Game Overview:

St. Norbert battles defending national runner-up Gustavus Adolphus with a Frozen Four berth in Lake Placid, N.Y., on the line in a NCAA Division III Quarterfinal game. The Green Knights are also going for the program's 400th all-time win.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Gustavus Adolphus in the all-time series 12-11, with the Green Knights a commanding 12-1 under Tim Coghlin. St. Norbert has outscored the Gusties 75-32 in the last 13 games. Gustavus handed St. Norbert its only loss in the 2007-08 national championship season with a 4-2 win at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights won the last meeting 7-5 on Oct. 31, 2008 at All Seasons Arena in Mankato, Minn.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 363-103-39 in his 17th season in De Pere. Coghlin owns a glossy 62-21-4 all-time post-season record. The Green Knights are 219-34-22 in the last eight-plus seasons. Coghlin's 353 wins as a coach in the NCHA is 17 short of Bemidji State's Bob Peters' record of 370.

Gustavus Adolphus coach Brett Petersen (Denver, 1992) is 133-115-18 in his tenth season in St. Peter.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 11th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in the last 14 years. The Green Knights are 13-9-1 all-time in NCAA competition. St. Norbert, which beat Adrian 4-3 in a 2010 first-round game, won its first national championship in 2008, beating St. Thomas, Norwich and Plattsburgh State by a combined 7-1 score in the NCAA Tournament.

The Green Knights broke through to their first Frozen Four in 2003 with a quarterfinal win over UW-River Falls before losing to Norwich in the semifinals. In 2004, St. Norbert beat River Falls in the quarterfinals and Plattsburgh State in the semifinals before losing in overtime to Middlebury 1-0 in the national championship game. In 2006, St. Norbert beat UW-Superior in the quarterfinals and Hobart in the semifinals before losing to Middlebury 3-0 in the national title game. St. Norbert lost 4-3 in overtime to Oswego State in a 2007 national semifinal.

Gustavus Adolphus is making its fifth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and is 3-5-2 all-time in the tournament. The Golden Gusties were the 2009 national runner-up, losing to Neumann 4-1 in the national title game. Gustavus claimed its first two NCAA Division III tournament wins last year with a 2-0 quarterfinal win over UW-Superior and a 3-2 overtime national semifinal win over UW-Stout. Gustavus also made Division III tournament trips in 1990, 1991 and 1993, falling in the

quarterfinal round of the tournament each time.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters Saturday's game at 22-3-3 overall and ranked No. 3 in the final USCHO.com NCAA Division III Poll for 2010. The Green Knights beat Adrian 4-3 in a first-round NCAA Division III Tournament game Wednesday at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights are 9-0-2 in their last 11 games, which is the longest current unbeaten streak in Division III.

Senior forward Shane Wheeler holds the team scoring lead with 12 goals and 17 assists for 29 points. Senior forward Tyler Allen has the team lead in goals with 13 and has 15 assists for 28 points. Senior forward Matt Boyd has nine goals and 19 assists for 28 points, while sophomore forward Johan Ryd has 10 goals and 16 assists for 26 points. Junior defenseman Nick Tabisz has eight goals and 16 assists for 24 points.

Junior goaltender B.J. O'Brien owns a 22-2-3 record with a 1.61 goals against average and .923 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 33-for-166 (19.9 percent) on the power play and is 95-for-113 (84.1 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Golden Gusties:

Gustavus Adolphus enters Saturday's game with a 20-6-2 overall record after topping St. Thomas 3-1 Wednesday in a first-round NCAA Tournament game in St. Peter, Minn. Following a 3-3-1 start to the year, the Gusties are 17-3-1. Gustavus' only loss in its last six games was a 2-1 overtime setback to St. Thomas in the championship game of the MIAC Tournament.

Senior forward David Martinson leads Division III in goals with 29 and also has 20 assists for 49 points. Martinson has seven power-play, two shorthanded and six game-winning goals this year. Sophomore forward Ross Ring-Jarvi has 16 goals and 24 assists for 40 points, and senior forward Patrick Dynan

has six goals and 22 assists for 28 points.

Junior goaltender Josh Swartout owns an 18-4-2 record with a 2.07 goals against average and .911 save percentage. He has three shutouts this year.

Gustavus is 31-for-153 (20.3 percent) on the power play and is 97-for-118 (82.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

Tundra Home Companion:

St. Norbert has always enjoyed its strong home-ice advantage at the Cornerstone Community Center, but especially so this year.

The Green Knights, who are 13-1-1 at home this year, have been dominant at the Cornerstone in the last month of the year. In its last six home games St. Norbert has outscored its opponents 36-7.

Overall, St. Norbert is averaging 5.5 goals per game at home this season. The Green Knights' power play is 27-for-100 (27.0 percent) at home. Opponents are scoring just 1.7 goals per game this year at the Cornerstone and are just 9-for-63 (14.2 percent) on the power play.

Shane Wheeler (8-12-20) and Matt Boyd (6-14-20) are St. Norbert's leading point scorers at home. Cody Keefer (11-8-19), Tyler Allen (9-10-19) and Brandon Longley (8-11-19) all have 19 points.

St. Norbert owns an 82-25 scoring edge in the 15 games, and has a 23-

4 scoring advantage in the first period. Opposing goaltenders have an .854 save percentage in the Cornerstone this year.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 71-8-4 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 71-6-4 against the MIAC. The losses came in a 4-3 decision at St. John's on Nov. 24, 2000 and a pair of losses to St. Thomas in the 2004-05 season. The Green Knights also dropped a 7-4 contest to Augsburg during 2005-06, to Gustavus Adolphus in 2007-08 and to St. Thomas in 2008-09. St. Norbert has tied St. Thomas twice and Augsburg and Hamline each once.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 37-2-2 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

Twenty Talk:

St. Norbert's 7-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 26 marked the 12th time in 14 years the Green Knights have won at least 20 games

in a season. Wednesday's NCAA Tournament win over Adrian marked the eighth time in nine years the Green Knights have won at least 22 games.

The Green Knights' first 20-win season came in a 21-9-1 campaign in 1996-97. The only two seasons since then where St. Norbert hasn't won at least 20 games were near-miss years of 18-8-3 in 2000-01 and 19-8-1 in 2008-09.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert has continued its long-standing tradition this season of being tough to beat when leading after two periods. The Green Knights are 19-0-1 this year when leading after the first 40 minutes of action.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 19-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009.

At home, St. Norbert is 216-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

Wheeler Whims:

Senior forward Shane Wheeler leads St. Norbert in scoring this season with 29 points. Wheeler's 12 goals trails only Tyler Allen's 13.

Wheeler has scored 112 points in 112 career games, scoring 38 goals and 74 assists. He tied for eighth all-time in career assists at St. Norbert, with Ryan Tew's 74. Andrew Derton is seventh with 75.

Wheeler, the 16th skater in St.

Norbert history to reach 100 career points, had seven goals and 12 assists in 18 NCHA games.

Boyd Bullets:

Senior forward Matt Boyd is now tied for eighth in St. Norbert career scoring entering Saturday's NCAA Tournament game with Gustavus Adolphus.

Boyd, who had one goal in Wednesday's 4-3 NCAA first-round win over Adrian, has 41 goals and 82 assists for 123 points in 109 games. Boyd is tied with Shane Dickson's 123 points for eighth all-time. The pair trail Marc Belanger's 132 career points for seventh all-time at St. Norbert.

Boyd has 82 career assists, which

places him fourth all-time at St. Norbert. Adam Sedgwick is third with 89 career helpers.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert has had a remarkably low number of one-goal games during the 2009-10 season with a scant total of four.

The Green Knights are 3-1 in one-goal games this season. St. Norbert topped Lawrence 2-1 on Nov. 27 and UW-Eau Claire 3-2 on Jan. 15 while losing to St. Scholastica 4-3 in overtime on Dec. 4. St. Norbert then beat Adrian 4-3 in a first-round NCAA Tournament game on March 10.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games last season, going 6-5 in those situa-

tions en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season of 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 54-48 in one-goal games.

St. Norbert is 6-0 this season in games decided by two goals, and is 12-2 in games decided by at least three goals.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.
