St. Norbert has its home opener this weekend when it hosts Concordia and St. John's. The Green Knights will unveil their 2008 NCAA Division III championship banner prior to Friday's game with the Cobbers.

The Series:

Concordia leads the all-time series with St. Norbert by a 5-4 count. The two teams have met only three times in the last 16 years, with St. Norbert winning those three meetings.

St. Norbert leads St. John's 10-7, with St. Norbert winning eight of the last nine games. The Johnnies' lone win in the last 16 years was on Nov. 24, 2000 at the National Hockey Center.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 325-92-35 in his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 181-23-18 in the last seven seasons.

Concordia coach Chris Howe (St. John's, 1999) is 0-2 in his first season in Moorhead.

St. John's coach Doug Scheuller (Bowling Green, 2001) is 0-2 in his first season in Collegeville.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert beat Concordia 3-1 last Nov. 10 at the Moorhead Sports Center. Matt Boyd's goal early in the third period snapped a 1-1 tie. The Green Knights outshot the Cobbers 39-15. Blake Bashor made 14 saves for the Green Knights, while Jeremy Boniface made 36 saves for the Cobbers.

St. Norbert beat St. John's 3-2 last Nov. 11 at the National Hockey Center in St. Cloud. Marc Belanger and Dustin Dubas gave St. Norbert a 2-0 lead before the Johnnies' Nate Meinz and Karl Gilbert tied the score. Steven Sleep's goal late in the second period was the difference. Kyle Jones made 30 saves for St. Norbert, while Vince Wheeler made 18 for the Johnnies.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved to 3-0 with a weekend road sweep of Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foes. The Green Knights topped Gustavus Adolphus 7-5 before beating St. Olaf 5-2.

The Green Knights have already scored 20 goals in three games after scoring 118 in 32 games last season. Freshman forward Alain Joanette has four goals along with one assist for five points. Junior forward A.J. Gale has a team-high seven points, netting three goals and four assists. Junior forward Shane Wheeler and Tyler Allen each have three goals apiece.

Sophomore Blake Bashor is 1-0 this season with a 2.01 goals against average and .889 save percentage. Sophomore B.J. O'Brien is 2-0 with a 3.32 GAA and an .861 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 7-for-22 (31.8 percent) on the power play and is 18-for-21 (85.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Cobbers:

Concordia dropped a pair of games last weekend to open the season, falling at home to UW-Stevens Point 3-1 and UW-Eau Claire 5-4. Concordia had 15 power plays against Stevens Point but scored just once.

Senior forward Ryan Clukey scored two goals and three assists last weekend to lead the Cobbers, while sophomore forward Michael Weiss had two goals for two points. Freshman forward Marc Harris has two assists for two points.

Freshman goalie Elliot Okland got the start against Stevens Point and has a goals against average of 3.02 and a save percentage of .903. Junior Mike Persson had the nod against Eau Claire and has a GAA of 5.02 and a save percentage of 857

Concordia's power play is 3-for-19 (15.8 percent) and its penalty kill is 12-for-15 (80 percent).

About the Johnnies:

St. John's also opened the season last weekend at home against Eau Claire and Stevens Point. The Johnnies lost to the Blugolds 3-2 on Friday before falling to the Pointers 5-4 on Saturday.

Senior forward Brian Baker leads the St. John's offense with one goal and two assists for three points. Sophomore defenseman Jared Smith has three assists for three points, while sophomore defenseman Brent Brodersen has a pair of power-play goals for two points.

Senior goalie Vince Wheeler got the start against Eau Claire and has a 3.03 goals against average and a .906 save percentage. Freshman Steele DeFazio has a 5.12 GAA with an .808 save percentage.

St. John's power play is 3-for-16 (18.8 percent) while its penalty kill is 12-for-13 (92.3 percent).

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last

209 games when scoring five goals or more with a 204-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-17-4 in its last 26 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999. a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30. 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3. 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31,

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 11 times in their last 211 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41 games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 64-7-3 Minnesota record against Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 64-5-3 against the MIAC. The losses came in a 4-3 decision at St. John's on Nov. 24, 2000 and a pair of losses to St. Thomas in the 2004-05 season. The Green Knights also dropped a 7-4 contest to Augsburg during 2005-06 and to Gustavus Adolphus

in 2007-08. St. Norbert has tied St. Thomas twice and Augsburg once, those coming in the 1999-2000 and 2000-01 seasons.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 34-2-1 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3, 2007.

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert is currently 28-0-4 since a 4-2 loss to Gustavus Adolphus last Nov. 3. The 32-game unbeaten streak is a school record.

The Green Knights' 32-game unbeaten streak is the secondlongest in Division III history. Massachusetts-Dartmouth holds the Division III record at 38 games from Jan. 16, 1985 to March 2, 1986.

In addition to the current streak, St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 12 unbeaten streaks in Division III NCAA history. Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 39-2-4 overall and are 22-0-4 against NCHA opponents.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 123 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1. The Green Knights are 51-10-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 123-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 38 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season. St. Norbert is 71-26-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert has been able to fashion its 32-game unbeaten streak thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

The Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games last season.

In the prior four seasons combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 45-41 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, 2008, the first time in school history that has occurred.
