St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview NCAA DIVISION III FROZEN FOUR

Frozen Four Overview:

New York's North Country hosts the Frozen Four as four teams converge on Lake Placid to determine the 2010 NCAA Division III champion. St. Norbert is aiming for its second national title in three years, capturing the crown in Lake Placid in 2008. The final four teams are all teams ranked in the top five in the final U.S. College Hockey Online Division III Poll for 2010. All four teams have also claimed at least one national championship within the last 10 years.

Broadcast:

St. Norbert coverage is on the WSNC radio Webcast with Tim Derozier on the call. The Webcast is available at <http://www.snc.edu/athletics/hockey/webcast.htm>.

The Division III championship game will also be broadcast live by cable channel CBS College Sports Network, which is available to some satellite dish and cable subscribers.

The Series:

Oswego State leads St. Norbert in the all-time series 2-0. The Lakers topped the Green Knights 4-3 in overtime in a NCAA Division III Frozen Four semifinal on March 17, 2007 at Wessman Arena in Superior. Oswego also topped St. Norbert 4-3 on Nov. 28, 2008 at the Cornerstone Community Center in Green Bay.

Norwich leads St. Norbert 2-1 in the all-time series. The Green Knights won the last meeting with a 3-0 triumph in the 2008 NCAA national semifinals at Herb Brooks Arena. The Cadets picked up a 5-2 win at the Cornerstone Community Center on Dec. 1, 2000. Norwich also won a NCAA national semifinal game by a 6-3 score on March 21, 2003 at Kreitzberg Arena.

St. Norbert leads Plattsburgh State in the all-time series 2-0. The Green Knights topped the Cardinals 2-0 on March 23, 2008 in the NCAA Division III national championship game. St. Norbert won the other meeting 4-1 in a NCAA national semifinal on March 19, 2004 at Kreitzberg Arena in Northfield, Vt.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 364-103-39 in his 17th season in De Pere. Coghlin owns a glossy 63-21-4 all-time post-season record. The Green Knights are 220-34-22 in the last nine seasons. Coghlin's 354 wins as a coach in the NCHA is 16 short of Bemidji State's Bob Peters' record of 370. Coghlin's teams have 11 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances, 11 NCHA regular-season championships, eight NCHA Peters Cup titles, six NCAA Division III Frozen Fours and one NCAA Division III championship. He was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's 1989 national champion.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek (Oswego State, 1983) is 140-41-14 in his seventh season in Oswego. His 2007 team won the NCAA Division III championship.

Norwich coach Mike McShane (New Hampshire, 1971) is 318-90-21 in his 15th season in Northfield. In

29 years of collegiate coaching he is 562-308-52 overall. He spent six years at St. Lawrence with two NCAA Division I tournament berths and was at Providence for nine years with three NCAA tournament bids. His 2000 and 2003 teams won NCAA Division III championships.

Plattsburgh State coach Bob Emery (Boston College, 1986) is 465-145-49 in his 21st season along the shore of Lake Champlain. Emery led the Cardinals to NCAA Division III championships in 1992 and 2001.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 11th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in the last 14 years. The Green Knights are 14-9-1 all-time in NCAA competition and have made six Frozen Fours. St. Norbert, which has beaten Adrian 4-3 and Gustavus Adolphus 3-1 so far in 2010, won its first national championship in 2008, beating St. Thomas, Norwich and Plattsburgh State by a combined 7-1 score in the NCAA Tournament.

The Green Knights broke through to their first Frozen Four in 2003 with a quarterfinal win over UW-River Falls before losing to Norwich in the semifinals. In 2004, St. Norbert beat River Falls in the quarterfinals and Plattsburgh State in the semifinals before losing in overtime to Middlebury 1-0 in the national championship game. In 2006, St. Norbert beat UW-Superior in the quarterfinals and Hobart in the semifinals before losing to Middlebury 3-0 in the national title game. St. Norbert lost 4-3 in overtime to Oswego State in a 2007 national semifinal.

Oswego State is making its ninth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its fourth trip to the Frozen Four. The Lakers are 9-12 all-time in the tournament and won the national championship in 2007.

Norwich is making its 11th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its eighth trip to the Frozen Four. Norwich is 17-9-2 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. The

Cadets won national championships in 2000 and 2003.

Plattsburgh State is making its 18th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its 11th trip to the Frozen Four. The Cardinals won national championships in 1992 and 2001 and are 22-17-8 all-time in the tournament.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Frozen Four at 23-3-3 overall and ranked No. 3 in the final USCHO.com NCAA Division III Poll for 2010. The Green Knights beat Gustavus Adolphus 3-1 in a Division III Tournament quarterfinal-round game Saturday at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights are 10-0-2 in their last 12 games, which is the longest current unbeaten streak in Division III.

Senior forward Shane Wheeler holds the team scoring lead with 13 goals and 18 assists for 31 points. Senior forward Tyler Allen has the team lead in goals with 14 and has 16 assists for 30 points. Senior forward Matt Boyd has nine goals and 19 assists for 28 points, while sophomore forward Johan Ryd has 10 goals and 16 assists for 26 points. Junior defenseman Nick Tabisz has eight goals and 16 assists for 24 points, and freshman forward Cody Keefe has 12 goals and 12 assists for 24 assists.

Junior goaltender B.J. O'Brien owns a 23-2-3 record with a 1.58 goals against average and .924 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 33-for-167 (19.8 percent) on the power play and is 95-for-114 (84.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Lakers:

Oswego State enters the Frozen Four with a 26-2 overall record and ranked No. 2 in the final USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Lakers, won won the SUNYAC at 15-1, topped Bowdoin 9-2 in a national quarterfinal on Saturday. Oswego's two losses this season came 2-1 at Elmira on Oct. 24 and 3-1 at Geneseo State on Feb. 20.

Sophomore forward Eric Selleck leads the Lakers in scoring with 21 goals and 32 assists for 53 assists. Junior forward Chris Laganieri has 16 goals and 29 assists for 45 points, and junior forward Justin Fox has 13 goals and 32 assists for 45 points. Freshman forward Jon Whitelaw has 11 goals and 26 assists for 37 points. Senior forward Neil Musselwhite leads the team in goals with 22 and has 13 assists for 35 points.

Senior goaltender Kyle Gunn-Taylor has seen most of the action this season in net, posting an 18-1 record with a 2.00 goals against average and .918 save percentage.

Sophomore Paul Beckwith is 8-1 with a 1.90 goals against average and .928 save percentage.

Oswego is 41-for-164 (25.0 percent) on the power play and is 138-for-159 (86.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Cadets:

Norwich enters the Frozen Four at 24-1-4 overall. The Cadets, who were ranked No. 1 in the final USCHO.com Poll, topped Elmira 2-1 in overtime in a national quarterfinal this past Saturday to advance. Norwich's lone loss came 2-1 to Williams on Feb. 6.

Freshman forward Blake Forkey has 15 goals and 22 assists for 37 points, while junior forward Chad Anderson has 12 goals and 24 assists for 36 points. Freshman forward Kyle Thomas has a team-high 23 goals with eight assists for 31 points.

Norwich owns the nation's top scoring defense at 1.38 goals per game. Senior netminder Ryan Klingensmith has a 22-1-3 record with a 1.31 goals against average and .930 save percentage.

Norwich is 24-for-118 (20.3 percent) on the power play and is 107-for-123 (87.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Cardinals:

Plattsburgh State enters the Frozen Four with a 19-5-4 record. The Cardinals, who were the runner-up in the SUNYAC at 13-2-1, topped Middlebury 3-2 in overtime Saturday to advance to the Frozen Four.

Junior forward Dylan Clarke leads the Cardinals with 12 goals and 17 assists for 29 points. Junior forward Eric Satim has 11 goals and 15 assists for 26 points, while sophomore forward Kyle Kurdoch has 14 goals and eight assists for 22 points. Senior forward Andrew Willock has six goals and 16 assists for 22 points. Junior forward Dan Sliasis has 10 goals - eight coming on the power play - with nine assists for 19 points.

A pair of freshmen goaltenders have split time this year for the

Cardinals. Josh Leis is 9-3-3 with a 1.71 goals against average and .930 save percentage, while Ryan Williams is 10-2-1 with a 2.16 goals against average and .905 save percentage.

Plattsburgh is 42-for-172 (24.4 percent) on the power play and is 95-for-110 (86.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 21-16-4 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights have played at least one weekend a season against an eastern foe for the past 15 years.

St. Norbert is 13-7-3 all-time on East Region ice. The Green Knights are 9-5-2 all-time in the State of New York. The Green Knights won the Pathfinder Bank Oswego Hockey Classic in 2007-08, beating Curry 5-2 and Amherst 3-1. St. Norbert then beat Norwich and Plattsburgh State in Lake Placid at the 2008 Frozen Four.

The Green Knights are 8-3-1 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State and an 0-2 ledger against Oswego State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 2-2 against the ECAC East, going 1-2 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey Association has placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 16 out of a possible 26 times. St. Norbert has made three title

game appearances, in 2004, 2006 and 2008. Bemidji State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991) and UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 - Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 - Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 - River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986), UW-Superior (2002) and St. Norbert (2008) have all won Division III national titles while members of the NCHA.

In 26 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team among the final four 24 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost

Twenty Talk:

St. Norbert's 7-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 26 marked the 12th time in 14 years the Green Knights have won at least 20 games in a season. Saturday's NCAA Tournament win over Gustavus Adolphus marked the eighth time in nine years the Green Knights have won at least 23 games.

The Green Knights' first 20-win season came in a 21-9-1 campaign in 1996-97. The only two seasons since then where St. Norbert hasn't won at least 20 games were near-miss years of 18-8-3 in 2000-01 and 19-8-1 in 2008-09.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert has continued its long-standing tradition this season of being tough to beat when leading after two periods. The Green Knights are 20-0-1 this year when leading after the first 40 minutes of action.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 199-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009.

At home, St. Norbert is 217-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

St. Norbert is 118-8-6 in its last 132 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 131-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 140-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 219-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 156 consecutive weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2009-10 season at No. 11 before rising to No. 1 on Nov. 9, and remained there for three weeks. The Green Knights are 61-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.
