Game Overview:

St. Norbert makes its first South Central Minnesota trip to Gustavus Adolphus and St. Olaf since 2003 for a pair of games with the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foes.

The Series:

St. Olaf leads the series 9-8, but St. Norbert is 7-0 against the Oles under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights hold the scoring advantage in games under Coghlin 39-15.

St. Norbert and Gustavus Adolphus are tied all-time in the series 11-11, with the Green Knights a commanding 11-1 under Tim Coghlin. St. Norbert has outscored the Gusties 68-27 in the last 12 games.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 323-92-35 in his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 179-23-18 in the last seven seasons.

Gustavus Adolphus coach Brett Petersen (Denver, 1992) is 94-98-16 starting his ninth season in St. Peter.

St. Olaf coach Sean Goldsworthy (St. Olaf, 1994) is 109-144-32 starting his 13th season in Northfield.

Last Meetings:

Gustavus Adolphus handed St. Norbert its only loss in 2007-08 with a 4-2 setback at the Cornerstone Community Center last Nov. 3. Rory Dynan's second-period goal for the Gusties snapped a 2-2 tie. Nick Tabisz and Matt Boyd scored for the Green Knights. Matt Lopes made 27 saves for Gustavus, including all 15 in the third period.

St. Norbert beat St. Olaf 4-3 last Nov. 2 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Marc Belanger scored two goals and added an assist for the Green Knights. Blake Bashor made 16 saves for St. Norbert, while Brycen Eberwein made 40 saves for the Oles.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert opened the 2008-09 season with an 8-1 win over Lawrence Tuesday night in Appleton and extended its unbeaten streak to 30 games.

Freshman forward Alain Joannette scored a hat trick in his first collegiate game and had the first four-point game by a Green Knights since Feb. 3, 2007. Junior forward A.J. Gale added two goals and an assist for three points. Freshmen forwards Cory Patterson and Steven Pratt also had big nights, scoring one goal and two assists and three assists, respectively.

Sophomore goaltender B.J. O'Brien picked up the win in relief, making 12 saves in just over 30 minutes of action. Sophomore Blake Bashor started and made eight saves while allowing one goal.

St. Norbert is 2-for-10 (20 percent) on the power play and is 6-for-7 (85.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Gusties:

Gustavus Adolphus opens the season Friday against St. Norbert, and went 13-12-1 a season ago with a 10-6 record in the MIAC.

Junior forward David Martinson scored 41 points a season ago with 21 goals and 20 assists. Junior forward Patrick Dynan had 10 goals and 19 assists for 29 points last season.

Sophomore goaltender Josh Swartout was 8-5-1 last season with a 2.54 goals against average and .893 save percentage. Senior Matt Lopes, who beat St. Norbert last season, was 5-5 with a 2.41 goals against average and .893 save percentage.

About the Oles:

St. Olaf opens the new season Friday against Lake Forest after going 9-12-4 last season with a 6-7-3 record in the MIAC.

Senior forward Nick Stalock was the Oles' leading scorer last season with 15 goals and nine assists for 24 points. Senior forward Dylan Mueller had nine goals and eight assists for 17 points, while senior defenseman Sam Windsor had eight goals and six assists for 14 points.

Senior goaltender Jake Busch had a 4-7-3 record last year with a 2.82 goals against average and .905 save percentage. Junior Brycen Eberwein was 3-3-1 with a 4.03 GAA and .873 save percentage.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert took a rare home loss against a MIAC foe when it lost 4-2 at home to Gustavus Adolphus last Nov. 3.

St. Norbert has a solid 62-7-3 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 62-5-3 against the MIAC. The losses came in a 4-3 decision at St. John's on Nov. 24, 2000 and a pair of losses to St. Thomas in the 2004-05 sea-

son. The Green Knights also dropped a 7-4 contest to Augsburg during 2005-06 and to Gustavus Adolphus in 2007-08. St. Norbert has tied St. Thomas twice and Augsburg once, those coming in the 1999-2000 and 2000-01 seasons.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 34-2-1 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3.

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert is currently 26-0-4 since a 4-2 loss to Gustavus Adolphus last Nov. 3. The 30-game unbeaten streak is a school record.

The Green Knights' 30-game unbeaten streak is the second-longest in Division III history. Massachusetts-Dartmouth holds the Division III record at 38 games from Jan. 16, 1985 to March 2, 1986.

In addition to the current streak, St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 12 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history. Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19-game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into

the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-2 over that 31-game stretch.

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 37-2-4 overall and are 22-0-4 against NCHA opponents.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 123 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert enters the 2008-09 season at No. 1. The Green Knights are 49-10-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 123-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 38 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season. St. Norbert is 71-26-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert's eight goals are the most it has scored since a 9-3 win over UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 24, 2006 - a stretch of 54 games.

* - Tyler Allen scored shorthanded against Lawrence. The Green Knights had one shorty all of 2007-08. Nick Tabisz scored shorthanded against Lake Forest on Feb. 23, 2008 for St. Norbert's last shorty.
