Weekend Overview:

St. Norbert takes a brief respite from NCHA play when it faces Oswego State and Lawrence in the St. Norbert Thanksgiving Tournament. The game against St. Norbert and Oswego State features the last two NCAA Division III national champions.

Broadcast:

The Series:

Oswego State leads St. Norbert in the all-time series 1-0. The Lakers topped the Green Knights 4-3 in overtime in a NCAA Division III Frozen Four semifinal on March 17, 2007 at Wessman Arena in Superior.

St. Norbert holds a 27-0 lead in the series with Lawrence. The two schools met four times a season from 1988-89 to Tim Coghlin's first year in 1993-94, and have met three times since the 1994-95 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 330-93-35 in his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 186-24-18 in the last seven seasons.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek (Oswego State, 1983) is 102-33-14 in his sixth season in Oswego.

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert, 2000) is 26-33-5 in his third season in Appleton.

Last Meetings:

Oswego State topped St. Norbert 4-3 in overtime in a NCAA Tournament national semifinal on March 17, 2007 in Superior. Ryan Woodward's goal 3:51 into overtime was the difference. Tyler Lyon added a pair of goals for the Lakers. Ryan Petersen is the only current Green Knight to score a goal in that game. Ryan Scott made 26 saves for Oswego, while Kyle Jones made 25 stops for St. Norbert.

St. Norbert beat Lawrence 8-1 in the 2008-09 season opener on Oct. 28 in Appleton. Alain Joanette scored a natural hat trick in his first collegiate game, while A.J. Gale added two goals. Masa Takahashi scored the lone marker for the Vikings. Evan Johnson made 42 saves for the Vikings, while Blake Bashor made eight saves and B.J. O'Brien 12 for the Green Knights.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert had school-record 37-game unbeaten and 16-game winning streaks come to an end this past Saturday with a 4-3 loss at UW-Superior. The Green Knights enter the weekend at 8-1 overall and are 3-1 in the NCHA.

The Green Knights are averaging 4.7 goals per game. Junior forward A.J. Gale has six goals and five assists for 11 points, while junior forward Shane Wheeler has five goals and five assists for 10 points. Freshman forward Alain Joanette and senior forward Ryan Petersen each have four goals and five assists for nine points. Sophomore forward Brandon Longley has taken over the team lead in goals with seven

after scoring four in two games this past weekend.

Sophomore Blake Bashor is 4-0 this season with a 1.34 goals against average and .943 save percentage, and made 31 saves to post his first collegiate shutout. Sophomore B.J. O'Brien is 4-1 with a 2.90 GAA and a .900 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 17-for-56 (30.4 percent) on the power play and is 50-for-58 (86.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Lakers:

Oswego State enters the tournament with a 6-2-1 overall record, and is 4-1-1 in the SUNYAC. The Lakers beat Brockport State 11-3 this past Friday before losing to Geneseo State 4-2 on Saturday.

Senior forward Ryan Ellis has eight goals and seven assists for 15 points, while senior forward Brendan McLaughlin has five goals and 10 assists for 15 points. Freshman forward Eric Selleck has eight goals and six assists for 14 points, and senior forward Matt Whitehead has four goals and six assists for 10 points. Overall, the Lakers are scoring 5.2 goals per game while allowing 3.1 goals per game.

Freshman goaltender Paul Beckwith is 4-1 with a 2.57 goals against average and .865 save percentage, while senior Chris Hyk has a 2-1-1 mark with a 3.41 GAA and .891 save percentage.

Oswego's power play is 11-for-57 (19.3 percent) and its penalty kill is 39-for-50 (78.0 percent).

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the weekend at 3-5 overall and is 3-3 in the MCHA. The Vikings had three consecutive shutouts heading into Tuesday's 5-1 loss at Lake Forest, topping MSOE 1-0 on Nov. 15 and sweeping Minnesota-Crookston 5-0 and 8-0 this past weekend.

Senior forward Nick Jennette leads the Vikings in scoring with three goals and five assists for eight points. Junior forward Marc Howe has four goals and two assists for six points, while freshman forward Matt Hughes has two goals and three assists for five points. The Vikings are scoring 2.4 goals per game while allowing 3.4 goals per game.

Sophomore goaltender Evan Johnson has seen most of the action in net for Lawrence, posing a 3-3 record with a 2.47 goals against average and .919 save percentage.

Lawrence's power play is 8-for-52 (15.4 percent), while its penalty kill is 45-for-53 (84.9 percent).

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 21-14-4 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights have played at least one weekend a season against eastern foes for the past 14 years.

The Green Knights are 8-2-1 alltime against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 alltime against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 2-2 against the ECAC East, going 1-2 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 98-4-4 in its last 106 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last seven-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 111-7-6 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 120-11-7 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 199-33-13 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

St. Norbert has a 19-game unbeaten streak at the Cornerstone, going 17-0-2 during that stretch. The Green Knights are 35-1-2 in their last 38 games at the Cornerstone, the lone setback a 4-2 loss to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3, 2007

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert had its 37-game unbeaten streak snapped with a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The long skein of games without a loss was the longest in any division of NCAA hockey since 1986 and the only streak in the top nine all-time since 1996.

St. Norbert's unbeaten streak is impressive considering the level of competition in the Northern

The Green Knights' 37-game unbeaten streak is the second-longest in Division III history. Massachusetts-Dartmouth holds the Division III record at 38 games from Jan. 16, 1985 to March 2, 1986.

St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 13 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history. Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19-game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-2 over that 31-game stretch.

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 44-3-4 overall and are 25-1-4 against NCHA opponents.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 211 games when scoring five goals or more with a 206-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-17-4 in its last 26 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 11 times in their last 217 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41 games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 126 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1 before falling to No. 3 this week. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 126-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 40 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season and is 2-1-0 against them this season. St. Norbert is 73-27-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert was able to fashion its 37-game unbeaten streak thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

St. Norbert had a 10-game winning streak in one-goal games snapped in a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The Green Knights were 8-0 in one-goal games in 2007-08 and are 2-1 in one-goal games this season.

In the prior four seasons (2003-04 to 2006-07) combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 47-42 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, 2008, the first time in school history that has occurred.
