his 16th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 190-26-18 in the last seven seasons.

St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek (St. Mary's, 1970) is 394-177-40 in his 22nd season in St. Paul.

St. Mary's coach Bill Moore (St. Mary's, 1985) is 1-8-1 in his first season in Winona.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert topped St. Thomas 2in overtime last March 15 in an epic NCAA Division III Tournament game in front of 2,010 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Ryan Petersen's goal at 8:28 of overtime was the game-winner. Mike Bernardy scored at 7:01 of the first period for St. Norbert, while Nick Pernula scored 22 seconds into the second period for the Tommies. Kyle Jones made 21 saves for the Green Knights, while Tyler Chestnut had 35 saves for the Tommies.

Matt Boyd's overtime game-winner lifted St. Norbert to a 3-2 win over St. Mary's last Jan. 11 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Boyd and Marc Belanger gave St. Norbert a 2-0 lead before the Cardinals scored a pair of thirdperiod goals to draw even. Blake Bashor made eight saves for the Green Knights, while Dan Smith made 31 saves for St. Mary's.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved to 12-3 overall with a non-conference sweep of Milwaukee School of Engineering in a home-and-home series this past weekend. The Green Knights won 3-0 in Green Bay and 7-2 in Milwaukee.

Junior forward A.J. Gale posted his first collegiate hat trick against MSOE on Saturday, and now has a team-high 13 goals and 22 points this season. Junior forward Shane Wheeler has seven goals and nine assists for 16 points, while sophomore defenseman Nick Tabisz has five goals with a team-high 11 assists for 16 points. Freshman forward Alain Joanette and senior forward Ryan Petersen both have five goals and seven assists for 12 points.

Sophomore goaltender B.J. O'Brien is 7-1 overall with a 2.22 goals against average and .916 save percentage. Sophomore Blake Bashor is 5-2 with a 2.19 goals against average and .904 save percentage.

The Green Knights are scoring 4.33 goals per game while allowing 2.20 goals per game. St. Norbert is 24-for-89 (27.0 percent) on the power play and is 80-for-90 (88.9 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Tommies:

St. Thomas enters the weekend with a 4-5-2 overall record but a 3-0-1 mark in the MIAC. The Tommies dropped a 4-2 decision at UW-River Falls this past Saturday. St. Thomas is 1-3-1 in its last five games, beating St. John's 7-3 on Dec. 5 for its only win since Thanksgiving.

Sophomore forward Rob Johnson leads the Tommies in scoring with nine goals and six assists for 15 points. Senior defenseman Adam Davis has fouf goals and six assists for 10 points, while senior forward Tom Knutson has two goals and eight assists for 10 points. Only three Tommy skaters have reached double-digits in points thus far.

Junior goaltender Tyler Chestnut has seen most of the action for the Tommies in net, going 2-4-1 with a 3.47 goals against average and .853 save percentage. Sophomore Sean Deichert is 2-1-1 with a 3.10 goals against average and .868 save percentage.

St. Thomas is averaging 3.09 goals per game while allowing 3.55 goals per game. The Tommies are 13-for-63 (20.6 percent) on the power play and are 46-for-57 (80.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Cardinals:

St. Mary's enters Friday's game at Lake Forest with a 1-8-1 overall record and a 1-4-1 mark in the MIAC. The Cardinals have been idle since Dec. 6, when they last 7-6 in overtime at Hamline. St. Mary's lone win came on Nov. 21 when it beat Concordia-Moorhead 6-5 in overtime in Winona. Junior forward Anthony Bohn leads the Cardinals in scoring with one goal and nine assists for 10 points. Junior forward Steve Murphy has five goals and three assists for eight points, while sophomore forward Mike Glaesmer has four goals and four assists for eight points.

Junior goaltender Greg Moore and freshman Scott Pederson have split the netminding duties thus far. Moore is 0-3-1 with a 5.51 goals against average and .871 save percentage, while Pederson is 1-5 with a 5.38 goals against average and .880 save percentage.

St. Mary's is averaging 2.30 goals per game while allowing 5.60 goals per game. The Cardinals are 10-for-62 (16.1 percent) on the power play and are 57-for-76 (75.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 66-7-3 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 66-5-3 against the MIAC. The losses came in a 4-3 decision at St. John's on Nov. 24, 2000 and a pair of losses to St. Thomas in the 2004-05 season. The Green Knights also dropped a 7-4 contest to Augsburg during 2005-06 and to Gustavus Adolphus in 2007-08. St. Norbert has tied St. Thomas twice and Augsburg once, those coming in the 1999-2000 and 2000-01 seasons.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 36-2-1 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

Not Asleep:

Senior forward Steven Sleep has skated in 100 consecutive games, not missing a game since Nov. 25, 2005 at UW-Stevens Point. In all, Sleep has appeared in 109 of a possible 110 career games.

The NCAA Division III record for consecutive games played by a skater is 109, set by Bethel's Garrett Strot from 1984 to 1987. Barring an injury or disqualification, Sleep would pass Strot for the record on Feb. 14 at Lake Forest.

Fourteen St. Norbert skaters have played in at least 110 career games. Rob Smillie (1996-99), Shane Dickson (1998-2001) and Jason Deitsch (2002-05) all share the school record for total games played with 122.

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert had its 37-game unbeaten streak snapped with a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The long skein of games without a loss was the longest in any division of NCAA hockey since 1986 and the only streak in the top nine all-time since 1996.

St. Norbert's unbeaten streak is impressive considering the level of competition in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association,

The Green Knights' 37-game unbeaten streak is the secondlongest in Division III history. Massachusetts-Dartmouth holds the Division III record at 38 games from Jan. 16, 1985 to March 2, 1986.

St. Norbert has had two 19-game unbeaten streaks in its history, and fashioned a 26-game skein during the 2004-05 season. With its collection of unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games, St. Norbert now has four of the top 13 unbeaten streaks in NCAA Division III history. Middlebury is the only other Division III school which has at least two unbeaten streaks of at least 19 games.

St. Norbert's best ever stretch of hockey came at the end of the 2002-03 season into the 2003-04 season. The Green Knights carried a 19game unbeaten streak (17-0-2) into the 2003 Frozen Four before losing to Norwich in a national semifinal. St. Norbert then opened the 2003-04 season 11-0-1. St. Norbert was 28-1-2 over that 31-game stretch.

Dating back to a 2-1 loss to UW-Stout at the Resch Center on Jan. 27, 2007, the Green Knights are an impressive 48-5-4 overall and are 26-2-4 against NCHA opponents.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 212 games when scoring five goals or more with a 207-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed

five goals just 12 times in their last 223 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41 games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 130 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1 before falling to No. 3 on Nov. 24. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 130-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 40 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 9-0-1 against ranked foes last season and is 2-3-0 against them this season. St. Norbert is 73-29-11 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert was able to fashion its 37-game unbeaten streak thanks to pulling out several close games, or at least forging a tie.

St. Norbert had a 10-game winning streak in one-goal games snapped in a 4-3 loss to UW-Superior on Nov. 22. The Green Knights were 8-0 in one-goal games in 2007-08 but are 3-2 in one-goal games this season.

In the prior four seasons (2003-04 to 2006-07) combined, St. Norbert had been just 12-10 in one-goal games. The Green Knights were 4-4 in 2006-07, 2-2 in 2005-06, 4-2 in 2004-05 and 2-2 in 2003-04. St. Norbert was 4-0 in 2002-03 for its best season in one-goal games prior to 2004-05.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 48-43 in one-goal games. The Green Knights' had three consecutive one-goal wins from March 1-15, 2008, the first time in school history that has occurred.
