No. 1 St. Norbert College (4-0-1, 2-0) vs. UW-Stevens Point (2-3, 0-2)

Series Overview:

St. Norbert returns to Northern Collegiate Hockey Association action when long-time rival UW-Stevens Point visits in a two-game series at the Cornerstone Community Center this weekend.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 31-18-5 margin. St. Norbert is 31-10-2 in the last 43 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 13-2-1 in the last 16 games in the series. St. Norbert is 19-6-4 all-time at home in the series. The Green Knights went 3-1 in four games against the Pointers last season, and won all three games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 345-100-37 in his 17th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 201-31-20 in the last eight-plus seasons.

UW-Stevens Point coach Wil Nichol (UW-Stevens Point, 1998) is 31-22-6 in his third season in Stevens Point.

Last Year

St. Norbert took three of four games from UW-Stevens Point last year. Each team won at home in the regular season, with St. Norbert winning 5-2 at home on Nov. 14, 2008 and Stevens Point winning 2-1 in overtime at Willett Arena on Jan. 24.

The Green Knights swept an NCHA Quarterfinal Series at the Cornerstone on Feb. 20-21. St. Norbert won the opener 8-3 behind two goals from Tyler Allen. The Green Knights then won the second game 4-3 in overtime behind a rare empty-net overtime goal by Nick Tabisz. Matt Boyd's shorthanded goal inside of five minutes left in regulation forced overtime as St. Norbert rallied from a 3-0 deficit.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved is now 4-0-1 overall after picking up a win and a tie against MIAC foes last weekend. The Green Knights topped Bethel 8-2 last Friday before skating to a 1-1 draw on Saturday against Hamline.

Freshman forward Cody Keefer leads the Green Knights in scoring with 11 points, tallying six goals and five assists through five games. Senior forward Shane Wheeler has five goals and four assists for nine points, while senior forward Matt Boyd has two goals and four assists for six points.

Junior goaltender B.J. O'Brien has seen most of the action between the pipes for St. Norbert. O'Brien is 4-0-1 with a 0.84 goals against average and .959 save percentage. Junior Blake Bashor has seen 20 minutes of action this season and has allowed one goal in 12 shots faced.

St. Norbert is 4-for-28 (14.3 per-

cent) on the power play and is 26-for-28 (92.9 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the St. Norbert series with a 2-3 overall record and an 0-2 mark in the NCHA. The Pointers lost to Hamline 6-3 last Friday before beating Bethel 5-4 on Saturday. Stevens Point has lost its lone two league games this season, getting swept at home by St. Scholastica 4-2 and 2-1 on Oct. 30-31.

Sophomore forward Travis Erstad leads the Pointers in scoring with three goals and three assists for six points. Junior defenseman Garrett Suter also has six points, registering two goals with four assists. Junior forward Nic Polaski and freshman forward Donnie Hallmark each have two goals and three assists for five points.

Junior Thomas Speer has seen most of the action in net for Stevens Point, and is 0-3 with a 3.65 goals against average and .884 save percentage. Freshman Nick Graves is 2-0 with a 2.70 goals against average and .864 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 5-for-28 (17.9 percent) on the power play and is 29-for-34 (85.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

Keefer Comments:

Freshman forward Cody Keefer has been off to a red-hot start to his collegiate career with 11 points, including six goals, through his first five games wearing a St. Norbert sweater.

Keefer scored four goals in an 8-2 win over Bethel on Nov. 6, including three in the second period. Keefer's four-goal night was St. Norbert's first four-goal game since Andy Cote scored four times against in a 6-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 4, 2006 at the Resch Center.

Keefer's three goals in the second period against Bethel tied a Cornerstone Community Center record, matching Adam Sedgwick's three goals in the first period against UW-Stout on Jan. 27, 2001.

Keefer registered five points in his first collegiate game in an 8-1 win over Lake Forest. Keefer had two goals and three assists against the Foresters, marking St. Norbert's first five-point game since Jason Deitsch scored five points in an 11-2 win over St. John's on Jan. 3, 2003.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterpiece *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 106-7-6 in its last 119 games at the Cornerstone Community Center. In the last eight-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 119-10-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 128-14-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 207-36-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

St. Norbert was 10-3-1 at the Cornerstone last season. The Green Knights lost that many games at the Cornerstone just twice in their history - going 9-4-1 in 2000-01 and 13-3-2 in 2001-02.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 141 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2009-10 season at No. 11 before rising to No. 1 on Nov. 9. The Green Knights are 56-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 141-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 41 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005,

2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but is now 2-0 against ranked teams already this season. St. Norbert is 77-33-12 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 2-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 217 games when scoring five goals or more with a 211-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 12 times in their last 237 games.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert has scored five goals just six times in its last 27 games.

* - St. Norbert junior goaltender B.J. O'Brien leads NCAA Division III goaltenders who have played more than one game with a 0.84 goals against average.

* - Matt Boyd surpassed the 100-point plateau for his career against Bethel. Boyd now has 34 goals and 67 assists for 101 points. He is now 14th on the St. Norbert career scoring list.

* - St. Norbert has trailed just 2 minutes 46 seconds this season, or 0.9 percent of the total action of 305 minutes.
