The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 349-100-37 in his 17th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 205-31-20 in the last eight-plus seasons. Coghlin's 339 wins as a coach in the NCHA is 31 short of Bemidji State's Bob Peters' record of 370.

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert, 2000) is 45-40-6 in his fourth season in Appleton.

Salem State coach Bill O'Neill (Boston University, 1979) is 458-292-45 in his 29th year in Salem.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Lawrence 4-0 last Nov. 29 at the Cornerstone Community Center in Green Bay. The Green Knights led 2-0 after two periods before goals by Nick Tabisz and Alain Joanette scored thirdperiod goals to ice the game. B.J. O'Brien made 16 saves for St. Norbert, while Evan Johnson made 32 stops for the Vikings.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved improved to 8-0-1 overall and 6-0 in the NCHA with a two-game sweep at UW-River Falls by scores of 4-2 and 8-3 this past weekend at Hunt Arena.

Senior forward Shane Wheeler has moved to the top of the scoring leaders with nine goals and eight assists for 17 points. Freshman forward Cody Keefer has seven goals and seven assists for 14 points, while senior forward Matt Boyd has five goals and seven assists for 12 points. Junior defenseman Nick Tabisz has four goals and seven assists for 11 points.

Junior goaltender B.J. O'Brien owns an 8-0-1 record with a 1.37 goals against average and .933 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 13-for-55 (23.6 percent) on the power play and is 40for-45 (88.9 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Vikings I:

Lawrence enters its game with St. Norbert with a 6-1 record, and is an unblemished 5-0 in the Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association. The Vikings swept Northland 8-5 and 8-1 at home this past weekend. Lawrence has split a pair of games against NCHA foes this year, beating UW-Eau Claire 3-2 on Oct. 31 and losing to UW-Superior 6-2 on Nov. 14.

Senior forward Marc Howe leads the Vikings in scoring with nine goals and five assists for 14 points. Sophomore forward Ben DiMarco has eight goals and six assists for 14 points. Sophomore forwards Matt Hughes and Sam Johnson both have four goals and four assists for eight points.

Junior Evan Johnson is 6-1 overall with a 3.03 goals against average and .899 save percentage.

Lawrence is 10-for-44 (22.7 percent) on the power play and is 34for-40 (85.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Vikings II:

Salem State opened its season last week with a trio of wins to stand at 3-0 overall and in the MASCAC. The Vikings topped UMass-Dartmouth 3-2 on Nov. 17, Plymouth State 5-2 on Nov. 19 and Fitchburg State 4-3 in overtime this past Saturday.

Sophomore forward Matt Johnson has two goals and one assist for three points, while sophomore forward Justin Roy has one goal and two assists for three points. Senior forward Chris MacInnis and freshman forward Casey Terreri each have two goals.

Junior goaltender James Lacour is the only netminder to have seen action for the Vikings. Lacour is 3-0 with a 2.30 goals against average and .921 save percentage.

Salem State is 3-for-14 (21.4 percent) on the power play and is 16for-20 (80.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 21-15-4 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights have played at least one weekend a season against an eastern foe for the past 15 years.

The Green Knights are 8-3-1 alltime against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 alltime against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 2-2 against the ECAC East, going 1-2 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 143 consecutive weeks. Prior to being ranked seventh in the Nov. 5, 2007 poll, the Green Knights had been rated in the top four for 100 of 101 weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2009-10 season at No. 11 before rising to No. 1 on Nov. 9. The Green Knights are 60-11-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 143-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 43 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but is now 4-0 against ranked teams already this season - sweeping UW-Stout and UW-River Falls in road series. St. Norbert is 79-33-12 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-3 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 2-5 alltime against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 219 games when scoring five goals or more with a 214-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996. The Green Knights had an 85-game winning streak snapped when scoring five or more goals when they tied UW-Superior 5-5 on Dec. 3, 2004.

St. Norbert is 5-18-4 in its last 27 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, another win over UW-Stout in an 8-5 triumph on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 12 times in their last 241 games.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert has never lost a game to a Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association school. The Green Knights are 47-0-1 all-time against the MCHA. St. Norbert is 28-0 against Lawrence, 12-0-1 against Marian, 6-0 against MSOE and 1-0 against Lake Forest as a MCHA member.

* - Matt Boyd has 37 goals and 70 assists for 105 points in 90 games. He is now 12th on the St. Norbert career scoring list. His career assists total is one short of Maris Ziedins' 71 for 10th among the all-time St. Norbert leaders.

* - Shane Wheeler reached the career 100-point plateau during the UW-River Falls series this past weekend. In 93 games, Wheeler has 35 goals and 65 assists for 100 points. Wheeler is the 16th skater in St. Norbert history to reach 100 career points.

* - St. Norbert's Justin Favreau, Dylan Exton, Brandon Longley and Dustin Walz were disqualified for fighting an 8-3 win over UW-River Falls on Nov. 21, meaning all four will miss Friday's game with Lawrence. It is the most St. Norbert players disqualified in one game since six Green Knights were dismissed against Bethel on Feb. 17, 1990. A total of 14 players were asked to leave that contest, which featured a whopping total of 225 penalty minutes. By contrast, last Saturday's game with River Falls had "just" 154 penalty minutes.
