Series Overview:

The meatgrinder of the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association continues when No. 1 St. Norbert travels to Western Wisconsin for a two-game series with sixth-ranked UW-River Falls at Hunt Arena.

St. Norbert coverage is on the WSNC radio Webcast with Tim Derozier on the call. The Webcast is available at http://www.snc.edu/athletics/hockey/webcast.htm.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-River Falls 28-16-2. The Green Knights are 24-4-1 against River Falls in their last 29 meetings. The Green Knights are 10-11-1 all-time at Hunt Arena, the only NCHA venue that head coach Tim Coghlin is not at least .500 in. St. Norbert has won four its last five games at UW-River Falls, the only blemish a 3-2 loss to the Falcons on Dec. 2, 2006.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 347-100-37 in his 17th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 203-31-20 in the last eight-plus seasons. Coghlin's 337 wins as a coach in the NCHA is 33 short of Bemidji State's Bob Peters' record of 370.

UW-River Falls coach Steve Freeman (UW-Stevens Point, 1981) is 251-114-28 in his 14th season in River Falls.

Last Year

St. Norbert swept UW-River Falls last year, winning 4-3 in River Falls on Dec. 6 and 4-1 on Feb. 6 in Green Bay.

St. Norbert trailed 2-1 after two periods but scored three times in the third to win on the road, with Sam Tikka, Tyler Allen and Scott Pulak netting third-period goals. B.J. O'Brien made 30 saves for the Green Knights.

The Green Knights got two goals from Nick Tabisz at home to top the Falcons. St. Norbert, which outshot River Falls 36-14 in the game, got 13 saves from Blake Bashor.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved improved to 6-0-1 overall and 4-0 in the NCHA with a two-game sweep of UW-Stevens Point by scores of 9-3 and 2-0 this past weekend at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Freshman forward Cody Keefer leads St. Norbert in scoring with 13 points, netting seven goals and six assists. Senior forward Shane Wheeler has six goals and six assists for 12 points, while senior forward Matt Boyd has four goals and five assists for nine points. All three of those skaters have two power-play goals apiece.

Junior goaltender B.J. O'Brien posted his second shutout of the year in Saturday's 2-0 win over Stevens Point. O'Brien owns a 6-0-1 record with a 1.04 goals against average and .947 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 10-for-42 (23.8 percent) on the power play and is 33-for-37 (89.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Falcons:

UW-River Falls enters the St. Norbert series with a 5-1-1 overall record and a 3-0-1 mark in the NCHA. The Falcons picked up three points at UW-Eau Claire this past weekend, winning 2-1 on Friday with a 1-1 tie on Saturday. River Falls' lone loss this season came at home to Gustavus Adolphus by a 3-2 score on Nov. 6.

Sophomore forward Justin Brossman leads the Falcons in scoring with five goals and eight assists for 13 points. Senior forward Tyler Czuba has one goal and seven assists for eight points, while junior forward Jason Yuel has two goals and five assists for six points. Freshman defenseman Brady Horn has four goals this season, all on the power play.

Sophomore goaltender Bo Storozuk owns a 5-1 record with a 1.59 goals against average and .949 save percentage.

River Falls is 7-for-29 (24.1 percent) on the power play and is 29-for-30 (96.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

Power Play Patter:

St. Norbert had an avalanche of power-play goals in a 9-3 win over UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 13 at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights were a robust 6-for-8 on the power play in the game.

The Green Knights registered five power-play goals in the third period alone to set a Cornerstone Community Center record. St. Norbert was 4-for-27 this season on the power play entering the game, and was battling a 9-for-72 slump with the extra man dating back through the last 11 games of the 2008-09 season.

St. Norbert last scored six powerplay goals in an 8-2 win over UW-Superior in a NCAA Division III Tournament game on March 11, 2006.

The Green Knights set a NCAA Division III and school record with eight power-play goals against Stevens Point in an 11-1 win on Jan. 27, 1996 at the De Pere Ice Arena.

Keefer Komments:

Freshman forward Cody Keefer has been off to a red-hot start to his collegiate career with 13 points, including seven goals, through his first seven games wearing a St. Norbert sweater.

Keefer has three multi-point games this season, which shares the team lead with Shane Wheeler. Keefer is third nationally in points per game by freshmen at 1.86 points per game.

Keefer scored four goals in an 8-2 win over Bethel on Nov. 6, including three in the second period. Keefer's four-goal night was St. Norbert's first four-goal game since Andy Cote scored four times against in a 6-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 4, 2006 at the Resch Center.

Keefer's three goals in the second period against Bethel tied a Cornerstone Community Center record, matching Adam Sedgwick's three goals in the first period against UW-Stout on Jan. 27, 2001.

Keefer registered five points in his first collegiate game in an 8-1 win over Lake Forest. Keefer had two goals and three assists against the Foresters, marking St. Norbert's first five-point game since Jason Deitsch scored five points in an 11-2 win over St. John's on Jan. 3, 2003.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 142 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2009-10 season at No. 11 before rising to No. 1 on Nov. 9. The Green Knights are 58-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 142-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 42 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but is now 2-0 against ranked teams already this season. St. Norbert is 77-33-12 against teams ranked in the

USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 2-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 218 games when scoring five goals or more with a 213-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 12 times in their last 239 games.

Ice Chips:

- * St. Norbert is 46th out of 54 teams in Division III who have played this season at 12.3 penalty minutes per game.
- * St. Norbert's 1.14 goals allowed per game is tops in this week's Division III national statistics rankings.
- * Matt Boyd has 36 goals and 68 assists for 104 points. He is now 13th on the St. Norbert career scoring list. His career assists total is three short of Maris Ziedins' 71 for 10th among the all-time St. Norbert leaders.
- * St. Norbert has trailed just 4 minutes 12 seconds this season, or 1.0 percent of the total action of 425 minutes.
- * Junior defenseman Nick Tabisz is St. Norbert's leading scorer in NCHA competition, scoring one goal and five assists for six points.
