Game Overview:

St. Norbert hosts Lake Forest for the final time in a regular-season Northern Collegiate Hockey Association game at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Series:

St. Norbert has played Lake Forest 60 times, more than any other opponent, and holds a 37-20-3 advantage. The Green Knights have played the Foresters at least once every season in the 21 years St. Norbert has had a hockey program. Lake Forest won the first 14 games in the series, with St. Norbert posting a 37-6-3 ledger since. St. Norbert is 24-1 against Lake Forest at home under Tim Coghlin in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 335-96-35 in his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 191-27-18 in the last seven seasons.

Lake Forest coach Tony Fritz is 342-403-41 in his 31st season in Lake Forest.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert swept Lake Forest last Feb. 22-23 in a NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs Quarterfinal Series at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights were 4-0 against the Foresters last season.

St. Norbert topped Lake Forest 4-0 in the opening game, with Sam Tikka, Nick Tabisz, Marc Belanger and Ryan Petersen scoring goals. Kyle Jones made eight saves for the shutout.

The Green Knights jumped out to a 3-0 lead after one period the next night and went on to win 5-0. Tyler Allen scored twice for St. Norbert, which got 12 saves from Jones in the shutout. Belanger, Tabisz and Brad Herman also scored for St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Lake Forest game at 13-4 overall and 4-2 in the NCHA. The Green Knights split a pair of games in Minnesota last week, losing 3-2 to St. Thomas on Friday before beating St. Mary's 5-1 on Saturday.

Junior forward A.J. Gale enters the game with 16 goals, which shares the Division III lead with Adrian's Shawn Skelly. Gale also has 10 assists for 26 points. Eight of his goals are power-play markers. Junior forward Shane Wheeler has seven goals and 12 assists for 19 points, while sophomore defenseman Nick Tabisz has five goals and 11 assists for 16 points.

Sophomore goaltender B.J. O'Brien is 7-2 overall with a 2.31 goals against average and .912 save percentage. Sophomore Blake Bashor is 6-2 with a 2.04 goals against average and .915 save percentage.

The Green Knights are scoring

4.24 goals per game while allowing 2.18 goals per game. St. Norbert is 28-for-104 (26.9 percent) on the power play and is 90-for-101 (89.1 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest, which is 2-1-1 in its last four games, enters the game against St. Norbert with a 5-11-1 overall record and an 0-6 mark in the NCHA. The Foresters, who are 1-30-3 in their last 34 NCHA regular-season games since a 4-2 win at St. Norbert on Feb. 11, 2006, split last weekend in Minnesota. Lake Forest beat St. Mary's 5-2 on Friday before losing at St. Thomas 7-2 on Saturday.

Senior forward Mike Kneeland has nine goals and 10 assists for 19 points, all team highs. Sophomore forward Zach Kozak has seven goals and four assists for 11 points, while senior forward Chris Wilson has four goals and seven assists for 11 points. Senior forward Peter Morrison is the only other skater with at least 10 points with four goals and six assists.

Senior goaltender Scott Campbell is 1-7-1 with a 3.76 goals against average and .923 save percentage. Senior Brandon Kohuch is 4-4 with a 3.45 goals against average and .926 save percentage.

Lake Forest is averaging 2.71 goals per game while allowing 3.71 goals per game. The Foresters are last nationally (71 of 71) on the power play, going 5-for-80 (6.2 percent) and are 100-for-125 (80.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

January Joy:

The month of January continues to be a strong one for the St. Norbert College hockey team under coach Tim Coghlin.

Under Coghlin, the Green Knights boast a 95-18-11 record in January. It's the best mark in any month for the Green Knights. St. Norbert is also 89-28-8 in November and 72-20-9 in February under Coghlin. The Green Knights are 23-13-1 under Coghlin in the "money month" of March, with all games being NCHA Peters Cup or

NCAA Division III championship action.

St. Norbert has lost more than one game in January just once in the last 11 years, when it went 5-2 in January in 2006-07. The Green Knights were 6-0-1 in January last season en route to their first national championship.

Two Down, One to Go:

St. Norbert suffered a rare loss when leading after two periods in the 3-2 setback to St. Thomas on Jan. 9. The Green Knights led 2-1 after two periods before falling 3-2. It marked just the third time in the last 14 years St. Norbert had a two-period lead and lost the game.

St. Norbert had a 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods end on Jan. 19, 2007 against St. Scholastica when the Green Knights led 2-1 after two periods before losing 3-2. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995. St. Norbert also lost to Oswego State in the NCAA national semifinals in 2007 by a 4-3 overtime score after leading 3-2 after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 200-1-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead. The most recent tie came on Nov. 30, 2007 when St. Scholastica claimed a 2-2 stalemate after trailing 2-1 after the first 40 minutes.

Under coach Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 182-0-2 at home when up after two periods. The overall home unbeaten streak when up after two stanzas is 198 games (195-0-3).

Not Asleep:

Senior forward Steven Sleep has skated in 102 consecutive games, not missing a game since Nov. 25, 2005 at UW-Stevens Point. In all, Sleep has appeared in 111 of a possible 112 career games.

The NCAA Division III record for consecutive games played by a skater is 109, set by Bethel's Garrett Strot from 1984 to 1987. Barring an injury or disqualification, Sleep would pass Strot for the record on Feb. 14 at Lake Forest.

Fourteen St. Norbert skaters have played in at least 110 career games. Rob Smillie (1996-99), Shane Dickson (1998-2001) and Jason Deitsch (2002-05) all share the school record for total games played with 122.

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert had its 37-game unbeaten streak snapped with a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The long skein of games without a loss was the longest in any division of NCAA hockey since 1986 and the only streak in the top nine all-time since 1996.

St. Norbert's unbeaten streak is impressive considering the level of competition in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association, playing at least 18 games annually against league foes.

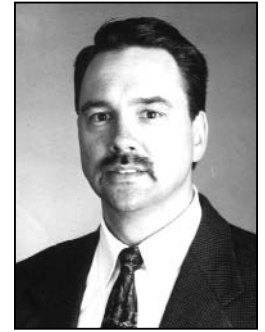

unbeaten streak is the second-longest in Division III history. Massachusetts-Dartmouth holds the Division III record at 38 games from Jan. 16, 1985 to March 2, 1986.

St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 13 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history. Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19-game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-2 over that 31-game stretch.

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 49-6-4 overall and are 26-2-4 against NCHA opponents.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 213 games when scoring five goals or more with a 208-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 12 times in their last 225 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41

games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 131 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1 before falling to No. 3 on Nov. 24. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 131-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 40 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season and is 2-3-0 against them this season. St. Norbert is 73-29-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert was able to fashion its 37-game unbeaten streak thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

St. Norbert had a 10-game winning streak in one-goal games snapped in a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The Green Knights were 8-0 in one-goal games in 2007-08 but are 3-3 in one-goal games this season.

In the prior four seasons (2003-04 to 2006-07) combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 48-44 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, 2008, the first time in school history that has occurred.
