Weekend Overview:

St. Norbert looks to get back on track when it faces UW-River Falls and UW-Stout in its final regular-season home weekend of the year.

Broadcast:

St. Norbert coverage is on the WSNC radio Webcast with Tim Derozier on the call. The Webcast is available at http://www.snc.edu/athletics/hock-ey/webcast.htm.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-River Falls 27-16-2. The Green Knights are 23-4-1 against River Falls in their last 28 meetings. St. Norbert is 14-0 against the Falcons at home during that stretch. River Falls is 1-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, and is 0-12 all-time there against St. Norbert.

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stout 28-7-4. The Green Knights are 26-2-3 in the last 31 games with the Blue Devils and are 18-1 in their last 19 home games in the series. Stout is 0-10 all-time at the Cornerstone - MORE -

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 337-98-36 in his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 193-29-19 in the last seven seasons.

UW-River Falls coach Steve Freeman (UW-Stevens Point, 1981) is 246-109-26 in his 13th season in River Falls.

UW-Stout coach Terry Watkins (UW-Stout, 1972) is 155-176-20 in his 13th season in Menomonie.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert topped UW-River Falls 4-3 in a wild game on Dec. 6 at Hunt Arena. Scott Pulak's goal with 4:42 left was the decisive score. Steven Sleep, Sam Tikka and Tyler Allen all scored for St. Norbert. B.J. O'Brien made 30 saves for St. Norbert. Stephen Ritter made 33 saves for River Falls.

UW-Stout topped St. Norbert 5-2 on Dec. 5 at the Dunn County Ice Arena. Joel Gaulrapp scored twice for the Blue Devils as they jumped out to a 4-0 lead. A.J. Gale and Jason Nopper scored for St. Norbert. Matt Koenig made 33 saves for Stout.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a 15-6-1 overall record and a 6-4-1 mark in the NCHA. St. Norbert tied UW-Superior 2-2 on Friday before falling to St. Scholastica 3-0 on Saturday.

Junior forward A.J. Gale, who has missed the last two weekends, has a team-high 19 goals. Gale also has 11 assists for 30 points. Junior forward Shane Wheeler has eight goals and 14 assists for 22 points, while sophomore defenseman Nick Tabisz has five goals and 15 assists for 20 points.

Sophomore goaltender Blake Bashor is 8-4-1 overall with a 1.82 goals against average and .920 save percentage. Sophomore B.J. O'Brien is 7-2 overall with a 2.33 goals against average and .911 save percentage.

The Green Knights are scoring

3.91 goals per game while allowing 2.05 goals per game. St. Norbert is 29-for-129 (22.5 percent) on the power play and is 111-for-124 (89.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Falcons:

UW-River Falls enters the weekend at 10-11-1 overall and 4-7 in the NCHA. The Falcons won a pair of one-goal games at home last weekend, topping UW-Stevens Point 4-3 on Friday before tipping UW-Eau Claire 2-1 on Saturday.

Senior forward Derek Hansberry leads the Falcons in scoring at 15 goals and seven assists for 22 points. Junior forward Tyler Czuba has 12 goals and five assists for 17 points, while freshman forward Ben Beaudoin has five goals and 12 assists for 17 points. The Falcons will be without freshman forward Josh Kamrass, sophomore defenseman Jon Halstenson and freshman defenseman Tyler Pederson against St. Norbert, who were disqualified for fighting at the conclusion of the Eau Claire game.

Junior goaltender Stephen Ritter has seen most of the action in net this season for the Falcons. Ritter is 9-7-1 with a 2.67 goals against average and .920 save percentage.

River Falls is averaging 2.86 goals per game while allowing 2.86 goals per game. The Falcons are 14-for-100 (14.0 percent) on the power play and are 105-for-126 (83.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Blue Devils:

UW-Stout enters Friday's game at Lake Forest with a 15-5-2 overall record and a 7-2-2 mark in the NCHA. The Blue Devils won 3-1 at UW-Eau Claire on Friday before beating UW-Stevens Point 6-3 at home on Saturday. Stout is 10-1-2 since a 5-2 loss to St. Scholastica on Nov. 15, its only setback a 4-1 loss to Concordia-Moorhead on Jan. 9.

Junior forward Derek Hanson leads the Blue Devils in scoring with 14 goals and 21 assists for 35 points. Junior forward Joel Gaulrapp has 14 goals and 15 assists for 29 points, while junior forward Scott Motz has 11 goals and 15 assists for 26 points.

Senior forward Matt Koenig has seen most of the time between the pipes for Stout. Koenig is 13-4-2 with a 2.40 goals against average and .925 save percentage.

Stout is averaging 4.27 goals per game while allowing 2.68 goals per game. The Blue Devils are 30-for-129 (23.3 percent) on the power play and are 103-for-126 (81.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

Power Outage:

St. Norbert enters the weekend ranked 17th in the national Division III statistics on its power play. The Green Knights are 29-for-129 on the power play this season, good for 22.5 percent.

However, St. Norbert is just 1-for-26 in its last five games with the man advantage. The only goal St. Norbert has scored on the power play in the last five games was Tyler Allen's third-period game-winning goal in a 2-1 triumph at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 23.

St. Norbert has had just one power play below 22 percent in the last 14 years - a 21.6 percent unit in 2006-07.

The Green Knights' penalty kill of 89.5 percent is second nationally behind Amherst's 91.1 percent.

Not Asleep:

Senior forward Steven Sleep has skated in 107 consecutive games, not missing a game since Nov. 25, 2005 at UW-Stevens Point. In all, Sleep has appeared in 116 of a possible 117 career games.

The NCAA Division III record for

consecutive games played by a skater is 109, set by Bethel's Garrett Strot from 1984 to 1987. Barring an injury or disqualification, Sleep would pass Strot for the record on Feb. 14 at Lake Forest.

Seven St. Norbert skaters have played in at least 116 career games. Rob Smillie (1996-99), Shane Dickson (1998-2001) and Jason Deitsch (2002-05) all share the school record for total games played with 122.

Additionally, senior forward Ryan Petersen has played in 92 consecutive games dating back to his freshman year. Petersen was a healthy scratch in the regular-season finale against Lake Forest in 2006, then played in all seven postseason games. Petersen has played in 114 of 117 career games, and was scratched for two of the first three games played during his freshman season.

Sophomore forward Taylor Langford has not missed a game in his collegiate career, skating in all 54 games.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 134 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1 before falling to No. 3 on Nov. 24. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 134-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season and is 2-5-1 against them this season. St. Norbert is 73-31-12 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 2-5 alltime against the No. 2-ranked team.

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a six-game winless streak against ranked opponents, the first time in school history since the inception of the USCHO.com Poll in 1998 that has happened.

Two Down, One to Go:

St. Norbert suffered a rare loss when leading after two periods in the 3-2 setback to St. Thomas on Jan. 9. The Green Knights led 2-1 after two periods before falling 3-2. It marked just the third time in the last 14 years St. Norbert had a two-period lead and lost the game.

St. Norbert had a 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods end on Jan. 19, 2007 against St. Scholastica when the Green Knights led 2-1 after two periods before losing 3-2. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995. St. Norbert also lost to Oswego State in the NCAA national semifinals in 2007 by a 4-3 overtime score after leading 3-2 after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 201-1-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead. The most recent tie came on Nov. 30, 2007 when St. Scholastica claimed a 2-2 stalemate after trailing 2-1 after the first 40 minutes.

Under coach Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 183-0-2 at home when up after two periods. The overall home unbeaten streak when up after two stanzas is 199 games (196-0-3).

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 214 games when scoring five goals or more with a 209-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 12 times in their last 226 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41 games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert was able to fashion its 37-game unbeaten streak thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

St. Norbert had a 10-game winning streak in one-goal games snapped in a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The Green Knights were 8-0 in one-goal games in 2007-08 but are 4-4 in one-goal games this season.

In the prior four seasons (2003-04 to 2006-07) combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 49-45 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, 2008, the first time in school history that has occurred.
