St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview NCHA PETERS CUP PLAYOFFS - SEMIFINAL GAME No. 11 St. Norbert College (19-7-1) at No. 2 UW-Superior (22-2-3) Saturday, February 28, 2009 - 7 p.m. Wessman Arena (1,700) - Superior, Wis.

Game Overview:

St. Norbert and UW-Superior renew its hotly contested rivalry with a NCHA Peters Cup Playoff Semifinal game Saturday at Wessman Arena. No NCHA team other than St. Norbert or Superior has won the Peters Cup since UW-River Falls won it in 1996.

Broadcast:

St. Norbert coverage is on the WSNC radio Webcast with Tim Derozier on the call. The Webcast is available at <http://www.snc.edu/athletics/hockey/webcast.htm>.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the hotly contested series with UW-Superior 24-19-10. The Green Knights are 8-8-7 all-time at Wessman Arena against Superior. St. Norbert and Superior have met 27 times in the past eight seasons, with St. Norbert holding a 13-6-8 edge. The Green Knights are 11-3-6 against Superior since a 2002 loss in the NCAA Tournament quarterfinals in Green Bay.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 341-99-36 in his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 197-30-19 in the last eight seasons.

UW-Superior coach Dan Stauber (UW-Superior, 1988) is 182-50-34 in his ninth season in Superior.

This Year:

UW-Superior snapped St. Norbert's 37-game unbeaten streak with a 4-3 win at Wessman Arena on Nov. 22. Chris Wilson's goal with 14:04 left snapped a 3-3 tie. Superior scored two power-play goals in the game, while A.J. Gale connected on a penalty shot for St. Norbert. Chad Beiswenger had 24 saves for St. Norbert, while B.J. O'Brien had 31 saves for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert and Superior tied 2-2 on Jan. 30 at the Cornerstone Community Center in Green Bay. Eric Bausano's goal with 8:11 left in regulation was the equalizer. Shane Wheeler and Matt Boyd scored for St. Norbert, while Bausano had both of Superior's markers. Blake Bashor had 20 saves for St. Norbert, while Beiswenger had 32 saves for the Yellowjackets.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game with a 19-7-1 overall record and is seeded fourth in the Peters Cup Playoffs. St. Norbert swept UW-Stevens Point in a quarterfinal series by scores of 8-3 and 4-3, the latter tilt in overtime.

Junior forward A.J. Gale, who has missed the last five weekends, has a team-high 19 goals. Gale also has 11 assists for 30 points. Junior forward Shane Wheeler has 11 goals and 17 assists for 28 points, while sophomore defenseman/forward Nick Tabisz has 11 goals and 17 assists for 28 points. Junior forward Matt Boyd has 25 points - including a team-high 20 assists - this season, with 20 coming since the Christmas break.

Sophomore goaltender Blake Bashor is 10-5-1 overall with a 1.83 goals against average and .919 save percentage. Sophomore B.J. O'Brien

is 9-2 overall with a 2.61 goals against average and .894 save percentage.

The Green Knights are scoring 4.04 goals per game while allowing 2.19 goals per game. St. Norbert is 33-for-151 (21.9 percent) on the power play and is 129-for-148 (87.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Yellowjackets:

UW-Superior enters the game with a 22-2-3 overall record. The Yellowjackets swept Lake Forest in a quarterfinal series 4-3 and 5-0 this past weekend. Superior's lone two losses this season came 3-1 at St. Thomas on Oct. 31 and 7-2 at St. Scholastica on Jan. 17. The Yellowjackets are 12-0-2 this season at Wessman Arena.

Junior forward Chris Wilson has scored 15 goals and 17 assists this season to lead the Yellowjackets with 32 points. Junior forward Braden Desmet has 13 goals and 18 assists for 31 points. Sophomore forward Talon Berlando has 11 goals and 18 assists for 29 points, while senior forward Kevin Huck has eight goals and 21 assists for 29 points.

Senior goaltender Chad Beiswenger has seen exclusive action in net for Superior. Beiswenger is 22-2-3 overall with a 2.01 goals against average and .920 save percentage with four shutouts.

The Yellowjackets are scoring 4.52 goals per game while allowing 2.04 goals per game. Superior is 29-for-132 (22.0 percent) on the power play and is 114-for-130 (87.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

Peters Cup Patter:

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just one NCHA Peters Cup Playoff series on the road. The Green Knights, after a third-place finish in the NCHA in 2000-01, played at UW-River Falls in the semifinal round and were eliminated 1-0 in an overtime mini-game. This weekend's game at Superior marks just the second round of action the Green Knights have had to play on the road in Peters Cup Playoff play in 13 years.

St. Norbert finished second in 1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game by UW-Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

Including Saturday's game at Superior, St. Norbert has played 33 of the last 35 NCHA Peters Cup Playoff rounds it has played in on home ice. The Green Knights are 46-11-1 all-time in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs, and are 45-7 at home all-time in the Peters Cup tournament. St. Norbert has played only away series against UW-River Falls (twice) and UW-Stevens Point on the all-time in Peters Cup play - going 1-4-1 in those games.

Boyd Bullets:

Junior forward Matt Boyd enjoyed his best weekend of the season in the NCHA Peters Cup Quarterfinal series against UW-Stevens Point. Boyd finished the two games with one goal and five assists for six points.

Boyd factored in on all four of St. Norbert's goals in a 4-3 overtime win to clinch the series on Feb. 21. His lone goal was a big one, an unassisted shorthanded marker with 4:22 left in regulation to knot the game at 3-3. It was Boyd's first career shorthanded goal.

Despite missing eight games this season, Boyd has reached the 20-assist plateau. Boyd has had at least 20 assists in all three of his seasons (21 as a freshman, 22 as a sophomore and 20 as a junior), giving him

a total of 63 so far for his career.

Boyd's 29 career multi-point games are the most among current St. Norbert skaters.

Rare Indeed:

St. Norbert suffered its first-ever home loss when leading after two periods under Tim Coghlin in a 4-3 overtime loss to UW-Stout on Feb. 7. The Green Knights led 2-1 after two periods and held a 3-1 advantage but ended up losing in overtime. It was just the fourth time in the last 14 years St. Norbert had a two-period lead and lost the game.

Under Coghlin, St. Norbert is 185-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The overall home unbeaten streak when up after two stanzas was 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by Stout.

At home, St. Norbert is 203-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead. The most recent tie came on Nov. 30, 2007 when St. Scholastica claimed a 2-2 stalemate after trailing 2-1 after the first 40 minutes.

Not Asleep:

Senior forward Steven Sleep had his 109 consecutive games skated streak snapped when he did not dress against Lake Forest on Feb. 14. Sleep had not missed a game since Nov. 25, 2005 at UW-Stevens Point. In all, Sleep has appeared in 120 of a possible 122 career games.

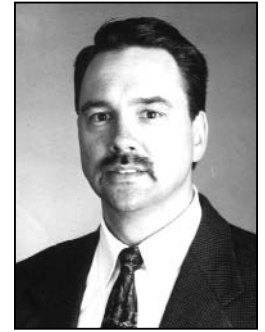

Division III record for consecutive games played by a skater at 109, also set by Bethel's Garrett Strot from 1984 to 1987.

Seven St. Norbert skaters have played in at least 117 career games. Rob Smillie (1996-99), Shane Dickson (1998-2001) and Jason Deitsch (2002-05) all share the school record for total games played with 122.

Additionally, senior forward Ryan Petersen has played in 97 consecutive games dating back to his freshman year. Petersen was a healthy scratch in the regular-season finale against Lake Forest in 2006, then played in all seven post-season games. Petersen has played in 118 of 121 career games, and was scratched for two of the first three games played during his freshman season.

Sophomore forward Taylor Langford has not missed a game in his collegiate career, skating in all 58 games.

Power Outage:

St. Norbert enters the weekend ranked 20th in the national Division III statistics on its power play. The Green Knights are 33-for-151 on the power play this season, good for 21.9 percent.

Entering the Stevens Point series, St. Norbert was 2-for-36 in its last seven games with the man advantage. The Green Knights were 3-for-12 on the power play against Stevens Point this past weekend, getting two scores from Steven Pratt and one from Sam Tikka.

The only power-play goals St. Norbert scored on the power play during its 2-for-36 stretch was Tyler Allen's third-period game-winning goal in a 2-1 triumph at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 23 and Steven Pratt's score late in a 4-1 win over UW-River Falls on Feb. 6.

St. Norbert has had just one power play below 22 percent in the last 14 years - a 21.6 percent unit in 2006-07.

The Green Knights' penalty kill of 87.2 percent is eighth nationally after entering the Stevens Point series second.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 137 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1 before falling to No. 3 on Nov. 24. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 137-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 40 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season and is 4-6-1 against them this season. St. Norbert is 75-32-12 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 2-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

St. Norbert snapped a seven-game winless streak against ranked opponents by sweeping No. 15 UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 20-21. The seven-game winless streak against ranked foes was first time in school history since the inception of the USCHO.com Poll in 1998 that has happened.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 215 games when scoring five goals or more with a 210-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

five goals just 12 times in their last 231 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41 games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert was able to fashion its 37-game unbeaten streak during the 2008 and 2009 seasons thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

St. Norbert had a 10-game winning streak in one-goal games snapped in a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The Green Knights were 8-0 in one-goal games in 2007-08 but are 6-5 in one-goal games this season. St. Norbert has split its last six one-goal games.

In the prior four seasons (2003-04 to 2006-07) combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2

in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 51-46 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, 2008, the first time in school history that has occurred.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 104-7-5 in its last 116 games at the Cornerstone Community Center. Unless an improbable series of events occur, St. Norbert has likely

played its final game of the 2008-09 at the Cornerstone.

In the last eight seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 117-10-7 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 126-14-8 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 205-36-14 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

St. Norbert was 10-3-1 at the Cornerstone this season. The Green Knights lost that many games at the Cornerstone just twice in their history - going 9-4-1 in 2000-01 and 13-3-2 in 2001-02.
