St. Norbert wraps up the first half of the regular season with a pair of NCHA road games at UW-Stout and UW-River Falls. The Green Knights will then have a 26-day break between games.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stout 28-6-4. The Green Knights are 26-1-3 in the last 30 games with the Blue Devils.

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-River Falls 26-16-2. The Green Knights are 22-4-1 against River Falls in their last 26 meetings. The Green Knights are 9-11-1 all-time at Hunt Arena, the only NCHA venue they are not at least .500 in.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 331-94-35 in his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 187-25-18 in the last seven seasons.

UW-Stout coach Terry Watkins (UW-Stout, 1972) is 147-175-18 in his 13th season in Menomonie.

UW-River Falls coach Steve Freeman (UW-Stevens Point, 1981) is 238-104-26 in his 13th season in River Falls.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert topped UW-Stout 4-3 last March 8 for the NCHA Peters Cup championship at the Cornerstone Community Center. Marc Belanger's goal at 17:03 of overtime ended an epic battle. Stout held a 3-2 lead until Brad Herman scored at 6:51 of the third period tied the game. Kyle Jones made 31 saves for St. Norbert, while Mike Stone had 35 stops for the Blue Devils.

St. Norbert beat UW-River Falls 4-1 last Feb. 8 on "white-out" night in front of a capacity crowd at Hunt Arena. Steven Sleep's first period goal held up until the third period, when the Green Knights scored three times to pull away. St. Norbert outshot River Falls 32-16. Kyle Jones made 15 saves for St. Norbert, while Stephen Ritter had 28 stops for the Falcons.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert split a pair of games at its own Thanksgiving tournament at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights fell to Oswego State 4-3 last Friday before topping Lawrence 4-0 on Saturday.

Junior forward A.J. Gale scored three goals on the weekend to boost his team-high total to nine. Along with six assists, Gale also has a team-high 15 points. Freshman forward Alain Joanette and Shane Wheeler each have five goals and six assists for 11 points. Sophomore defenseman Nick Tabisz has three goals and eight assists for 11 points. Senior forward Ryan Petersen is also in double digits, scoring four goals and six assists for 10 points. Sophomore goaltender Blake Bashor is 4-1 overall with a 1.83 goals against average and .922 save percentage. Sophomore B.J. O'Brien is 5-1 with a 2.37 goals against average and .911 save percentage.

The Green Knights are scoring 4.45 goals per game while allowing 2.09 goals per game. St. Norbert is 19-for-67 (28.4 percent) on the power play and is 60-for-69 (87.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Blue Devils:

UW-Stout, which was idle this past weekend, enters the weekend with a 7-4 overall record and a 2-2 mark in the NCHA. The Blue Devils beat UW-Stevens Point 4-3 on Nov. 21 and UW-Eau Claire 2-0 on Nov. 22 in their most recent action.

Junior forward Derek Hanson has 10 goals and seven assists for 17 points, while senior defenseman Nick Klaren has six goals and 11 assists for 17 points. Junior forward Scott Motz has five goals and eight assists for 13 points, while senior forward Jeff Wheeler has three goals and nine assists for 12 points.

Senior goaltender Matt Koenig has seen most of the action between the pipes. Koenig is 5-3 with a 2.79 goals against average and .908 save percentage.

Stout is averaging 4.09 goals per game while allowing 3.09 goals per game. The Blue Devils are 14-for-64 (21.9 percent) on the power play and are 52-for-68 (76.5 percent) on the penalty kill

About the Falcons:

UW-River Falls enters Friday's game with Lake Forest at 2-6-1 overall and 1-3 in the NCHA. The Falcons topped Marian 5-4 in overtime last Tuesday, and beat St. Scholastica 6-3 on Nov. 14 for their two wins this season.

Junior forward Tyler Czuba leads River Falls in scoring with six goals and four assists for 10 points. Sophomore forward Jamie Ruff has two goals and six assists for eight points, while senior forward Derek Hansberry has five goals and one assist for six points. Three of Hansberry's markers have come on the power play.

Junior goaltender Stephen Ritter is 2-3-1 with a 3.81 goals against average and .878 save percentage. Freshman Bo Storozuk is 0-3 with a 3.37 goals against average and .874 save percentage.

River Falls is averaging 2.67 goals per game while allowing 4.00 goals per game. The Falcons are 6-for-49 (12.2 percent) on the power play and are 47-for-58 (81.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Four Factor:

When St. Norbert's opponent has scored exactly four goals in recent history, it has usually spelled doom for the Green Knights.

In St. Norbert's last 92 games, opponents have scored exactly four goals six times. The Green Knights are 1-5 in those games.

St. Norbert's last four losses have all come when its opponent found twine four times. Oswego State owns two of those victories - in the 2007 Frozen Four and on Nov. 28, 2008 at St. Norbert - both 4-3 scores. UW-Superior topped the Green Knights 4-3 this season on Nov. 22, while Gustavus Adolphus handed St. Norbert its only loss in 2007-08 by a 4-2 score. Lake Forest also beat St. Norbert 4-2 on Feb. 11, 2006.

The Green Knights lone win recently in the situation came in a stirring 5-4 overtime win over Hobart in the 2006 Frozen Four.

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert had its 37-game unbeaten streak snapped with a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The long skein of games without a loss was the longest in any division of NCAA hockey since 1986 and the only streak in the top nine all-time since 1996.

St. Norbert's unbeaten streak is impressive considering the level of competition in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association, playing at least 18 games annually against league foes.

The Green Knights' 37-game unbeaten streak is the secondlongest in Division III history. Massachusetts-Dartmouth holds the Division III record at 38 games from Jan. 16, 1985 to March 2, 1986.

St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 13 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history. Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-2 over that 31-game stretch.

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 45-4-4 overall and are 25-1-4 against NCHA opponents.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 211 games when scoring five goals or more with a 206-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-17-4 in its last 26 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 11 times in their last 219 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41 games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 127 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1 before falling to No. 3 on Nov. 24. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 127-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 40 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season and is 2-2-0 against them this season. St. Norbert is 73-28-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert was able to fashion its 37-game unbeaten streak thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie. St. Norbert had a 10-game winning streak in one-goal games snapped in a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The Green Knights were 8-0 in one-goal games in 2007-08 but are 2-2 in one-goal games this season.

In the prior four seasons (2003-04 to 2006-07) combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 47-43 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, 2008, the first time in school history that has occurred.

Ice Chips:

* - Freshman forward Alain Joanette has scored in eight of the nine games he has skated in this season, getting blanked in a 3-0 win over St. Scholastica on Nov. 21.

* - Sophomore forward Scott Pulak has scored assists in each of his last three games.

* - Sophomore forward Brandon Longley's first point of the season was an assist in a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31. SInce then, Longley's last eight points have all been goals.

* - Junior forward A.J. Gale has scored goals in his last three games, while sophomore defenseman Nick Tabisz has tallied markers in each of his last two games.

* - Senior forward Steven Sleep has skated in 96 consecutive games, not missing a game since Nov. 25, 2005. In all, Sleep has appeared in 105 of a possible 106 career games. The NCAA Division III record for consecutive games played by a skater is 109, set by Bethel's Garrett Strot from 1984 to 1987.

* - St. Norbert has not lost consecutive NCHA road games since losing to UW-River Falls and St. Scholastica during the 2006-07 season.
