Series Overview:

St. Norbert begins post-season play with a NCHA Peters Cup Quarterfinal series against UW-Stevens Point. The Green Knights have won a NCHA Quarterfinal series every year since 1998.

Broadcast:

St. Norbert coverage is on the WSNC radio Webcast with Tim Derozier on the call. The Webcast is available at http://www.snc.edu/athletics/hockey/webcast.htm.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 29-18-5 margin. St. Norbert is 29-10-2 in the last 41 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 11-2-1 in the last 14 games in the series. St. Norbert is 17-6-4 all-time at home in the series. The Green Knights are 3-3-1 all-time in the post-season against the Pointers, and the two teams haven't met in the playoffs since a 3-1 St. Norbert win in a NCHA Peters Cup Semifinal game on Feb. 28, 2002 in Green Bay.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 339-99-36 in his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 195-30-19 in the last seven seasons.

UW-Stevens Point coach Wil Nichol (UW-Stevens Point, 1998) is 29-17-6 in his second season in Stevens Point.

This Year:

Ryan Petersen's shorthanded goal with 5:24 left broke open a 2-1 game and led St. Norbert to a 5-2 win over UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 14 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Petersen scored two goals in the game for the Green Knights. Blake Bashor made 15 saves for St. Norbert, while Thomas Speer made 21 saves for the Pointers.

Travis Erstad scored 1:41 into overtime to give Stevens Point a 2-1 win over St. Norbert on Jan. 24 at Willett Arena. Erstad scored both goals for the Pointers, while Taylor Langford scored for St. Norbert. Speer made 24 saves for the Pointers, while Bashor made 23 saves for the Green Knights.

Playoff Format:

The quarterfinals will have a twogame series format. There will be a five-minute overtime played in case of a tie in regulation. If the teams split or tie both of the two games, a 20-minute "mini-game" will be played following the completion of Saturday night's game. If the minigame results in a tie, the game will continue in a sudden-death format using 20-minute overtime periods.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a 17-7-1 overall record and is seeded fourth in the Peters Cup Playoffs. St. Norbert topped Lake Forest in its only game last week, a 4-3 triumph in Lake Forest, Ill.

Junior forward A.J. Gale, who has missed the last four weekends, has a team-high 19 goals. Gale also has 11 assists for 30 points. Junior forward Shane Wheeler has 10 goals and 14 assists for 24 points, while sophomore defenseman Nick Tabisz has eight goals and 16 assists for 24 points. Junior forward Matt Boyd has 19 points this season, with 14 coming since the Christmas break.

Sophomore goaltender Blake Bashor is 9-5-1 overall with a 1.91 goals against average and .916 save percentage. Sophomore B.J. O'Brien is 8-2 overall with a 2.40 goals against average and .905 save percentage.

The Green Knights are scoring 3.88 goals per game while allowing 2.12 goals per game. St. Norbert is 30-for-139 (21.6 percent) on the power play and is 122-for-137 (89.1 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the weekend at 15-8-2 overall and is seeded fifth for the Peters Cup Playoffs. The Pointers beat UW-Eau Claire 5-4 this past Saturday in Stevens Point. The Pointers are 2-3 in their last five games.

Freshman forward Jon Madden has 16 goals and 13 assists for 29 points. Freshman forward Luke Nesper has 11 goals and 12 assists for 23 points, while senior forward Russel Law has 14 goals and eight assists for 22 points, with six of his goals power-play scores. Senior forward Sean Fish has seven goals and 13 assists for 20 points.

Sophomore goaltender Thomas Speer has seen most of the action in goal for the Pointers this season, going 11-8 with a 2.96 goals against average and .892 save percentage. Senior Marcus Paulson is 4-0-2 with a 1.75 goals against average and .934 save percentage.

Peters Cup Patter:

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just one NCHA Peters Cup Playoff series on the road. The Green Knights, after a third-place finish in the NCHA in 2000-01, played at UW-River Falls in the semifinal round and were eliminated 1-0 in an overtime minigame. St. Norbert finished second in 1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game by UW- Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

St. Norbert has played 33 of the last 34 NCHA Peters Cup Playoff rounds it has played in on home ice. The Green Knights are 44-11-1 alltime in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs, and are 43-7 at home alltime in the Peters Cup tournament. St. Norbert has played only away series against UW-River Falls (twice) and UW-Stevens Point on the all-time in Peters Cup play.

Rare Indeed:

St. Norbert suffered its first-ever home loss when leading after two periods under Tim Coghlin in a 4-3 overtime loss to UW-Stout on Feb. 7. The Green Knights led 2-1 after two periods and held a 3-1 advantage but ended up losing in overtime. It was just the fourth time in the last 14 years St. Norbert had a two-period lead and lost the game.

Under Coghlin, St. Norbert is 184-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The overall home unbeaten streak when up after two stanzas was 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by Stout.

At home, St. Norbert is 202-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead. The most recent tie came on Nov. 30, 2007 when St. Scholastica claimed a 2-2 stalemate after trailing 2-1 after the first 40 minutes.

Not Asleep:

Senior forward Steven Sleep had his 109 consecutive games skated streak snapped when he did not dress against Lake Forest on Feb. 14. Sleep had not missed a game since Nov. 25, 2005 at UW-Stevens Point. In all, Sleep has appeared in 118 of a possible 120 career games.

Sleep's streak tied the NCAA Division III record for consecutive games played by a skater at 109, also set by Bethel's Garrett Strot from 1984 to 1987.

Seven St. Norbert skaters have played in at least 117 career games. Rob Smillie (1996-99), Shane Dickson (1998-2001) and Jason Deitsch (2002-05) all share the school record for total games played with 122.

Additionally, senior forward Ryan Petersen has played in 95 consecutive games dating back to his freshman year. Petersen was a healthy scratch in the regular-season finale against Lake Forest in 2006, then played in all seven postseason games. Petersen has played in 117 of 120 career games, and was scratched for two of the first three games played during his freshman season.

Sophomore forward Taylor Langford has not missed a game in his collegiate career, skating in all 57 games.

Power Outage:

St. Norbert enters the weekend ranked 20th in the national Division III statistics on its power play. The Green Knights are 30-for-139 on the power play this season, good for

However, St. Norbert is just 2-for-36 in its last seven games with the man advantage. The only powerplay goals St. Norbert has scored on the power play in the last seven games was Tyler Allen's third-period game-winning goal in a 2-1 triumph at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 23 and Steven Pratt's score late in a 4-1 win over UW-River Falls on Feb. 6.

St. Norbert has had just one power play below 22 percent in the last 14 years - a 21.6 percent unit in 2006-07.

The Green Knights' penalty kill of 89.1 percent is second nationally.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 136 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1 before falling to No. 3 on Nov. 24. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 136-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 40 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season and is 2-6-1 against them this season. St. Norbert is 73-32-12 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 2-5 alltime against the No. 2-ranked team.

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a seven-game winless streak against ranked opponents, the first time in school history since the inception of the USCHO.com Poll in 1998 that has happened.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 214 games when scoring five goals or more with a 209-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more

goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 12 times in their last 229 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41 games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert was able to fashion its 37-game unbeaten streak during the 2008 and 2009 seasons thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

St. Norbert had a 10-game winning streak in one-goal games snapped in a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The Green Knights were 8-0 in one-goal games in 2007-08 but are 5-5 in one-goal games this season. St. Norbert has lost three of its last five one-goal games.

In the prior four seasons (2003-04 to 2006-07) combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 50-46 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, 2008, the first time in school history that has occurred.
