Game Overview:

St. Norbert looks to claim its eighth NCHA Peters Cup championship when it faces UW-River Falls on Saturday at the Cornerstone Community Center. UW-River Falls has not won the NCHA post-season championship since 1996.

St. Norbert coverage is on the WSNC radio Webcast with Tim Derozier on the call. The Webcast is available at http://www.snc.edu/athletics/hockey/webcast.htm.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-River Falls 31-16-2. The Green Knights are 27-4-1 against River Falls in their last 32 meetings. St. Norbert is 16-0 against the Falcons at home during that stretch. River Falls is 1-17 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, and is 0-14 all-time there against St. Norbert.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 361-103-39 in his 17th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 217-34-22 in the last eight-plus seasons. Coghlin's 351 wins as a coach in the NCHA is 19 short of Bemidji State's Bob Peters' record of 370.

UW-River Falls coach Steve Freeman (UW-Stevens Point, 1981) is 264-121-29 in his 14th season in River Falls.

This Year:

St. Norbert swept the three-game regular-season series with UW-River Falls by scores of 4-2 and 8-3 on Nov. 20-21 in River Falls and by a 4-0 score on Feb. 13 in Green Bay. The eight goals allowed by River Falls was the most it had given up in a game at Hunt Arena since 1997. Nick Tabisz and Shane Wheeler each scored three goals during the two-game series at River Falls for St. Norbert. B.J. O'Brien made 20 and 22 saves, respectively.

In the game at the Cornerstone Community Center, St. Norbert scored two goals by Tyler Allen and Johan Ryd in the first period to take the lead. B.J. O'Brien made 23 saves for the Green Knights.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Peters Cup Championship game at 20-3-3 overall and ranked No. 3 in this week's USCHO.com NCAA Division III Poll. The Green Knights topped UW-Stevens Point in a penaltymarred 7-1 game in a Peters Cup semifinal game last Saturday at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Senior forward Shane Wheeler holds the team scoring lead with 11 goals and 16 assists for 27 points. Senior forward Tyler Allen has the team lead in goals with 13 and has 12 assists for 25 points. Senior forward Matt Boyd has seven goals and 18 assists for 25 points, while sophomore forward Johan Ryd has 10 goals and 14 assists for 24 points. Freshman forward Cody Keefer has also reached double digits in goals with 11, and has 11 assists for 22 total points.

Junior goaltender B.J. O'Brien has continued a stellar season, and owns a 20-2-3 record with a 1.57 goals against average and .926 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 31-for-155 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 87-for-104 (83.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Falcons:

UW-River Falls enters the Peters Cup title matchup with an 18-8-2 overall record. The Falcons, who finished third in the NCHA regular season, have won seven of their last eight games with the only loss a 4-0 defeat to St. Norbert on Feb. 13. River Falls beat St. Scholastica 6-3 last Saturday to win its NCHA Peters Cup semifinal game.

Senior forward Tyler Czuba leads the Falcons in scoring with 18 goals and 20 assists for 38 points. Junior forward Josh Calleja has eight goals and 29 assists for 37 points, while sophomore forward Justin Brossman has 10 goals and 24 assists for 34 points. Sophomore forward Ben Beaudoin has 13 goals and 10 assists for 23 points.

Sophomore goaltender Bo Storozuk is 15-7-1 with a 2.64 goals against average and .913 save percentage. Sophomore Eric Babcook is 3-1-1 with a 3.27 goals against average and .890 save percentage.

River Falls is 25-for-129 (19.4 percent) on the power play and is 115-for-139 (82.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

Power Play Points:

St. Norbert had 15 power-play opportunities, scoring four times, in Saturday's 7-1 win over UW-Stevens Point. It was the most man advantages the Green Knights have had in one game in 14 years.

The Green Knights last had 15 power-play chances in an 11-1 win over Stevens Point on Jan. 27, 1996 at the De Pere Ice Center. In that game, the Green Knights scored eight power-play goals overall and had five power-play goals in a 3-minute 45-second stretch in the third period to take an 11-0 lead with 8:36 left. The eight power-play

goals scored in that game is still an NCAA Division III record.

Since that game, St. Norbert had five games where it had 13 power-play opportunities. Most recently, the Green Knights were 4-for-13 on the power play in a 6-0 win over UW-Eau Claire on Feb. 3, 2006.

Twenty Talk:

St. Norbert's 7-1 win over UW-Stevens Point last Saturday marked the 12th time in 14 years the Green Knights have won at least 20 games in a season.

The Green Knights' first 20-win season came in a 21-9-1 campaign in 1996-97. The only two seasons since then where St. Norbert hasn't won at least 20 games were near-miss years of 18-8-3 in 2000-01 and 19-8-1 in 2008-09.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert has continued its long-standing tradition this season of being tough to beat when leading after two periods. The Green Knights are 17-0-1 this year when leading after the first 40 minutes of action.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 196-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009.

At home, St. Norbert is 214-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

Peters Cup Patter:

Since the 1996-97 season, St.

Norbert has played just two NCHA Peters Cup Playoff series/rounds on the road. The Green Knights, after a third-place finish in the NCHA in 2000-01, played at UW-River Falls in the semifinal round and were eliminated 1-0 in an overtime minigame. St. Norbert's 3-0 loss at UW-Superior in the NCHA Semifinals in 2009 was just the second round of action the Green Knights have had to play on the road in Peters Cup Playoff play in 13 years.

St. Norbert finished second in 1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game by UW-Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

Including Saturday's game with UW-River Falls, St. Norbert has played 35 of the last 37 NCHA Peters Cup Playoff rounds it has played in on home ice. The Green Knights are 47-12-1 all-time in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs, and are 46-7 at home all-time in the Peters Cup tournament. St. Norbert has played only away series against UW-River Falls (twice) and UW-Stevens Point and UW-Superior on the all-time in Peters Cup play going 1-5-1 in those games.

Wheeler Whims:

Senior forward Shane Wheeler leads St. Norbert in scoring this season with 27 points. Wheeler's 11 goals is tied for second on the squad with Cody Keefer behind Tyler Allen's 13.

Wheeler has scored 110 points in 110 career games, scoring 37 goals and 73 assists. He is currently ninth all-time in career assists at St. Norbert, one behind Ryan Tew's 74.

Wheeler, the 16th skater in St. Norbert history to reach 100 career points, had seven goals and 12 assists in 18 NCHA games.

Boyd Bullets:

Senior forward Matt Boyd is tenth in St. Norbert career scoring entering the 2009-10 post-season.

Boyd, who had two assists against UW-Stevens Point in a

Peters Cup semifinal, has 39 goals and 81 assists for 120 points in 107 games. Boyd is one point out of ninth place in St. Norbert scoring annals, which is Rob Garofolo's 121 points.

Boyd has 81 career assists, which places him fourth all-time at St. Norbert. Adam Sedgwick is third with 89 career helpers.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert has had a remarkably low number of one-goal games during the 2009-10 season with a scant total of three.

The Green Knights are 2-1 in one-goal games this season. St. Norbert topped Lawrence 2-1 on Nov. 27 and UW-Eau Claire 3-2 on Jan. 15 while losing to St. Scholastica 4-3 in overtime on Dec. 4.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games last season, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season of 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 53-48 in one-goal games.

St. Norbert is 6-0 this season in games decided by two goals, and is 12-2 in games decided by at least three goals.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 115-8-6 in its last 129 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 128-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 137-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 216-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 155 consecutive weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2009-10 season at No. 11 before rising to No. 1 on Nov. 9, and remained there for three weeks. The Green Knights are 61-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 155-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 43 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1

in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but is now 6-1-1 against ranked teams this season - going 3-0 against UW-River Falls, 2-0 against UW-Stout and 1-1-1 with St. Scholastica this year. St. Norbert is 81-34-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 2-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 224

games when scoring five goals or more with a 219-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996

St. Norbert is 5-19-4 in its last 28 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 13 times in their last 258 games.
