Series Overview:

St. Norbert opens play in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association with a tough two-game series at defending Peters Cup champion UW-Stout. The two-game weekend series marks a return to the format last used in the NCHA in the 1998-99 season.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stout 28-8-4 in a series begun in the 1991-92 season. The Green Knights are 26-3-3 in the last 32 games with the Blue Devils, but Stout is 2-1-1 in the last four meetings. The Green Knights are 9-3-4 all-time at the Dunn County Ice Arena, but Stout holds a 1-0-2 edge in the last three games played there.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 342-100-36 in his 17th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 198-31-19 in the last eight-plus seasons.

UW-Stout coach Terry Watkins (UW-Stout, 1972) is 163-177-20 in his 14th season in Menomonie.

Last Year:

UW-Stout jumped out to a 4-0 lead in the second period en route to a 5-2 win over St. Norbert last Dec. 5 at the Dunn County Ice Arena. Joel Gaulrapp scored a pair of goals for Stout, and Matt Koenig made 33 saves. Blake Bashor made nine saves for St. Norbert while B.J. O'Brien added 18.

Stout rallied for a 3-1 third-period deficit to claim a 4-3 overtime win at the Cornerstone Community Center last Feb. 7, a setback that likely kept St. Norbert out of the NCAA Tournament. It was also the first and only home loss for Tim Coghlin when leading after two periods. Gaulrapp's extra-attacker goal with 30 seconds left tied the game at 3-3, and Scott Motz's score 2:16 into overtime was the gamewinner. Koenig made 29 saves for Stout, while Bashor made 30 saves for St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the UW-Stout series coming off an 8-1 win over Lake Forest Tuesday at the Cornerstone Community Center in Green Bay.

The Green Knights were led by freshman forward Cody Keefer, who had two goals and three assists for five points in his first collegiate game. Keefer had St. Norbert's lone power-play goal. Senior forward Shane Wheeler tied a career high with four points, notching two goals and two assists. Junior defensemen Mike Bernardy and Sam Eccles both had two points, with Bernardy getting one goal and one assist and Eccles two assists. Fourteen of the 18 skaters who dressed against the Foresters scored at least one point.

Junior goaltender B.J. O'Brien got

the nod in goal for the Green Knights and made 18 saves. The Green Knights outshot the Foresters by a 44-19 margin.

St. Norbert was 1-for-4 (25.0 percent) on the power play and was 7-for-7 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill

About the Blue Devils:

UW-Stout enters the 2009-10 season coming off a banner 23-6-2 season that saw it claim its first NCHA Peters Cup title and make its first NCAA Division III Frozen Four appearance. The Blue Devils are picked to win their first NCHA regular-season championship in this year's pre-season coach's poll.

The Blue Devils return their top three scorers from last season. Senior forward Derek Hanson scored 17 goals and 28 assists for 45 points, while senior forward Joel Gaulrapp added 21 goals and 21 assists for 42 points. Senior forward Scott Motz had 14 goals and 22 assists for 36 points.

Junior goaltender Jesse Pischlar is the lone returning goaltender with experience for Stout. Pischlar was 2-1 last season with a 3.88 goals against average and .818 save percentage.

Stout's power play last season operated at 23.7 percent (42-for-177). The Blue Devils' penalty kill was 140-for-167 (83.8 percent) a year ago.

Dashing Debut:

Freshman forward Cody Keefer made his collegiate debut a memorable one with a five-point game in St. Norbert's 8-1 win over Lake Forest on Tuesday.

Keefer registered two goals and three assists for St. Norbert's first five-point game in nearly seven years. The last to do it was Jason Deitsch in an 11-2 win over St. John's on Jan. 3, 2003 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Keefer, a Grayling, Mich., native was a top scorer for the Bismarck Bobcats of the NAHL. Keefer scored 28 goals and 26 assists for 54 points last season during his final year with Bismarck.

18 and I Like It:

Alice Cooper didn't have much of a say in it, but the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association has moved to an 18-game league schedule for 2009-10. The NCHA had a 14-game league slate for the last 10 years. In St. Norbert's first four years in the NCHA, a 20-game league schedule was used.

St. Norbert will have three home two-game series this season and three away, along with six single dates to close out the regular season.

The Green Knights will host UW-Stevens Point, St. Scholastica and UW-Superior in two-game series, and travel to UW-Stout, UW-River Falls and UW-Eau Claire.

B.C. Bullets:

For the first time in 18 seasons, St. Norbert College does not have a British Columbia native on its hockey roster.

Tim Coghlin's first team at St. Norbert, the 1993-94 season, had four British Columbians - Darren Holmes, Brent Cyr, Silverio Mirao and Stew Weepers. Since that time, St. Norbert has had no fewer than two British Columbians each season until not having any this year.

In its hockey history, St. Norbert has had 33 British Columbians don a sweater.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 140 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2008-09 season at No. 1 before falling to No. 3 on Nov. 24. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 140-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 40 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09. St. Norbert is 75-33-12 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim

Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 2-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 216 games when scoring five goals or more with a 211-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 12 times in their last 233 games. St. Norbert hadn't allowed at least five goals in 41 games until Gustavus Adolphus scored five times on Oct. 31, 2008.

Ice Chips:

- * Matt Boyd leads St. Norbert's roster in multi-point games with 29. Shane Wheeler is the only other skater over 20 with a total of 26. Nick Tabisz and Tyler Allen each have 14 multi-point games.
- * St. Norbert's 109 goals scored in 2008-09 was the fewest amount since netting 85 during the 1994-95 season, its first in the NCHA.
- * Junior defensemen Mike Bernardy and Sam Eccles both set career highs with two-point games against Lake Forest on Oct. 27.
- * St. Norbert has now won 10 straight season-opening games. The Green Knights have won their second game of the season in each of the last four seasons. RIT topped St. Norbert 4-3 in the second game of 2004-05 and the two teams skated to a 4-4 tie in the second game of 2003-04
