Weekend Overview:

St. Norbert can climb back into the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association championship hunt when it faces a pair of top-three opponents in UW-Superior and St. Scholastica at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the hotly contested series with UW-Superior 24-19-9. St. Norbert and Superior have met 26 times in the past eight seasons, with St. Norbert holding a 13-6-7 edge. The Green Knights are 11-3-5 against Superior since a 2002 loss in the NCAA Tournament quarterfinals in Green Bay.

St. Norbert is 37-6-2 all-time against St. Scholastica. The Green Knights are 34-1-2 in the last 37 meetings, and have outscored the Saints 131-22 in

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 337-97-35 in his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 193-28-18 in the last seven seasons.

UW-Superior coach Dan Stauber (UW-Superior, 1988) is 176-50-33 in his ninth season in Superior.

St. Scholastica coach Mark Wick (St. Scholastica, 1985) is 60-55-16 in his fifth season in Duluth.

Last Meetings:

UW-Superior snapped St. Norbert's 37-game unbeaten streak with a 4-3 win at Wessman Arena on Nov. 22. Chris Wilson's goal with 14:04 left snapped a 3-3 tie. Superior scored two power-play goals in the game, while A.J. Gale connected on a penalty shot for St. Norbert. Chad Beiswenger had 24 saves for St. Norbert, while B.J. O'Brien had 31 saves for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert topped St. Scholastica 3-0 on Nov. 21 at Mars Lakeview Arena in Duluth. Brandon Longley scored all three goals for St. Norbert, while Ryan Petersen had three assists. Blake Bashor made 31 saves for St. Norbert, while Steve Bounds had 34 saves for St. Scholastica.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a 15-5 overall record and a 6-3 mark in the NCHA. The Green Knights topped UW-Eau Claire 2-1 on Friday before falling to UW-Stevens Point 2-1 in overtime on Saturday.

Junior forward A.J. Gale, who missed last weekend's action, enters the weekend with 19 goals. Gale also has 11 assists for 30 points. Junior forward Shane Wheeler has seven goals and 13 assists for 20 points, while sophomore defenseman Nick Tabisz has five goals and 14 assists for 19 points.

Sophomore goaltender Blake Bashor is 8-3 overall with a 1.75 goals against average and .925 save

percentage. Sophomore B.J. O'Brien is 7-2 overall with a 2.31 goals against average and .912 save percentage.

The Green Knights are scoring 4.20 goals per game while allowing 2.00 goals per game. St. Norbert is 29-for-119 (24.4 percent) on the power play and is 104-for-116 (89.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Yellowjackets:

UW-Superior enters the weekend with a 16-2-2 overall record and a 7-1-1 mark in the NCHA. The Yellowjackets topped UW-River Falls 5-3 on Friday before a 2-2 stalemate with UW-Stout on Saturday at Wessman Arena.

Senior forward Kevin Huck leads Superior in scoring with eight goals and 18 assists for 26 points. Junior forward Braden Desmet has 12 goals and 13 assists for 25 points, while junior forward Chris Wilson has 11 goals and 11 assists for 22 points.

Senior goaltender Chad Beiswenger has played exclusively in net for the Yellowjackets. Beiswenger is 16-2-2 overall with a 2.03 goals against average and .916 save percentage.

Superior is averaging 4.50 goals per game while allowing 2.05 goals per game. The Yellowjackets are 22-for-100 (22.0 percent) on the power play and are 93-for-107 (86.9 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Saints:

St. Scholastica enters Friday's game at Lake Forest with a 15-3-2 overall record and a 6-2-1 ledger in the NCHA. The Saints tied UW-Stout 2-2 on Friday and topped UW-River Falls 3-2 on Saturday. St. Scholastica is 11-0-1 since a 3-0 loss to St. Norbert on Nov. 21.

Senior forwards Trevor Geiger and Joey Martini share the team lead in scoring, with both owning 11 goals and 13 assists for 24 points. Senior forward A.J. Tucker has 13 goals and 10 assists for 23 points, while junior forward Jordan Chong has 11 goals and 10 assists for 21 points.

Senior goaltender Steve Bounds

has seen the vast majority of action in net for the Saints. Bounds is 13-3-2 with a 1.98 goals against average and .935 save percentage.

St. Scholastica is averaging 3.90 goals per game while allowing 2.15 goals per game. The Saints are 19-for-80 (23.8 percent) on the power play and are 80-for-93 (86.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Not Asleep:

Senior forward Steven Sleep has skated in 105 consecutive games, not missing a game since Nov. 25, 2005 at UW-Stevens Point. In all, Sleep has appeared in 114 of a possible 115 career games.

The NCAA Division III record for consecutive games played by a skater is 109, set by Bethel's Garrett Strot from 1984 to 1987. Barring an injury or disqualification, Sleep would pass Strot for the record on Feb. 14 at Lake Forest.

Nine St. Norbert skaters have played in at least 114 career games. Rob Smillie (1996-99), Shane Dickson (1998-2001) and Jason Deitsch (2002-05) all share the school record for total games played with 122.

Additionally, senior forward Ryan Petersen has played in 90 consecutive games dating back to his freshman year. Petersen was a healthy scratch in the regular-season finale against Lake Forest in 2006, then played in all seven post-season games. Petersen has played in 112 of 115 career games, and was scratched for two of the first three games played during his freshman season.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 133 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

This weekend marks the second time in two years St. Norbert will host a pair of top-five opponents in the same weekend at the Cornerstone Community Center. On Dec. 7-8, 2007, St. Norbert topped No. 5 UW-Stout 7-1 and No. 4 UW-River Falls 5-2.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1 before falling to No. 3 on Nov. 24. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 133-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 40 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season and is 2-4-0 against them this season. St. Norbert is 73-30-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 2-4 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a four-game losing streak against ranked opponents, the first time in school history since the inception of the USCHO.com Poll in 1998 that has happened.

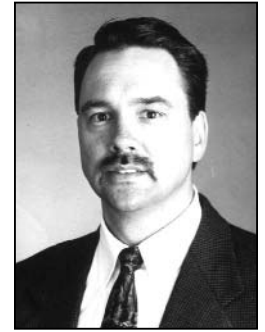

Norbert College hockey team under coach Tim Coghlin, with the Green Knights going 5-2 so far this month.

Under Coghlin, the Green Knights boast a 97-19-11 record in January. It's the best mark in any month for the Green Knights. St. Norbert is also 89-28-8 in November and 72-20-9 in February under Coghlin. The Green Knights are 23-13-1 under Coghlin in the "money month" of March, with all games being NCHA Peters Cup or NCAA Division III championship action.

St. Norbert has lost more than one game in January just once in the last 11 years, when it went 5-2 in January in 2006-07. The Green Knights were 6-0-1 in January last season en route to their first national championship.

Two Down, One to Go:

St. Norbert suffered a rare loss when leading after two periods in the 3-2 setback to St. Thomas on Jan. 9. The Green Knights led 2-1 after two periods before falling 3-2. It marked just the third time in the last 14 years St. Norbert had a two-period lead and lost the game.

St. Norbert had a 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods end on Jan. 19, 2007 against St. Scholastica when the Green Knights led 2-1 after two periods before losing 3-2. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995. St. Norbert also lost to Oswego State in the NCAA national semifinals in 2007 by a 4-3 overtime score after leading 3-2 after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 201-1-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead. The most recent tie came on Nov. 30, 2007 when St. Scholastica claimed a 2-2 stalemate after trailing 2-1 after the first 40 minutes.

Under coach Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 183-0-2 at home when up after two periods. The overall home

unbeaten streak when up after two stanzas is 199 games (196-0-3).

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 214 games when scoring five goals or more with a 209-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 12 times in their last 226 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41 games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert was able to fashion its 37-game unbeaten streak thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

St. Norbert had a 10-game winning streak in one-goal games snapped in a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The Green Knights were 8-0 in one-goal games in 2007-08 but are 4-4 in one-goal games this season.

In the prior four seasons (2003-04 to 2006-07) combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 49-45 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, 2008, the first time in school history that has occurred.
