norbert. Jones had a 7-0 record with a 0.54 goals against average and .975 save percentage this postseason.

St. Norbert was 7-for-32 (21.9 percent) on the power play and was 29-for-30 on the penalty kill (96.7 percent) this postseason.

Working Overtime:

St. Norbert tied a NCAA Division III record when it picked up its fourth overtime win of the season when it beat St. Thomas 2-1 in overtime March 15 in a NCAA Division III quarterfinal game.

St. Norbert claimed overtime wins on consecutive nights for the first time in program history when it beat St. Mary's 3-2 and St. Thomas 4-3, both on Matt Boyd game-winners, on Jan. 11-12. The Green Knights also beat UW-Stout 4-3 in overtime on March 8 for the NCHA Peters Cup title.

In its 20-year history, St. Norbert is 14-10-35 in overtime games. The Green Knights are 12-9-34 in overtime games under Tim Coghlin (Coghlin officially has 35 ties, but one stalemate ended after 60 minutes when the NCHA Playoffs did not use overtime periods).

St. Norbert won two overtime games in the same season just one other time - in 1995-96. The Green Knights beat St. Scholastica 4-3 on Jan. 5, 1996 and survived a wild 8-7 triumph over Lake Forest on Feb. 4,

Three other teams have won four overtime games in a season at the NCAA Division III level, most recently Plattsburgh State in 2005. Colby in 1998 and UW-Stevens Point in 1989, captained by Coghlin, also won four overtime games in one year.

St. Norbert's eight overtime games this season were also a school record. Seven of the overtime games were at the Cornerstone Community Center, with St. Norbert going 4-0-4 in overtime games and 4-0-3 at home.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert has been able to fashion its 29-game unbeaten streak this season thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

The Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games this season. St. Norbert is 5-0 at home in one-goal games and has gone 3-0 away from home in such contests.

St. Norbert picked up its second 1-0 win in school history on March 1 when it beat St. Scholastica in a NCHA Peters Cup Semifinal game at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the prior four seasons combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 45-41 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, the first time in school history that has occurred.

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 21-14-4 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights have played at least one weekend a season against eastern foes for the past 14 years.

St. Norbert is 13-7-3 all-time on East Region ice. The Green Knights are 9-5-2 all-time in the State of New York. The Green Knights won the

Pathfinder Bank Oswego Hockey Classic earlier this season, beating Curry 5-2 and Amherst 3-1. St. Norbert then beat Norwich and Plattsburgh State in Lake Placid at the 2008 Frozen Four.

The Green Knights are 8-2-1 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 2-2 against the ECAC East, going 1-2 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey Association has placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 16 out of a possible 25

times. St. Norbert has made three title game appearances, in 2004, 2006 and 2008. Bemidji State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991) and UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 - Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 - Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 - River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986), UW-Superior (2002) and St. Norbert (2008) have all won Division III national titles while members of the NCHA.

In 25 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team among the final four 23 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost to Union in the 1984 quarterfinals and St. Norbert lost to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

Kill Comments:

St. Norbert enjoyed a strong season on the penalty kill. The Green Knights were 158-for-173 on the penalty kill this season, a solid 91.3 percent. That number led Division III and is the fourth-best mark in Division III history.

St. Norbert previously had its best season ever on the penalty kill a year ago, turning away 170 of 190 chances for 89.5 percent. The Green Knights led Division III in penalty kill in 2003 at 89.4 percent before leading again in 2008.

In NCHA play this season, St. Norbert's penalty kill was 68-for-74, a percentage of 91.9 percent.

Seven of the 15 power-play goals St. Norbert has allowed this season came against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference teams. Gustavus Adolphus, St. John's and St. Mary's all scored two power-play goals each, and St. Olaf tallied one. Against foes this season not from the MIAC, St. Norbert's penalty kill is 126-for-134 (94.0 percent).

UW-Stout scored twice on the power play on Feb. 9, the only NCHA team to score twice with the man advantage against the Green Knights this season. The Blue Devils added one power-play marker in seven chances in the Peters Cup title game March 8.

Belanger Bits:

Senior forward Marc Belanger, a 2007 and 2008 first-team All-America selection, scored the overtime game-winner against UW-Stout on March 8 for the NCHA Peters Cup championship. It was Belanger's team-high fifth game-winning goal of the season.

Belanger had a consecutive games scoring streak snapped at 16 when he went scoreless in a 1-1 tie with UW-Superior on Feb. 1. Belanger had scored 13 goals and 13 assists for 26 points during his streak. Belanger was one game shy of tying Maris Ziedins' team record of 17 for consecutive games scored in, set from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Belanger scored in 28 of 32 games this season. He also did not get on the scoresheet in a 3-1 win at Concordia-Moorhead on Nov. 10, in a 1-0 win over St. Scholastica on March 1 and in a 2-1 win over St. Thomas on March 15.

Belanger carried a nine-game scoring streak into this season, giving him a point in 37 of his last 41 collegiate games. In his last 41

games, Belanger has scored 29 goals with 23 assists for 52 points.

With 132 career points, Belanger is seventh in career scoring at St. Norbert. Belanger's 62 career goals tie him with Bruce Henderson for fourth in career goals in school history.

His 10 power-play goals in 2008 were a career high and the eighth time in St. Norbert history that has happened.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterpiece *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 94-4-4 in its last 102 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last seven seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 107-7-6 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 116-11-7 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 195-33-13 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere

This season marks the eighth time in school history St. Norbert has won at least 14 home games in a single season.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert took a rare home loss against a MIAC foe when it lost 4-2 at home to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3.

St. Norbert has a solid 62-7-3 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 62-5-3 against the MIAC. The losses came in a 4-3 decision at St. John's on Nov. 24, 2000 and a pair of losses to St. Thomas in the 2004-05 season. The Green Knights also dropped a 7-4 contest to Augsburg during 2005-06 and to Gustavus Adolphus this season. St. Norbert has tied St. Thomas twice and Augsburg once, those coming in the 1999-2000 and 2000-01 seasons.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 34-2-1 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 122 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert earned the No. 1 ranking for the first time this season when it earned the top spot in the Dec. 10, 2007 poll, and remained there for four consecutive polls until dropping to No. 2 on Jan. 28. St. Norbert moved back into the top spot on Feb. 4 and is now in its sixth-straight week at No. 1. The Green Knights are 48-10-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 122-week stretch, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 37 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes this season. St. Norbert is 71-26-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 206 games when scoring five goals or more with a 201-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights have scored five goals in a game just 10 times this season.

* - St. Norbert has allowed five goals in a game just once in its last 85 games - a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007. The Green Knights have gone 38 consecutive games without allowing five goals.
