#### Weekend Overview:

The stretch run in the 2009 Northern Collegiate Hockey Association race has arrived and the second half of the league schedule send St. Norbert on the road to face UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads the UW-Eau Claire series by a 35-3-2 margin. St. Norbert is unbeaten in the last 37 meetings, going 35-0-2. St. Norbert is 24-1-1 at home all-time against Eau Claire.

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 29-17-5 margin. St. Norbert is 29-9-2 in the last 40 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 11-1-1 in the last 13 games in the series.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 336-96-35 in his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 192-27-18 in the last seven seasons.

UW-Eau Claire coach Matt Loen (UW-Eau Claire, 1995) is 23-21-2 in his second season in Eau Claire.

UW-Stevens Point coach Wil Nichol (UW-Stevens Point, 1998) is 25-14-6 in his second season in Stevens Point.

#### Last Meetings:

Shane Wheeler's power-play goal with 6:19 left gave St. Norbert a 4-3 win over UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 15 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Brad Herman, A.J. Gale and Pete Fylling also scored for St. Norbert. B.J. O'Brien made 29 saves for the Green Knights, while Tyler Brigl made 25 stops for the Blugolds.

Ryan Petersen's shorthanded goal with 5:24 left broke open a 2-1 game and led St. Norbert to a 5-2 win over UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 14 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Petersen scored two goals in the game for the Green Knights. Blake Bashor made 15 saves for St. Norbert, while Thomas Speer made 21 saves for the Pointers.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 14-4 overall and 5-2 in the NCHA. The Green Knights topped Lake Forest 9-0 at home this past Saturday.

Junior forward A.J. Gale enters the weekend with 19 goals, which puts him second nationally in Division III. Gale also has 11 assists for 30 points. Junior forward Shane Wheeler has seven goals and 13 assists for 20 points, while sophomore defenseman Nick Tabisz has five goals and 13 assists for 18 points.

Sophomore goaltender B.J. O'Brien is 7-2 overall with a 2.31 goals against average and .912 save percentage. Sophomore Blake Bashor is 7-2 with a 1.81 goals against average and .920 save percentage. The Green Knights are scoring 4.50 goals per game while allowing 2.06 goals per game. St. Norbert is 28-for-106 (26.4 percent) on the power play and is 93-for-104 (89.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire enters the weekend with a 12-5-1 overall record and a 2-4-1 mark in the NCHA. The Blugolds tied UW-Stevens Point 4-4 in Eau Claire this past Saturday.

Senior forward Sean Garrity leads the Blugolds in scoring with 11 goals and eight assists for 19 points. Senior forward Jesse Vesel has five goals and 12 assists for 17 points, while junior forward Brant Marple has three goals and 12 assists for 15 points. Junior forward Joe Bluhm also has 11 goals to go along with three assists for 14 points.

Junior goaltender Tyler Brigl has seen most of the action in net this season for the Blugolds. Brigl is 10-4-1 overall with a 2.06 goals against average and .909 save percentage.

Eau Claire is averaging 3.50 goals per game while allowing 2.28 goals per game. The Blugolds are 16-for-112 (14.3 percent) on the power play and are 79-for-90 (87.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the weekend with an 11-5-2 overall mark and a 2-4-1 record in the NCHA. The Pointers tied UW-Eau Claire 4-4 this past Saturday in Eau Claire.

Freshman forward Jon Madden leads the Pointers in scoring with 15 goals and 11 assists for 26 points. Senior forward Russel Law has 12 goals and six assists for 18 points. Senior forward Sean Fish and freshman forward Luke Nesper each have six goals and 10 assists for 16 points.

Sophomore goaltender Thomas Speer is 7-5 overall with a 2.84 goals against average and .886 save percentage. Senior Marcus Paulson is 4-0-2 overall with a 1.75 goals against average and .934 save percentage.

Stevens Point is averaging 4.28

goals per game while allowing 2.50 goals per game. The Pointers are 25-for-110 (22.7 percent) on the power play and are 101-for-119 (84.9 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### Gale Warning:

Junior forward A.J. Gale has been white hot over the last four games, leading a resurgent St. Norbert offense.

Gale has scored 12 points (9-3-12) in his last four games. Gale posted three goals and one assist for four points on Jan. 3 at MSOE and Jan. 17 against Lake Forest.

Gale became just the second St. Norbert skater in the last 11 years to register two hat tricks in the same season. Andy Cote had a pair of four-goal games during the 2005-06 campaign.

Gale holds the outright lead in the NCHA in goals, power-play goals and points, and shares the league lead in power-play points with UW-Stout's Derek Hanson with 14.

Rob Smillie is the only St. Norbert skater to ever score at least 25 goals in one season. Smillie posted a school-record 34 goals in 1997-98.

#### Not Asleep:

Senior forward Steven Sleep has skated in 103 consecutive games, not missing a game since Nov. 25, 2005 at UW-Stevens Point. In all, Sleep has appeared in 112 of a possible 113 career games.

The NCAA Division III record for consecutive games played by a skater is 109, set by Bethel's Garrett Strot from 1984 to 1987. Barring an injury or disqualification, Sleep would pass Strot for the record on Feb. 14 at Lake Forest.

Fourteen St. Norbert skaters have played in at least 110 career games. Rob Smillie (1996-99), Shane Dickson (1998-2001) and Jason Deitsch (2002-05) all share the school record for total games played with 122.

#### January Joy:

The month of January continues to be a strong one for the St. Norbert College hockey team under coach Tim Coghlin, with the Green Knights going 4-1 so far this month.

Under Coghlin, the Green Knights boast a 96-18-11 record in January. It's the best mark in any month for the Green Knights. St. Norbert is also 89-28-8 in November and 72-20-9 in February under Coghlin. The Green Knights are 23-13-1 under Coghlin in the "money month" of March, with all games being NCHA Peters Cup or NCAA Division III championship action.

St. Norbert has lost more than one game in January just once in the last 11 years, when it went 5-2 in January in 2006-07. The Green Knights were 6-0-1 in January last season en route to their first national championship.

#### Two Down, One to Go:

St. Norbert suffered a rare loss when leading after two periods in the 3-2 setback to St. Thomas on Jan. 9. The Green Knights led 2-1 after two periods before falling 3-2. It marked just the third time in the last 14 years St. Norbert had a twoperiod lead and lost the game.

#### **Penalty Shot:**

Gale at UW-Superior (L 4-3) By Opponent: Nov. 5, 2005 - Joe Haehn, Augsburg (L 7-4) St. Norbert had a 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods end on Jan. 19, 2007 against St. Scholastica when the Green Knights led 2-1 after two periods before losing 3-2. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995. St. Norbert also lost to Oswego State in the NCAA national semifinals in 2007 by a 4-3 overtime score after leading 3-2 after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 201-1-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead. The most recent tie came on Nov. 30, 2007 when St. Scholastica claimed a 2-2 stalemate after trailing 2-1 after the first 40 minutes.

Under coach Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 183-0-2 at home when up after two periods. The overall home unbeaten streak when up after two stanzas is 199 games (196-0-3).

#### Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 214 games when scoring five goals or more with a 209-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 12 times in their last 226 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41 games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

#### **Poll Position:**

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 132 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1 before falling to No. 3 on Nov. 24. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 132-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 40 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season and is 2-3-0 against them this season. St. Norbert is 73-29-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team.

#### **One-Goal Observations:**

St. Norbert was able to fashion its 37-game unbeaten streak thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

St. Norbert had a 10-game winning streak in one-goal games snapped in a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The Green Knights were 8-0 in one-goal games in 2007-08 but are 3-3 in one-goal games this season.

In the prior four seasons (2003-04 to 2006-07) combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 48-44 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, 2008, the first time in school history that has occurred.
