Game Overview:

St. Norbert returns to the NCAA Division III Tournament for the first time since winning the 2008 national championship when it hosts Adrian on Wednesday in a first-round game.

The Series:

St. Norbert and Adrian have never met in men's ice hockey.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 362-103-39 in his 17th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 218-34-22 in the last eight-plus seasons. Coghlin's 352 wins as a coach in the NCHA is 18 short of Bemidji State's Bob Peters' record of 370.

Adrian coach Ron Fogarty (Colgate, 1995) is 77-7-1 in his third season in Adrian.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 11th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in the last 14 years. The Green Knights are 12-9-1 all-time in NCAA competition. St. Norbert won its first national championship in 2008, beating St. Thomas, Norwich and Plattsburgh State by a combined 7-1 score in the NCAA Tournament.

The Green Knights broke through to their first Frozen Four in 2003 with a quarterfinal win over UW-River Falls before losing to Norwich in the semifinals. In 2004, St. Norbert beat River Falls in the quarterfinals and Plattsburgh State in the semifinals before losing in overtime to Middlebury 1-0 in the national championship game. In 2006, St. Norbert beat UW-Superior in the quarterfinals and Hobart in the semifinals before losing to Middlebury 3-0 in the national title game. St. Norbert lost 4-3 in overtime to Oswego State in a 2007 national semifinal.

Adrian is making its first NCAA Division III Tournament appearance.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Tournament at 21-3-3 overall and ranked No. 3 in the final USCHO.com NCAA Division III Poll for 2010. The Green Knights topped UW-River Falls 7-1 in the Peters Cup championship game last Saturday at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Senior forward Shane Wheeler holds the team scoring lead with 12 goals and 16 assists for 28 points. Senior forward Tyler Allen has the team lead in goals with 13 and has 14 assists for 27 points. Senior forward Matt Boyd has eight goals and 19 assists for 27 points, while sophomore forward Johan Ryd has 10 goals and 15 assists for 25 points. Junior defenseman Nick Tabisz has eight goals and 16 assists for 24 points. Junior goaltender B.J. O'Brien has continued a stellar season, and owns a 21-2-3 record with a 1.55 goals against average and .927 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 33-for-163 (20.2 percent) on the power play and is 93for-110 (84.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters the NCAA Division III Tournament with a 24-3 overall record. The Bulldogs swept through the Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association with a 20-0 regular-season record and rallied with two third-period goals to claim the Harris Cup with a 3-2 win over Marian on Saturday.

Junior forward Mike Dahlinger leads the Bulldogs in scoring with 12 goals and 40 assists for 52 points. Freshman forward Zach Graham has 16 goals and 29 assists for 45 points. Junior forward Shawn Skelly has 21 goals and 21 assists for 42 points, while junior forward Sam Kuzyk has 20 goals and 22 assists for 42 points with 10 power-play markers. Junior forward Brad Houston has 20 goals and 20 assists for 40 points. Junior defenseman Chris Stansik has seven goals and 30 assists for 37 points.

Junior goaltender Brad Fogal sees most of the action in net, posting a 23-3 record with a 2.28 goals against average and .916 save percentage. Fogal's 68 career wins are 19 short of St. Norbert's Kyle Jones' NCAA Division III record of 87.

Adrian is 45-for-151 (29.8 percent) on the power play and is 150-for-166 (90.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

Tundra Home Companion:

St. Norbert has always enjoyed its strong home-ice advantage at the Cornerstone Community Center, but especially so this year.

The Green Knights, who are 12-1-1 at home this year, have been dominant at the Cornerstone in the last month of the year. In its last five home games, all against NCHA foes, St. Norbert has outscored its opponents 32-4 - including 14-2 in the Peters Cup Playoffs.

Overall, St. Norbert is averaging 5.6 goals per game at home this season. The Green Knights' power play is 27-for-97 (27.8 percent) at home. Opponents are scoring just 1.6 goals per game this year at the Cornerstone and are just 8-for-60 (13.3 percent) on the power play.

Shane Wheeler (8-11-19) and Matt Boyd (5-14-19) are St. Norbert's leading point scorers at home. Cody Keefer (10-8-18), Tyler Allen (9-9-18) and Brandon Longley (7-11-18) all have 18 points.

St. Norbert owns a 78-22 scoring edge in the 14 games, and has a 22-3 scoring advantage in the first period. Opposing goaltenders have an .853 save percentage in the Cornerstone this year.

Power Play Points:

In two post-season games this season, St. Norbert has drawn 23 power-play opportunities. The Green Knights have converted six times for a 26.1 percentage.

St. Norbert had 15 power-play opportunities, scoring four times, in Feb. 26th's 7-1 win over UW-Stevens Point. It was the most man advantages the Green Knights have had in one game in 14 years.

The Green Knights last had 15 power-play chances in an 11-1 win over Stevens Point on Jan. 27, 1996 at the De Pere Ice Center. In that game, the Green Knights scored eight power-play goals overall and had five power-play goals in a 3minute 45-second stretch in the third period to take an 11-0 lead with 8:36 left. The eight power-play goals scored in that game is still an NCAA Division III record.

Since that game, St. Norbert had five games where it had 13 powerplay opportunities. Most recently, the Green Knights were 4-for-13 on the power play in a 6-0 win over UW-Eau Claire on Feb. 3, 2006.

Twenty Talk:

St. Norbert's 7-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 26 marked the 12th time in 14 years the Green Knights have won at least 20 games in a season. Last Saturday's 7-1 win over UW-River Falls marked the eighth time in nine years the Green Knights have won at least 21 games.

The Green Knights' first 20-win season came in a 21-9-1 campaign in 1996-97. The only two seasons since then where St. Norbert hasn't won at least 20 games were near-miss years of 18-8-3 in 2000-01 and 19-8-1 in 2008-09.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert has continued its long-standing tradition this season of being tough to beat when leading after two periods. The Green Knights are 18-0-1 this year when leading after the first 40 minutes of action.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 197-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten

At home, St. Norbert is 215-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

Wheeler Whims:

Senior forward Shane Wheeler leads St. Norbert in scoring this season with 28 points. Wheeler's 12 goals trails only Tyler Allen's 13.

Wheeler has scored 111 points in 111 career games, scoring 38 goals and 73 assists. He is currently ninth all-time in career assists at St. Norbert, one behind Ryan Tew's 74.

Wheeler, the 16th skater in St. Norbert history to reach 100 career points, had seven goals and 12 assists in 18 NCHA games.

Boyd Bullets:

Senior forward Matt Boyd is now ninth in St. Norbert career scoring entering the NCAA Tournament.

Boyd, one goal and one assist against UW-River Falls in the Peters Cup championship, has 40 goals and 82 assists for 122 points in 108 games. Boyd moved past Rob Garafolo's 121 career points into ninth, and trails Shane Dickson 123 points by one point for eighth alltime.

Boyd has 82 career assists, which places him fourth all-time at St. Norbert. Adam Sedgwick is third with 89 career helpers.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert has had a remarkably low number of one-goal games during the 2009-10 season with a scant total of three.

The Green Knights are 2-1 in onegoal games this season. St. Norbert topped Lawrence 2-1 on Nov. 27 and UW-Eau Claire 3-2 on Jan. 15 while losing to St. Scholastica 4-3 in overtime on Dec. 4.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games last season, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season of 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 53-48 in one-goal games.

St. Norbert is 6-0 this season in games decided by two goals, and is 12-2 in games decided by at least three goals.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 116-8-6 in its last 130 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 129-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 138-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 217-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 156 consecutive weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2009-10 season at No. 11 before rising to No. 1 on Nov. 9, and remained there for three weeks. The Green Knights are 61-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 156-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 43 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008
